

complications.

The Special Delivery Program reflects NAMC's commitment to prioritizing early intervention and raising awareness about the risks associated with the postpartum period. The wristbands act as a visible reminder for patients, families, and healthcare providers providers to remain vigilant about postpartum health during this critical time.

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), In 2022, the U.S. maternal mortality rate was 22.3 deaths per 100,000 live births which is significantly higher than rates in other high-income countries. Alarmingly, the maternal mortality rate for Black women in the US is even higher at 69.9 deaths per 100,000 live births.

Many postpartum complications, such as hypertension, anemia, conditions, and infections, occur days or weeks after delivery, and

53% of pregnancy-related deaths happen between 7 and 365 days postpartum.

"By providing tools for early identification of potential complications and encouraging community awareness, we are enhancing care during a critical time," said Mike Howard, CEO and Market President of North Alabama Medical Center. 'This program underscores dedication our improving health outcomes and ensuring that every postpartum individual has the resources and support they need."

been completed.

"The lighting on the bridge was updated just last week, and a few additional steps are currently underway to prepare the bridge for the next phase of improvements," Broyles

said. 



Can someone explain to me why there are Spanish speaking workers with the tree contracting company working for Florence Utilities? I'm not talking about the one or two guys who get out of the truck to speak to the residents, the ones who can speak some English but sometimes only marginally. I'm talking about the ones who stay in the truck until the work starts and communicate in Spanish.

Hazardous occupations, according to OSHA, require employees to be a minimum age of 18. At that age, I can think of no reason they would be

legally here and legally working here without also being fluent in English and/or having English as their first language. There are plenty of qualified citizens to work for these companies that there would be no need for someone working on an H-1B, H-2A, or any other temporary work visa.

I get the feeling the crew is something like that of a crew I worked with in

south Mississippi going on 25-30 years ago. There were 15 of us with me being the only one that spoke fluent English. There was one guy among the rest that spoke enough English to handle their business, renting apartments, buying cars, etc. Break times, including lunch time, were extremely boring for me because I had no one to talk to. Eventually, I found out from the "lead" guy had come in on a school visa but never started school. He told me this himself.

I'm estimating it has been about 25 years ago that the city of Florence had Asplundh doing the trimming along the power lines. After several complaints from residents that the workers didn't speak English and therefore couldn't communicate the

That's not just Joel and me saying that. Read the opinion below written by the Alabama Court of Civil Appeals. If you or someone you know has an on-thejob injury you can ask the nurse not to be present while you meet with your doctor who was chosen by the insurance company. The judge said:

"I want to briefly address an abhorrent and, unfortunately, growing practice increasingly used by workers' compensation insurance carriers in which the insurance carriers hire nurses to monitor the recovery of the injured employees. The nurses usually are paid to accompany the employees to all appointments with doctors and physical therapists, to review the employees' medical records, and to even make home visits to check on the employees' progress...'

"My objection to this practice is not so much that the insurance carriers are employing these nurses, but that the nurses are usually not forthcoming in revealing the existence, nature, and purpose of their employment. Thus, injured employees are presented with nurses, who appear to be assisting them when, in actuality, the nurses might very well testify in court using information gained through the employees' trust in them. In my opinion, insurance carriers and nurses involved in this practice are treading perilously close to misrepresentation and suppression, if they have not crossed the line already.'

Reid v. Aetna Cas. & Sur. Co., 692 So. 2d 863, 865 (Ala. Civ. App. 1997) (Monroe, Concurring) (emphasis added).

We send a letter to nurse case managers that states: 1. My client does not consent to your meeting with the physician regarding a medical impairment rating without my client being present for the conversation. 2. My client (and your client) does not consent to your meeting with the physician for the purpose of requesting an FCE without my client present. 3. My client (and your client) does not consent to your "redirecting" my client's medical care. 4. My client (and your client) does not consent to your canceling my client's medical appointments because the date is not convenient to you. 5. My client (and your client) demands that you copy my client with all reports, letters, and other documents that you write or receive as part of my client's file.



murder cases.

To classify a given murder as more heinous and deserving of the death penalty just because a certain type of individual or occupation is associated with the victim is a knee-jerk reaction by government officials to play the voting public, most of whom have never been directly impacted by a murder. One family's pain is not any less traumatic when their loved one is not among those with special circumstances.

Then there is the aspect of the wrongly convicted. Few murder cases are absolute slam dunks. With evidence in these cases later being found faulty, questionable, withheld, prejudicial, disallowed, etc., there can be a lot that the jury is not privy to, resulting in questionable convictions. Life without parole often makes more sense, especially when that is what a jury recommends.

There are cases like occasional the one involving David Lee Roberts, convicted in the 1992 murder of Annetra Jones and sentenced to die on August 21, 2025, by the judge in the case, despite the jury's recommendation for life imprisonment. His execution has been temporarily stayed by a Marion County judge to assess his mental competency.
The U.S. Supreme Court

has ruled in the past that inmates who cannot understand their sentence or the reasons for it cannot be executed. That is not as troubling as the fact that he had shown signs of mental instability for many years before his crime, has a detailed family history of mental illness, and was in all likelihood unable to intellectually keep his own wits against the person who actually wanted Jones dead. Apparently, jurors were not convinced that Roberts was solely responsibility for the doubted crime and whether the evidence presented supported a death sentence at all. One juror is even speaking out publicly about it.

There are so many aspects to consider for death penalty cases. We'd be better off if there were fewer prosecuted as such and fewer rendered.

# Medicare Minute "Medicare Part B, 2"

Medicare Part B is most used when you visit your primary care physician or specialist. But Medicare Part B is also used for many other medically necessary services. Medicare defines medically necessary as "healthcare services or supplies needed to diagnose or treat an illness, injury, condition or disease, or its symptoms and that meet accepted standards of medicine".

One of these other services covered by Part B is transportation by ambulance. Medicare covers and helps pay for ambulance services only if other types of transportation will endanger your health and will only cover and help pay for you to be transported to the nearest medical facility that's able to give you the care you need. If you choose to be transported to a facility farther away you may have to pay more.

Another service Part B covers is Durable Medical Equipment (DME). DME must be long lasting equipment that is used in your home for medical reasons and has an expected lifetime of at least 3 years. Medicare has a long list of equipment that falls under DME.

One of the most important benefits of Medicare Part B are the preventive services that it covers. These services include health care that is used to prevent illness or detect illness at an early stage.

Medicare.gov list 23 screenings and shots that fall under preventive services. They include things such as mammogram screenings, colorectal cancer screenings and flu shots.

Part B has an annual deductible of \$257 and a coinsurance

Part B has an annual deductible of \$257 and a coinsurance of 20%. This means that if you have Original Medicare only, with no other supplemental coverage, you will owe the first \$257 filed on Part B each year and, after the deductible is met, you will be responsible for 20% of the cost of Part B services you receive.






