A SPECIAL VEHICLE IN COMANCHE

Tumbleweed Smith

A SPECI Bobby Lane of Comanche has a 1905 Cadillac.

"The Cadillac still runs good. Even though it's a hundred and twenty years old. I crank it up every morning when I get up. Before I eat breakfast, I go out there and crank it up 'cause one time I let it sit for about six months. It had a stuck valve on it. I

Tumbleweed Smith thought I didn't have time to mess with it.

I was lucky enough to find a mechanic that would help me get it running again. Of course, being one cylinder, it wasn't too complicated for a mechanic of any sort. I get it out in parades. It's a lot of fun. It's red with black fenders. There were only two color choices back in the day. Green and red."

His car was produced before the model T.

"Cadillac started in 1903 and there were big improvements every year. There's all the difference in the world between a 1903 and a 1905 Cadillac. They continued the one cylinder until about 1908. Then they went on to the four cylinder and on and on. Henry Ford worked with Cadillac in the early 1900s but Henry Ford didn't like the slowness of building those Cadillacs so he went on, thank goodness and did his thing with the assembly line and on from there with his model T."

The 1905 Caddy was not built for speed.

"It's got one cylinder, nine horsepower. On a straight road, it'll go about fifteen miles an hour."

It is a beautiful antique that has been in his family for

generations.

"It has a chain drive, got a chain in the middle of the back axle. It's got two forward gears, acetylene side lights and kerosene headlights. My great uncle bought it in 1910 in Denton, Texas when it was five years old. It originally belonged to Ann Sheridan's dad. She was a silent movie actress back in the day. Her dad had it for five years and decided to sell it. My great uncle had it for a while and ran it, but the bottom line is he put it up in a barn and in the late 50s, got it out, restored it and became a member of the horseless carriage club.

"My Dad and Granddad were always interested in it so when he passed away, it was willed to my granddad and when he passed away, willed to my dad and I ended up with it. Never thought that would happen so by the time I got it, it was in need of repair. It still would run, but it needed an overhaul so I went through a three-year process of getting it restored. Fortunately, I was in Dallas and knew a lot of the horseless carriage members that helped me do that. "

He keeps it in a rock house in Newburg where he lives. Bobby is chairman of the Comanche County Museum board and during celebrations like Frontier Days, he displays his glamorous car that sparkles like a jewel.

"I like that it's red. It's my favorite color. It shines up pretty good."




