The overall winner was Steve Anderson, the Mayor of Milford, whose sponsored portable toilet collected the most waste.



# Focusing On Art

This year, the Pearson Lakes Art Center celebrates its 60th year anniversary after its establishment in 1965.

"It's a big accomplishment for us," says Holly Zinn Hample, who has worked for 14 years as Education Director at the Art Center.

"Summer is a very busy time for us, with many visitors. Many students and adults are fond of our year-round programs." Programs at the Art Center include:

Holly says one of the things she enjoys most about her position at the art center are the ideas the students think up.

Holly Zinn Hample's fondness for art in general is as stated: "I've always been drawn to art and enjoy doing things with my hands; creating is who I am."

Her advice for new, aspiring artists is:

"Practice, try new things, and practice some more."

As being an artist for 20 years, Zinn Hample says her favorite medium is Print Making, a process similar to making stamps.

Holly says of the Art Center, "Part of our mission is connecting generations of people through art."

Three hours into my much-anticipated week on Lake of the Woods, I hit a submerged rock with my outboard motor. I wasn't going fast—but it was enough. A horrible crunch. Then silence. The motor was done. A "spine" in 9 feet of water that is heavily traveled caught the skeg guard on my motor, damaged my prop, and cracked the lower housing unit. The engine would not shift into gear, and I knew serious damage had occurred.

I sat there for a long while in disbelief, floating in a boat that could no longer go anywhere fast, miles from camp. This trip had taken months to plan. Friends and family had coordinated time off, packed gear, and driven hours across the Midwest for a week of fishing, laughter, and quiet sunrises. And here I was—crippled on Day One.

For a moment (maybe more than a moment), I felt despair set in. A sense of deep depression. I started thinking about heading home early. Why stay if I couldn't fish with my own boat?

But that's when something unexpected happened. One by one, friends and family came alongside me-literally and emotionally. They offered words of encouragement. The resort owner and other experienced fishermen indicated I had done nothing wrong. I was the 9th lower unit hit by rocks that year in what they are calling a "low water year". The friends and family started restructuring our fishing plans so I could still be part of the experience.

Instead of two to three people per boat, we packed four in each-tight quarters, yes, but full of laughter, shared sandwiches, and fish stories. And not just fish stories—we caught trophy muskies. Big ones. Lots of them. By the end of the week everyone put one on the board.

In the end, I stayed. And I'm so glad I did.

The trip I thought was ruined turned into something deeper and richer than I could have planned. It reminded me that joy doesn't always come from things going perfectly. Sometimes it comes from the way people show up for you when everything

So if you're going through something that feels like hitting a rock in the middle of a lake, here are five actions I've learned to take when things don't go the way you hoped:

1. **Pause before reacting –** It's easy to make a rash decision when you're frustrated or disappointed. Take a breath. Let emotions settle before choosing your next move.

2. Accept help – People genuinely want to support you. Letting others lend a hand isn't weakness—it's community.

3. **Reframe the moment –** This isn't what you planned. But could it be better in a different way? Ask yourself what might be possible because of the disruption.

4. **Stay in the story –** Don't pull out early. Give life a chance to surprise you. Some of the best chapters unfold right after things fall apart.

5. **Find the meaning**—Even when things go sideways, there's often a hidden gift. Look for the perspective, the connection, the grace that wasn't visible before.

So no, the trip didn't go as I expected. But I came home with stories that mattered. Not just about the fish we caught, but about the people who made the difference. And isn't that what really counts?

### **Ruthven Fire Department Launches Online** Fundraising Campaign to Build New Fire Station

Ruthven, Iowa - The Ruthven Fire department, a 100% volunteer-run emergency service serving the City of Ruthven,

Iowa, Lost Island Township, Lake Township, Freeman Township, has launched an online fundraising campaign and set up an account at the Iowa State Bank in Ruthven to raise \$800,000 for the construction of a new, modern fire station.



The campaign, which is hosted through the department's Face-

book page and official website, allows community members and supporters to make small, secure donations via Venmo with the goal of building a station that meets current safety, equipment, and personnel needs.

"We've been in tight spots before; on Mother's Day 1977, said Fire Chief Bates "our fire station burned down, resulting in a total loss." We were fortunate, we were able to reconstruct. Fire departments in surrounding areas donated fire trucks to assist with the rebuild," He recalls his father's time as a firefighter with this department. Chief Bates' family has a lengthy history of fire service.

### Mixed Tostadas

Oil, for shallow frying 14 freshly prepared unbaked corn tortillas

cup mashed red kidney or pinto

iceberg lettuce, shredded Olive oil and vinegar dressing

2 cooked chicken breast portions, skinned and thinly sliced

cup coarsely grated sharp cheddar

Pickled jalapeño chiles, seeded and sliced, to taste

Heat the oil in a shallow frying pan and fry the corn tortillas, one by one, until golden brown on both sides and crisp but not hard. Spread each tortilla with a layer of mashed pinto or kidney beans. Put a layer of shredded lettuce (which can either be left plain or lightly tossed with a little dressing) over the beans.



Arrange chicken slices on top of the lettuce. Carefully spread over a layer of the guacamole and finally sprinkle over the grated cheese. Arrange the mixed tostadas on a large platter and serve immediately, while still warm. Use your hands to eat tostadas, as they are extremely messy. Variations: Instead of chicken, try using shredded pork, ground beef or turkey, or sliced chorizo. For a more authentic taste, use queso fresco or feta cheese instead of cheddar.







The Spirit Lake Public Library has recently added a new genealogy resource: Ancestry Library Edition. If you already have an Ancestry.com account, it can be used in conjunction with that database as you do your genealogy research.

Ancestry Library Edition brings the world's most popular consumer online genealogy resource to your library. It's an unprecedented online collection of individuals from North America, the United Kingdom, Europe, Australia, and more. Popular and recently added collections include: U.S., Canadian, U.K., other international collections, military, and multimedia. This would include photos, Social Security index, baptism records, U.S. census information, birth, death & marriage records, and much more. It's great for library patrons, historians, students ... anyone wanting to do genealogy research.

There are some differences between Ancestry Library Edition (ALE) and a personal Ancestry.com subscription. ALE is free for anyone at the library, and international content is included, but there is no DNA component. In a personal Ancestry.com subscription service, international content is extra, and there is a DNA option. In ALE, the researcher follows his/her own trail, and family trees & message boards are read only. In Ancestry. com there is a research assistant (The Leaf), and you can publish family trees and connect on message boards. One thing that is the same in both products is the census data.

To access ALE, you have to physically be at the Spirit Lake Public Library since it is available only in the library. You can find Ancestry.com on our website slpublib.com under "Digital Services". James "Jim" Taylor passed away on July 28, 2025, at Spencer Hospital. James was born on February 15, 1937, in Council Bluffs, Iowa, to Glenn and Alice (Verner) Taylor. He grew up on the family farm in Pottawattamie County,

west of Oakland, on land purchased by his ancestors in the 1840s. He graduated from Carson High School in 1954.
