Friday, September 26th, 9:30 PM to 11:00 PM - OHS Homecoming Dance at OHS Commons.



Your Chance to Lead: Dickinson County Candidates Face September 18 Filing Deadline

Citizens of Dickinson County who are interested in running for local office in the upcoming November 4, 2025, city

and school election should be aware of some upcoming important deadlines. The official filing period for candidates seeking positions as mayors, city council members, school board members, or Iowa Lakes Community College trustees



opened on Monday, August 25.

In this upcoming election cycle, a total of 27 city council seats, six school board positions, and four seats on the Iowa Lakes Community College Board of Trustees are up for election in Dickinson County. All 10 mayoral positions across the county will be on the ballot for a two-year term. City council and school board members serve four-year, staggered terms. This means approximately half of the city council seats are up for election this year, with the rest to be decided in the November 2027 election. Similarly, school board and community college trustee terms are also staggered.

Candidates must submit their nomination papers to their respective city clerks or school board secretaries by 5 p.m. on Thursday, September 18. These officials will then be responsible for filing the paperwork with the Dickinson County Auditor's Office on Friday, September 19.





New Graduate Fellowship Established to Support Fisheries and Water Science Research in the IGL

A new endowed graduate fellowship has been created to advance research in fisheries biology, water quality, and watershed management within the Iowa Great Lakes ecosystem. The Edward Thelen Graduate Fellowship in Fisheries Biology and Water Science Research will provide funding and field opportunities for graduate students to conduct hands-on research in collaboration with the Iowa Department of Natural Resources and the Iowa Lakeside Laboratory, operated by the University of Iowa

Funded through the generosity of private donors, the fellowship honors Edward Thelen's career and contributions to the Iowa DNR, where he dedicated his life's work to maintaining, protecting, and enhancing Iowa's fisheries and aquatic habitat.

Partnership to Advance Science and Stewardship

The program will be jointly supported by the Iowa DNR's Fisheries Bureau and the Iowa Lakeside Lab, combining field expertise, scientific rigor, and local stewardship to address the most pressing fisheries and ecological questions in the Iowa Great Lakes region.

"This fellowship represents a remarkable opportunity to attract the brightest graduate students to our unique and valuable ecosystem," said Mike Hawkins, NW Regional Fisheries Management Supervisor with the Iowa DNR. "The Iowa Great Lakes are not only a natural treasure for our state but also a living laboratory for understanding aquatic systems. This program ensures that future scientists will have the resources, mentorship, and access they need to continue protecting these waters for generations to come."

The Iowa Lakeside Lab, located on the shores of West Okoboji Lake, has long served as a hub for research, education, and outreach in the region.

"By pairing the strengths of the DNR's field programs with the academic resources of Lakeside Lab, this fellowship will give graduate students unparalleled opportunities to conduct impactful research," said Mary Skopec, Executive Director of Iowa Lakeside Laboratory. "It's an investment not just in science, but in the future health and sustainability of our lakes, rivers, and watersheds.'

Focus on the Iowa Great Lakes Ecosystem

Participants in this new program will engage in projects addressing topics such as fish population dynamics, invasive species management, water quality monitoring, and watershed health. Research outcomes will inform conservation and management strategies for the Iowa Great Lakes and other freshwater systems in the Midwest.



Cyclone State, Again!

Well, it wasn't pretty, and it actually looked like a game that Iowa normally wins in the Cy-Hawk rivalry, but for the second straight year, a 54-yard field goal late in the fourth quarter (1:54) by Kyle Konrardy gave the Cyclones a victory over the Hawks, 16-13 on a beautiful football day at Jack Trice Stadium. It was Iowa State's first win over Iowa in Ames since 2011, but their third win in the last four games vs the Hawks, with them winning the last two games in Kinnick Stadium. This game always seems to come down to the fourth quarter, with 12 of the last 14 Cy-Hawk games being decided by 10 or fewer points, and this year's game did not trend away from the norm.

The script was flipped from last year's game where Iowa dominated early but couldn't put the Cyclones away, as Iowa State controlled the first quarter, but was only able to score two field goals and take a 6-0 lead. The momentum shifted on the last play of the first quarter when Iowa State's Xavier Townsend was run into on a punt by Iowa's Zach Lutmer. A flag was initially thrown for interference with the returner, but the flag was picked up as it was ruled Lutmer was blocked into Townsend, giving Iowa the ball in ISU territory. Iowa would turn the first turnover of the game into three points on a Drew Stevens 31-yard field goal to trim the lead to 6-3. The Cyclones appeared to take the momentum back when Jeremiah Cooper intercepted Mark Gronowksi, and returned it to the Iowa 18-yard line. Several plays later Rocco Becht would hit Ben Brahmer on a 3rd and goal play for a 2-yard TD to give ISU a 13-3 lead that looked pretty safe the way the Cyclones defense was playing against what looked like an inept Iowa offense. The Hawkeyes, however would not go away, and put together a very impressive 75-yard, 4:23 drive that ended with a 2-yard Gronowski run with just :27 left before halftime to trim the lead to 13-10 and give Iowa momentum back. Iowa State appeared to have the Hawkeyes stuffed on a 3rd and goal play with a sack of Gronowski, but was called for costly defensive holding and unsportsmanlike conduct penalties on the play, that gave Iowa new life and a first and goal at the ISU two-yard line.

The third quarter felt like Iowa football, and as an ISU fan, I did not like how the game felt. Iowa put together another impressive "Iowa" drive, going 77 yards in 16 plays, chewing up 9:28 of the third quarter to tie the game at 13-13 on a 36yard Stevens field goal with 4:32 left in the third frame. Iowa's defense stiffened up in the second half, forcing several three and outs for ISU, and the momentum was definitely in Iowa's favor. Fortunately for the Cyclones, ISU's defense was also up to the task as each team traded punts, and the only fans truly entertained were those who bet the under.

As a Cyclone fan, however, you do feel different about this year's team with Rocco Becht as your quarterback, and once again he came through in the clutch. Iowa State would take over after a deep punt from Rhys Dakin at their own 11-yard line with 8:14 remaining in the game. Becht would orchestrate a 55-yard drive that would chew up 6:20 and put the Cyclones in scoring position. The drive included some luck, as tight end Gabe Burkle made an amazing 17-yard catch on a 3rd down pass that bounced off the hands of wide receiver Xavier Townsend to Burkle who was drilled by Iowa safety Koen Entringer as he made the catch, but was able to hang on and extend the drive. Burkle made another spectacular 3rd down catch on a "pop" pass from Becht that took the Cyclones down to the Iowa 38yard line and helped set up the game-winning field goal. Iowa State was only able to muster one more yard on the next two plays, but Konrardy has the earned trust of head coach Matt Campbell and his teammates, as on 3rd and 9 ISU just ran a QB draw to put the ball in the middle of the field and set up the game-winning field goal. The kick, which was into a moderate wind, had just enough leg and gave the Cyclones a 16-13 lead with 1:54 remaining. Iowa did still have one timeout, and as we saw in last year's Cy-Hawk game, plenty of time left to pull out the victory. Those hopes, however, faded fast as Gronowski was sacked twice by Yale transfer Tamatoa McDunough for a total of 11 yards to set up a 4th and 15. Gronowski's 4th down pass then fell helplessly out of bounds and the Cyclones would take a knee twice to seal the hard-fought victory.

While I wasn't quite accurate with the final score, predicting a 27-21 Cyclone win, I am more than happy to have picked the winner correctly. As we sat in the parking lot and tailgated before the game with Cyclone and Hawkeye friends (yes I do have Hawkeye friends), and then sat in Jack Trice Stadium with mostly ISU fans, but also in front of some very nice Iowa fans, I couldn't help but think how fortunate we are in the State of Iowa to have two Power Four teams that constantly are on the national stage and are very competitive. This game for the third time in the last six years, had the eyes of the nation on it, with being the Fox Big Noon Kickoff Game, having the Fox Big Noon Kickoff Show and Barstool Sports Pregame Show live in Ames (ESPN Game Day has been in Ames twice). While we may not have a professional team, we have two very passionate fan bases and two very competitive football programs. I'm not sure where Iowa goes from here, they do need Gronowski to improve, as 83 yards passing isn't going to get it done in the B1G, but they showed again on defense that they will be good enough to be in every game. Iowa State showed, once again, that they are tough enough to win a game when they don't play their best, and they can win close games, having won eight of their last nine one possession games. The Big 12 has not looked overly impressive in the non-conference, as it looks like Iowa State, Utah and Texas Tech are the early head of the class in the league. Much can change during the season, but as long as the Cyclones can stay healthy, I really like their chances of making it back to Dallas for another shot at a Big 12 Championship. While I wouldn't place my mortgage on that bet, one thing I do know for sure, once again, it is a CYCLONE STATE!!

This week, I'd like to highlight a resource at the Spirit Lake Public Library that could be of use to you or someone you know who has vision problems: the Merlin Desktop Electronic

The Merlin offers the greatest picture quality available. Boasting an ergonomic design, this flexible desktop magnifier allows you to pivot and adjust the screen for your most comfortable viewing position. Merlin's screen easily pivots vertically and/ or horizontally to better accommodate peripheral or eccentric viewing. It lets people with low vision, macular degeneration, retinitis pigmentosa, glaucoma and cataracts read, write, and regain their visual independence.

With its low vision electronic magnifiers, many color select options are available for increased contrast. Depending on your eye condition, certain text and background color combinations allow for ease of reading. For example, one of the color selection options is black and white. It will convert anything you view to a black and white image for increased contrast.

The Merlin can also be used to magnify things other than books: mail, maps, needlework, crafts, photographs, recipes, coins, etc. I used it one day so I could remove a splinter from my finger! Stop by the library and try out the Merlin Desktop Magnifier!

Remember to check our book sale frequently ... especially the bargain books in the Community Room. That selection changes weekly! Our Back-to-School Special is still going on. fluoridate the city's water with their new water plant. These are some basic facts regarding water fluoridation: In May of 2025 the FDA announced its intention to remove

ingestible fluoride prescription drug products such as tablets and drops for children from the market. (FDA news release) Fluoride is a waste product from refining phosphate fertilizer.

(TimesofAgriculture.org) There is no way to accurately "dose" fluoride in drinking

water since people drink far different amounts. Fluoride is absorbed by the pineal gland which then disrupts the body's natural melatonin production. (NIH National Library of Medicine)

Israel, Japan, and most countries of Western Europe have discontinued water fluoridation. (Times of Israel)

Fluoride exposure is inversely proportional to the IQ of children. (JAMA Pediatrics January 6, 2025)

We need to remember that drinking water is *not* our only source of fluoride as fluoride is in our food, toothpaste, mouthwash, dental fluoride treatments, etc. Likely, we are consuming more

fluoride than what is healthy. Most fluoride in our municipal drinking water comes from synthetic compounds such as sodium fluoride, fluorosilicic acid, and sodium fluorosilicate and is not the same as fluoride occurring naturally from our lake or ground water. (National



We had fished together, golfed together, laughed with our families, and built memories that still make me smile. I knew him and his family very well. But here's the truth I wish I could rewrite: I never told him how much he meant to me while he was alive.

It can rob us of moments that matter most—words left unsaid, decisions postponed, conversations avoided. We all procrastinate. Sometimes it's because of fear, sometimes it's because of perfectionism, and sometimes it's simply

easier to do nothing. But here's the brutal truth: waiting rarely makes things easier. It usually makes them heavier. So how do we break the cycle? Here are five practical steps

you can take today:

1. Name the Real Reason You're Delaying

Be honest with yourself. Are you afraid of rejection? Worried about conflict? Or just overwhelmed? Naming the reason pulls the shadow into the light. Suddenly, it's not a vague dread—it's a challenge you can actually address.

2. Shrink the Task

Big projects — whether personal or professional — loom larger the longer we avoid them. Break them down. Instead of "finish the report," write the first paragraph. Instead of "call my sister to heal a rift," send a simple text: "Thinking of you." Small beginnings break inertia.

3. Use the 24-Hour Rule

If it's on your mind today, act on it within 24 hours. Make the appointment. Send the note. Have the tough conversation. Time is not guaranteed. My friend's passing taught me that with painful clarity.

4. Rehearse the Hard Conversation

Many of us avoid emotionally charged topics at work or home because we don't know how they'll land. Try rehearsing your opening line aloud. Often the act of speaking it-even privately—releases the fear and gives you courage to begin.

5. Visualize the Aftermath

Ask yourself: What relief or joy will I feel once this is done? Picture the clean slate, the reconciled relationship, or the problem no longer hanging over you. That positive picture can carry you through the discomfort of starting.

Procrastination is an internal battle, but its consequences spill into our external world. It can strain teams at work when deadlines slip, or distance us from loved ones when words remain unspoken. The antidote isn't perfection - it's action. Even the smallest step forward is a victory.

So let me ask you: Who do you need to call today? What conversation at work are you avoiding? What dream are you waiting to pursue "someday"? Make a list, prioritize things,

and get after it. Don't wait. Say the words. Start the work. Take the step. Because life is shorter than we think. And the cost of waiting
