Massive oak tree destroys Aitkin home, causes overnight power outage

June saw huge early-summer storms in Minnesota. Tornadoes have touched down in various places and

straight-line winds wrecked their own sort of havoc.
On a middle-of-the-night storm in Aitkin, which only left branches down in lots of

lawns, John Ziebarth's home was wrecked. A huge oak tree pulled out from the stump and fell diagonally over the roof.

Later, Heritage Tree Service in Brainerd used a crane and a crew to remove the mammoth tree on June 26. Folks gathered in the street to watch the huge crane lift out the large pieces of tree.

According to Dave Cluff of Aitkin Public Utilities, in the early hours of June 23, the tree fell on the home and also broke the Phase 3 power line, knocking off power to about 70 homes in southeast

Aitkin at 2:25 a.m. Power was restored by 4:25 p.m.

Cluff said that while there have been various trees down in Aitkin, there haven't been extended power disruptions as other areas have seen.
