Dialogue with a Designer Brenda Denny | BKD Interiors

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: What motivated you to go into the interior design field?

BRENDA DENNY: I've always been a highly visual and creative thinker, so interior design felt like a natural fit from the start. I was drawn to the idea of shaping spaces that are both beautiful and functional. Once I began working in the field, I quickly realized I had a real talent for it—especially when it came to seeing the big picture and helping others

envision what's possible. It didn't take long before I knew this was exactly where I was meant to be.

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: How has the field of interior design changed since you graduated?

BRENDA DENNY: When I graduated from college, interior design was still a relatively new field. Most people, especially builders—didn't fully understand what designers did or the value we could bring. Today, interior design is highly respected. People now recognize the tremendous benefits of working with an experienced designer to create spaces that are not only beautiful, but also functional, cohesive, and thoughtfully planned.

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: How can an experienced interior designer help a custom home builder or a remodeling contractor with their building or remodeling projects?

BRENDA DENNY: An experienced, organized, and creative designer can take a significant load off the builder by guiding the client through key decisions efficiently and

confidently. We help clients make thoughtful, informed choices—often on tight timelines, which keeps the project moving smoothly and avoids delays. When clients select finishes with a designer, we ensure those selections align with the final furnished design of the home, creating a cohesive look from start to finish. We also help keep selections within budget by presenting options that meet both aesthetic and financial goals. Just as importantly, a designer can help foster a strong, collaborative relationship between the client and builder—ensuring that everyone is working together as a team toward a shared vision.

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: What sets you apart from other designers?

BRENDA DENNY: What sets me apart is my ability to really understand and read my clients—I get a strong sense of their needs, even the ones they can't quite articulate. I'm also highly creative, especially when it comes to reimagining spaces in ways that surprise and inspire. THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: How do you begin the materials selection process when working with builders' and remodelers' clients?

BRENDA DENNY: I typically start with a few inspiration fabric samples to set the color palette and give the client something tangible to respond to. From there, I build a cohesive design that reflects their style and works with the planned furnishings. I begin early with foundational selections—like countertops, flooring, and stone—so we can lock in key materials that guide the rest of the design. This gives the client confidence in their choices and provides the builder with timely, organized information to keep the project on track.

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: Speaking about staying current, how to you keep yourself up to date with all the design trends happening in the industry today? **BRENDA DENNY:** Staying current is an important part of my job. I regularly attend trade shows, the High Point Furniture Market, vendor events, and product trainings to see what's new and how I can effectively incorporate it into my designs. I also keep up with design publications and trend forecasts. This allows me to introduce clients to fresh ideas and updated materials that not only look great but also have longevity. For the builder, it means fewer changes down the line and a finished product that feels relevant, functional, and timeless.

THE METROPOLITAN BUILDER: How would you characterize your personal style?

BRENDA DENNY: My personal style is rooted in creating spaces that truly reflect the client. I take pride in getting to know who they are and what they love, then

GHBA Forecast Luncheon Summary - June 17th, 2025 Featuring Ali Wolf, Chief Economist at ZONDA

- Consumer Sentiment: Consumers feel slightly better about the economy despite April's tariff shocks and subsequent policy volatility. Stock market figures and negotiations have eased some concerns.
- Business Outlook: Businesses also feel somewhat optimistic, though uncertainty remains high among small business owners. Half of CEOs expect worsening conditions in the next six months, with most anticipating some form of recession.
- Trade War Impact: The trade war causes uncertainty and recession fears but also brings positives like more domestic suppliers and potentially better trade terms for the USA.
- Interest Rate Pressures:
- Upward: Inflation, Fed policy, rising debt, questions about the US as a safe haven, bond sell-offs, and increased cash holdings.
- Downward: Economic uncertainty (tariffs, policy changes) and a slowing economy.
- Housing Market Trends:
- Home Listings: Up 32% year-over-year (YOY) but still down 12% from 2019.
- Existing Home Sales: Down 3% YOY and 20% from 2019.
- Houston Specifics: Home listings up 35% YOY and 12% from 2019. Community counts are back to normal, making Houston the 2nd largest production market with good jobs and tax revenue.
- Market Competitiveness: The market has become more competitive. Builder surveys show varied demand expectations, with 25% saying demand is as expected, 35% slower than expected, and 40% way less than expected and causing concern. Builders describe the market as a "knife fight," "sputtering," and "very difficult."
- Incentives: Most new home projects offer incentives, but these are not driving urgency. Incentives are costly, and consumers expect them along with more benefits.



Builders Post-Tension

- Home Prices: Houston home prices are down 5.4% from the peak but still up 40% from 2019, leading to different buyer behavior.
- Builder Dynamics: The top 15 builders in Houston are mostly public companies, which have different expectations and cost bases compared to private ones.
- Population and Labor Market: Houston's population is up 2% YOY. The city is demographically diverse and attractive to outsiders. The labor market has grown 9% since 2019 and continues to expand.
- Manufacturing Investments: Houston ranks #2 in Texas for private sector manufacturing investments.
- New Home Starts: Expected to stay in line with closings.
 ZONDA forecasts 5% fewer starts YOY due to pullback in specs, slower demand, fierce competition, top builder expectations, and increased costs without the ability to raise prices.
- Market Outlook: The market will be bumpy, but favorable demographics, a narrowed new vs. existing price spread, aging housing stock, incentives, and customization benefits make new housing desirable.
 Educating consumers on these advantages is crucial.
