

# MnDOT public comment period on long-range transportation plans



The roads we drive, the highways we depend on, and the way we move through our communities are all shaped by careful planning—and now, you have a chance to help shape that future.

The Minnesota Department of Transportation (MnDOT) is seeking public feedback on its long-range transportation plans for Region 5 and Region 7E, covering ten central Minnesota counties. The public comment period is open now through Thursday, Oct. 2.

Whether you're commuting to work, running errands, or enjoying the great outdoors, your transportation experience matters—and MnDOT

wants to hear about it.

The long-range transportation plans, developed in partnership with the Region Five Development Commission (R5DC) and the East Central Regional Development Commission (ECRDC), lay out a vision for transportation over the coming decades. The plans include goals, objectives, and strategies aimed at improving infrastructure, addressing community needs, and aligning with state and local priorities.

These plans are more than just maps and mileage—they reflect the values and voices of the people who live, work, and travel in Cass, Crow Wing, Wadena, Todd, Morrison, Mille Lacs, Kanabec, Isanti, Chisago, and Pine counties.

Earlier this year, MnDOT hosted an online open house to gather public feedback. That input played a key role in shaping the current draft plans. Now, MnDOT is circling back to the community for another round of input before finalizing the vision.

This is your opportunity to shape the future of transportation in central Minnesota.

Public comments will help MnDOT identify and prioritize future transportation projects—especially those involving major roads and highways.

Whether you're a lifelong flyer, an aviation enthusiast, or just someone who appreciates good food and friendly faces, this is the place to be.





At 6:00 p.m., the spotlight shifts to the world-famous Red Lake walleye fry, expertly prepared by Roland Hill — a meal that has become a celebrated tradition and a reason in itself to attend. Crispy,

golden, and locally loved, this walleye dinner is the stuff of northern Minnesota legend.

# Step back into divided Berlin

The rubble-strewn streets of postwar Berlin may seem a world away, but on Monday, Sept. 8, the past comes vividly to life at Heartwood Senior Living Community, 500 Heartwood Drive in Crosby at 1:30 p.m.

Unlimited Learning is proud to present Briana Smith in a thought-provoking session titled "Everyday Life in Cold War Berlin (1945-1948)." The program explores what life was really like for Berliners in the early years of the Cold War — a period known as the "Rubble Years." Admission is free for Unlimited Learning members and \$10 for nonmember.

Life among the ruins

Smith, a historian and Program Manager at the Osher Lifelong Learning Institute at the University of Minnesota, will guide attendees through a pivotal chapter of 20th-century history - from the collapse of Nazi Germany to the Allied occupation and the mounting tensions that led to the 1948 Berlin Blockade.

What makes this presentation truly unique is its human focus. Smith will share:

- Excerpts from the diary of a "rubble woman" — one of many German women who literally rebuilt Berlin brick by brick.
  - A U.S. Army training

video that offers an American perspective on postwar Germany.

 Song lyrics that reveal the cultural mood of a city caught between devastation and rebirth.

It's a powerful way to understand history—not just through dates and battles, but through the daily lives of people who lived it.

Smith holds a PhD in history from the University of Iowa and is the author of the acclaimed book Free Berlin: Art, Urban Politics, and Everyday Life (MIT Press, 2022), which explores postwar Berlin's transformation through art, politics, and public life.


