PERFORMING WITH PUPPETS



Tumbleweed Smith

Kelly Draper of Llano says he has been around puppets most of his life. "I had toy hand puppets going to school and I would entertain with them there."

Marionettes, ventriloquist dummies and

hand puppets are completely different from each other. Kelly taught puppetry 24 years Tumbleweed Smith at Lamar University in Beaumont. He was part of the theater department. He got his first professional hand puppets when he was sixteen.

Wherever they wanted me I would go."When the Midland Symphony Orchestra did a concert featuring Prokofiev's Peter and the Wolf, it hired Kelly to do a puppet show to illustrate the story in the music. Then the Big Spring Symphony Orchestra did Peter and the Wolf and hired Kelly to perform with his puppets.

"Over the years," says Kelly, "I have performed all over the country with Peter and the Wolf. I even did it down in Mexico. When I went there, I had a limited number of puppets and puppeteers." Five people usually are required to work the puppets which Kelly made. He relates the story of Peter and the Wolf.

"Peter goes out into a meadow even though his grandfather told him not to go out there because a wolf was out there. Out in the Meadow, Peter meets a duck, a cat, a bird. Then the wolf shows up. There are hunters who are hunting the wolf, which eats the duck. The moral of the story is Peter learned to obey his grandfather."

Kelly did puppet performances for the Wizard of Oz and Alice in Wonderland.

"The Fort Worth Symphony hired me to do the puppet work for 'Twas the Night Before Christmas. I did that with a couple of other symphony orchestras."

He started making puppets while a college student. Some of the puppets Kelly uses in his orchestra performances are eight feet tall and take two people to operate them. He has kept up with advancments on his craft.

"I've been to several puppet festivals put on by the Puppeteers of America and had workshops with most of the major puppeteers."

When he performed at schools, libraries and the like, he would write the script, make the puppets and do different voices. He has two trademark puppets named Marvin and Sam who introduced shows and carried on humorous conversations.

"People would stop me on the street and ask me 'how is Marvin.' I thought to myself that I should tell the person Marvin wasn't real, but I know it was a compliment.

Kelly is retired now but remains active in the arts. He makes creative items and sells them at his booth in an antique mall in Marble Falls. His items sell fast.




