#### 4th Annual Model Train Show in Spencer







Dear Tony, My son just started a new job. What advice would you give him to help him get off to a great start?

I've started 20 new jobs over 35 years and below are my top 10 pieces of advice from these experiences.

Work hard at your job and it will differentiate you. First things first. Take your career seriously and make sure you do great work at whatever you are paid to do. Don't be one of those who is always looking for the next job or the one who signs up for everything in the company except doing their job well.

2. Don't worry about who gets the credit. Bring so much value that no one will ever question your contributions. Focus on creating value, together, with everyone, and don't focus on what your contribution is. People who focus on who gets the credit tend to forget about the customer, forget about their teammates, and in general tend to gravitate toward a "me" centered view of the world.

3. Network as much as you can. Learn about different parts of the organization, formal and informal. Your life experience will be richer, you will enjoy the journey more, and you will be more effective and efficient in your work. Be careful not to over-do it.

4. Be curious. Seek to learn about other parts of the organization. Keep the mind open and always think broadly. Learn how the company creates value, how it operates in different market conditions, what works and what doesn't work in the culture, and how changes occur best. Think about how you can help drive positive changes in yourself, your co-workers, and your organization.

5. Realize you are always a work in progress. Peter Drucker suggests spending half your career switching careers to learn what you love, and the 2nd half doing what you love. I'm not sure about this ratio of half your life, but his point is a good one. Try some things out, take some risks in your career, especially in the first 15 years, and learn what you love by doing a few different things.

**6.** Go back to school when the time is right. This may be an advanced degree or MBA, it may be a specialized course on coding python, or it may be a course on Coursera or LinkedIn learning. The key is to advance your mastery, in combination

with work experience. 7. Seek formal communication training – presentation, writing, etc. Practice it (these skills are perishable). Learn how to communicate and organize your thoughts in 1 on 1 as well as group presentations. Join Toastmasters, get practice giving presentations, learn what makes effective communications. I received formal training early in my career from Dardis Communications out of Iowa City (www.dardiscommunications.com).

**8. Seek mentors** – who do you admire, who has been through some things you are interested in, and who can you learn from? Ask if they would spend 30 or 45 minutes sharing their experience. Come prepared with serious questions and don't waste their time.

**9. Give back to the community.** Get to know others not in your company. Be generous. Make it a habit. You will lead a more fulfilling life and you will enjoy the journey more. Not only is it good for the community, but it's good for the soul to be generous and help others.

10. Be grateful and always remember to say thank you. It's a basic courtesy to never forget - always say thanks to the people who have helped you.

**Bonus Tip** - Have a plan for your first 100 days. Learn from other's experiences, ask your boss what they want, ask co-workers, when possible, ask customers. When you think you are ready to set some objectives and get to work, use a framework to build a 100-day plan. There are a ton of tools on the web to do this, and many books as well. A good one is "Right from the Start: Taking Charge in a New Leadership Role" by Dan Ciampa. (https://a. co/d/2gQ8Fez)

Within the City of Spirit Lake, residential customers may dispose of items not normally picked up by the sanitation department.

SPENCER, IOWA - Spencer Economic Development Corporation (SEDC) and First Children's Finance (FCF) have released a Child

SPENCER ECONOMIC

Analysis and Strategic Plan for the Spencer area, outlining relevant child care data, child care market analysis, and FCF's key findings regarding care in the area.

SEDC

Care Market

SEDC contracted with FCF to perform a child care study to better identify and understand the gaps in child care services in the community. The study was paid for in part by grants received from the Iowa Economic Development Authority (IEDA), Iowa Area Development Group (IADG), and Iowa Rural Development Council (IRDC).

In February 2025, FCF and SEDC released three surveys to the Spencer community: one for parents, one for employers, and one for child care providers. The findings from these surveys were compiled into a single market analysis report.

According to the US Census Bureau in 2023, there are 6,053 total workers age 16 and older in the 51301-zip code, with 90% of families with children ages 0-5 and 92% of families with children ages 6-17 have all parents in the labor force. According to the study, over the last 12 months, parents have experienced child care challenges that have affected their job with 66% indicating the most common problem of having to leave work early. Employers indicated the same statistic.

Child care providers indicated lack of space in local programs with 79% saying they had turned away families or put them on a waitlist due to lack of space or openings in their programs in the last 12 months. FCF estimates there are 1,317 children in Spencer from families likely to use a regulated child care setting. According to Iowa Health and Human Services, there are 737 regulated spaces available during the school year and 529 regulated spaces during the summer, indicating a shortage of up to 580 spaces during the school year and up to 788 spaces during the summer.

"Many of us have heard or experienced the need for quality and affordable child care services in the community, but this market analysis from First Children's Finance has helped us put specific numbers to those needs," shared SEDC President Philip Ramstack. "Being able to walk through the results of the study, and work with other community members on a strategic plan to create more availability going forward has been a valuable exercise and tool to support our community."

After the market analysis, FCF led a strategic planning process, with a series of planning sessions held from April to July 2025. A total of 30 local individuals participated in the process, engaging in exercises to develop a vision for child care in the community, and goals and strategies to address the child care challenges identified through the child care market analysis.

Angie Duncan, Business Development Manager for First Children's Finance, presented the findings from both the Market Analysis and Strategic Plan to the Spencer City Council in a Committee of the Whole meeting on September 15, and to the Clay County Board of Supervisors on September 16.

The final step in the process with FCF is to create a financial model and budget projects for a local child care center project. This process is expected to wrap up in December 2025.



He graduated from Spirit Lake High School in 1983 and then pursued Financial Studies at Morn-



#### **Identifies Current Trends And Barriers** The Iowa Lakes Corridor Development Corporation (Cor-

ridor) has released the results of the recent regional Wage &

Benefit survey to identify current wages and benefits provided to a variety of occupations within the Corridor region of Buena Vista,



Clay, Dickinson, and Emmet Counties.

The Corridor contracted with the University of Northern Iowa Strategic Marketing Services (SMS) and Institute for Decision Making (IDM) to develop an online survey to assess local wages and benefits across industries including accommodation and food services; manufacturing; finance and insurance; professional, scientific and technical services; health care and social assistance; education; retail; wholesale; agriculture; construction; and transportation and warehousing. Responses came from 96 organizations across the region, with a majority (28.1%) representing the Manufacturing sector and 12.5% representing Health Care and Social Assistance.

44.2% of responding businesses were medium-sized with 20-99 employees. 32.6% were small with less than 20 employees, and 23.2% had over 100 employees. Most (29.5%) of the businesses had a gross revenue of \$1 million up to \$4.99 million.

The report breaks down starting and maximum estimated wages by both hourly and salaried employees in the various industry sectors. Hourly employees had an average standard annual wage increase in the last 12 months of 4.01%, whereas salaried employees saw an average increase of 3.16%. Both hourly and salaried employees have life insurance, health insurance, optional family health insurance and 401(k) or 403(b) matches as the top additional benefits offered.

Top-ranked amenities across the region were quality schools (50.5%), quality/affordability of houses (49.5%), lower overall cost of living (47.4%), low crime rate (38.9%) and outdoor recreation & leisure (35.8%). Businesses also identified a variety of recruitment barriers, including 64.2% saying there is a shortage of workers with the appropriate knowledge and skills they are looking for. The rural community location is also a major barrier (49.5%) followed by lack of affordable (20.0%) and available housing (17.9%), and lack of affordable childcare at 15.8%.

Top workplace opportunities and incentives included a casual work environment, vehicle allowance or mileage reimbursement, cell phone or reimbursement, flexible spending accounts and flexible work hours. 520 2nd Avenue East, Suite 2 Spencer, IA 51301 | www.

"Wage and benefit data like this is important for our local employers," shared Corridor President & CEO Curt Strouth. "Being able to identify current employment trends and barriers for growth assist us in developing programming and recruitment strategies for our region."
