STRAWBERRY PRETZEL SALAD

Serving:12

Yeild: 17 x 11 inch salad

Ingredients

- 1½ cups crushed pretzels
- ¾ cup butter, melted
- 4 ½ tablespoons white sugar
- 2 (8 ounce) packages cream cheese, softened
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 2 cups boiling water
- 1 (6 ounce) package strawberry flavored Jell-O
- 1 (16 ounce) package frozen strawberries

Directions

Step 1 Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F

Step 2 Mix together pretzels, melted butter, and 4 1/2 tablespoons sugar in a medium bowl until well combined. Press into the bottom of a 9x13-inch dish.

Step 3 Press into the bottom of a 9x13 inch pan. Bake for 10 minutes, or until lightly toasted. Set aside to cool completely.

Step 4 In a medium bowl, beat the sugar and cream cheese until smooth.

Step 5 Fold in whipped topping and spread evenly over the cooled crust. Refrigerate until set, about 30 minutes. **Step 6** Stir together boiling water and gelatin mix in a second large bowl. Mix in frozen strawberries; stir until thawed.

Step 7 Pour over cream cheese mixture in the dish. Refrigerate until completely chilled, at least 1 hour.

WATERGATE SALAD

Servings: 8

Ingredients

- 1 (3.4 ounce) package instant pistachio pudding mix
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple, with juice
- 1 cup miniature marshmallows
- ½ cup chopped walnuts
- 4 ounces frozen whipped topping, thawed

Directions

- 1. Combine crushed pineapple with juice, instant pudding mix, mini marshmallows, and walnuts in a large serving bowl. Mix until well combined.
- 2. Fold in whipped topping, then chill for 1 to 2 hours before serving.
- 3. When ready to serve, garnish with crushed pistachios and maraschino cherries.

CHERRY SUPREME SALAD

Servings: 12

Yield: 1 - 7x11 inch salad

Ingredients

- 1 (3 ounce) package strawberry flavored Jell-O[®] gelatin
- 1 cup boiling water
- 1 (21 ounce) can cherry pie filling
- 1 (3 ounce) package lemon flavored Jell-O[®] gelatin
- ¾ cup boiling water
- ¼ cup lemon juice
- 1 (3 ounce) package cream cheese
- 1/3 cup mayonnaise
- 1 (8 ounce) can crushed pineapple, undrained
- 2 cups miniature marshmallows
- ½ cup whipped cream
- ½ cup chopped walnuts

Directions

Dissolve the strawberry gelatin in 1 cup of boiling water. Stir in the cherry pie filling, then spread the mixture into a 7x11 inch pan, and refrigerate until nearly set, about 45 minutes.

Dissolve the lemon gelatin in 3/4 cup boiling water; stir in the lemon juice, and set aside. Mash the cream cheese in a separate bowl until soft, then stir in the mayonnaise. Pour the lemon gelatin into the cream cheese mixture and stir until smooth. Next, stir in the undrained pineapple. Finally, fold in the marshmallows and whipped cream.

Spread the pineapple mixture over the chilled cherry layer, and sprinkle with chopped walnuts. Chill in the refrigerator until fully set, about 2 hours.

ORANGE BUTTERMILK SALAD

Servings: 10 Yield: 10 servings

Ingredients

- 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple, undrained
- 3 tablespoons white sugar
- 1 (6 ounce) package orange flavored Jell-O®
- 2 cups buttermilk
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed

Directions

Mix pineapple and sugar together in a medium saucepan, and bring to a low boil, stirring occasionally. Stir in gelatin until completely



dissolved, remove from heat, and cool to room temperature. Add buttermilk, and refrigerate 1 hour, or until partially set.

Gently fold in whipped topping. Pour mixture into a lightly oiled gelatin mold. Refrigerate 8 hours, or until completely set.

STRAWBERRY FLUFF

Servings: 9 Yield: 8 to 10 servings Ingredients

 2 (3 ounce) packages strawberry flavored Jell-O®

- 1 (16 ounce) package cottage cheese
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 1 (20 ounce) can crushed pineapple, drained



Directions

In a mixing bowl, combine the gelatin mix, cottage cheese, whipped topping and pineapple. Mix together well, refrigerate until chilled and serve.

PINEAPPLE PRETZEL SALAD

Servings: 18 Yield: 1 - 9x13 inch dish Ingredients

- 2 cups crushed pretzels
- 1 cup butter, melted
- 1 (8 ounce) package cream cheese
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 (8 ounce) container frozen whipped topping, thawed
- 2 (20 ounce) cans crushed pineapple
- ½ (3.4 ounce) package instant vanilla pudding mix

Directions

Preheat oven to 350 degrees F

Place crushed pretzels in the bottom of a 9x13 inch baking dish. Pour melted butter carefully over top. Bake in preheated oven 10 minutes.

Cream together cream cheese and sugar. Fold in whipped topping. Spread over cooled crust. Combine pineapple and pudding mix. Spread over whipped topping layer. Chill until serving

Serve alongside a ham or turkey. Or as a refreshing holiday dessert.

Servings: 12 Ingredients


- ½ cup cinnamon red hot candies
- 1 cup water
- 1 (3 ounce) package cherryflavored gelatin (such as JELL-O)
 - 2 cups applesauce

Directions

1. Dissolve cinnamon candies in water in a saucepan over medium heat. Mix in gelatin and allow to dissolve; remove from heat and stir applesauce into mixture. Pour into a serving dish and refrigerate until set, about 2 hours.

CREAMSICLE ORANGE COOKIES

Servings24 Ingredients



- 3 ounces orange jello 1 box
- 2 tablespoons orange zest
- 8 tablespoons salted butter softened
- 2 large eggs room temperature
- 11 ounces white chocolate chips

Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 350°F. Line two large baking sheets with parchment paper or a silicone baking mat. Set aside.
- In a large mixing bowl or the bowl of a stand mixer, whisk together the white cake mix, orange gelatin powder and orange zest until fully combined.
- Add the butter and eggs to the bowl. Use a hand mixer or stand mixer to beat the ingredients together just until combined, about 2 minutes, scraping down the sides and bottom of the bowl as needed.
- 4. Add the white chocolate chips and fold into the cookie dough.
- 5. Use a 1 ½ tablespoon cookie scoop to scoop out the dough, roll the dough into a ball and place on the prepared cookie sheet. Repeat with the remaining dough making sure to leave about 2 inches between each ball.
- 6. Bake the cookies for 10 to 13 minutes or until the edges are set. Remove the cookies from the oven and let cool for about 10 minutes on the baking sheet before removing to a cooling rack to finish cooling.







Our new "birthmark" is: The "fruit" that Jesus is talking about, "is the Fruit of the Spirit". Galatians 5:22-23 The Holy Spirit

produces this kind of fruit in our lives: <u>love</u>, <u>joy</u>, <u>peace</u>, <u>patience</u>, <u>kindness</u>, <u>goodness</u>, <u>faithfulness</u>, 23 <u>gentleness</u>, and <u>self-control</u>. There is no law against these things!


Gardeners take heart, the heat and humidity that kept us inside while our weeds grew frighteningly tall, damaged our tomatoes, and fried our flowers will soon depart! See the side bar for optimal temperature range for growing tomatoes. The cooler temperatures following Hurricane Erin may give our tomatoes a chance to develop fruit again. This is also a good time to



prepare for fall plantings, clean out the beds, toss out the spent plants and refresh the soil with well-aged composted manure or new potting mix.

I have had wonderful results from using compost "tea". A couple scoops of aged compost in a half-barrel of water, left to soak for three or four or more days, will kill off any pathogens and pests and make the tea a highly absorbable natural nutrient boost to your plants. I have seen plants that have lost their leaves regrow new ones after watering with compost tea.

Remember to rotate your plants to avoid the buildup of nematodes or other root attacking pests. If you are wondering if you have nematodes, do this: Pull up a plant, rinse off the roots and examine them for root knots, bumpy knobs in the roots. Bumpy knots are a good indicator of nematode infestation. Some gardeners have found that after growing French marigolds and/or cauliflower, cabbage, broccoli, or



Osaka or Kodiak mustard greens, and then mixing their greens into the soil will deter nematode growth. Another method is to cover the soil under a plastic sheet for 3 to 5 sunny days to kill unwanted disease-carrying pathogens.

What seeds to plant in late August and September?
According to the SOW App you can now start these seeds: beets, Brussels sprouts, carrots, cauliflower, kale, Mexican kohlrabi, lettuce, tarragon (mint marigold), mustard, oregano, parsley, parsnips, rosemary, snap beans, and thyme.
Start your seeds in the shade in a moist soilless mix of peat moss, perlite and vermiculite, then when you see the second set of leaves growing, transplant into the garden or pot with fresh potting mix.






