TALK ABOUT BOUNDARIES

Dear Dave,

My husband and I are just starting to get control of our finances, but we have a problem. My dad has a habit of expecting us to buy things for him. I know he has money, but anytime he knows we're going to the store, he gives us a list of things he wants. If he's with us, he just throws things in the cart and expects us to pay. He acts like we have an obligation to do all this for him. I love my dad, but this has become annoying. What can we do?

Christina

Dear Christina,

I know you love your dad, but he sounds like the kind of guy who doesn't really respect boundaries. And these kinds of folks, as a rule, don't like it when they're suddenly confronted with them. Regardless, you need to have a firm but loving talk with your dad.

Let him know how much he means to both of you, but remind him that you and your husband are working hard to get into better financial shape. This means you can't spend more than is absolutely necessary. If he's hungry, have him over for dinner. If he just needs one or two small things, that's not such a big deal. But you're not obligated to pay his

way just because he's your dad. Like I said, he may or may not like this conversation. He may fuss and throw a little fit, but at that point it becomes his problem, not yours. Chances are he'll come around in a week or so, and after he gets over the embarrassment of it all, everything will be all right again.

You aren't an unloving or ungrateful daughter for not letting him run all over you. Talk to him in a kind, respectful way. If you feel you can't stand up to him alone, ask your husband to lend support or put a voice to your wishes. It's important that you're both on the same page with this issue.

IF IT'S PAID FOR, **DO YOU SELL IT?**

Dear Dave.

I'm debt-free except for my house. I make about \$120,000 a year, and I have a truck that's worth around \$33,000 and a car that's worth \$28,000. I don't have an emergency fund, so I was wondering if I should sell the truck to establish my emergency savings. Eric

Dear Eric,

A good rule of thumb is to never have more than half of your annual income tied up in things that go down in value. You're not quite there, but you're close. And I love your idea of wanting to immediately establish an emergency fund. You never know what life is going to unexpectedly throw at you, and an emergency fund is great insurance against that sort of thing.

Here's how I look at it. Nothing you've told me indicates that this truck represents anything being out of control. It's an expensive truck, but it's not like you make \$30,000 a year and have a \$33,000 truck. That kind of thing would be just plain stupid. But if you don't need or want the truck — and you're that passionate about having a big, instant emergency fund in place — then sell it!

NOT A DAY GOES BY THAT someone doesn't ask me, "How do I keep all this junk off my computer?" This is usually asked after the client pays us a respectable chunk of change to

clean up the mess they made of their computer. Examples of this junk include registry optimizers, fake antivirus software, driver updaters

and technical support software that trick many of you into calling "Microsoft" to fix a computer

problem that you probably don't even have. All these programs can slow your computer down and produce annoying pop-ups.

My honest answer to their query is, "I have no clue." In the old days, 5 to 10 years ago, the common source of this kind

of junk was peer-to-peer file sharing (the source of "free" music) and pornographic websites. Now days, it is more common that little old ladies come in with this kind of junk. They insist they are doing nothing more than playing the occasional online card game or basic word processing. I believe them when they say they honestly don't know. These little old ladies are rapidly supplanting grandchildren as excellent revenue generators for my business.

I suspect that most people are simply being tricked into clicking on stuff. For example, you may visit an online card game website and see an advertisement that says, "Your computer is SLOW! Click here to make it faster!" Click that link and you'll be seeing someone like me in no

Another way of attracting iunk is to download free software from various otherwiselegitimate websites. When downloading free software, you'll often run across a fake download link — or multiple fake download links — on the software's web page. You'll often find large, brightly colored

buttons with text like "Free Download" or "Download Now" while the legitimate download link is in very small text. These are often advertisement banners designed to mimic real download links, tricking you into clicking them and installing different software.

Another way of attracting junk is when trying to download the Java update. You find that McAfee Security Scan Plus or the uber-annoying Ask toolbar is bundled as a "free" product by default. Users who accept the default option or don't read it will end up with this additional software on their computers.

To avoid this sort of thing, be careful on download pages uncheck any additional software you don't want to install before downloading the intended installer. To remove the bad software, you'll generally just need to hunt it down in the list

of installed programs in the control panel and uninstall it. A particularly bad installer might pull in multiple junk programs that you'll have to remove.

A decent bit of software called MalwareBytes Antimalware will often remove much of the junk automatically. Get it from Malwarebytes.org.

Painfully Inadequate

Editor:

Imagine a community without adequate health

No emergency room, no local cancer treatments, no intensive care beds, no hospital to provide needed surgery in your local community. This is what could happen if a proposed plan on the table to drastically cut Medicaid funding is not reversed. The people of Chilton County didn't have to imagine it. Chilton Medical Center closed in 2012, leaving the county without a hospital. Citizens woke up one morning and the care was no longer available.

Think about what might happen in your community if the only hospital closed. Where would the child who broke his arm sliding into home go to be seen? Worse, where would someone go if they thought they were having a heart attack or stroke or if they were ready to deliver a baby? Driving to Montgomery or Birmingham might be an option for someone with a scheduled surgery, but it's not convenient. In an emergency, it's life

threatening.

In addition to the loss of health care access, the community would lose hundreds of good jobs and would likely have difficulty recruiting new businesses to the area ... all creating a devastating blow to the local economy.

That's why the people Chilton County overwhelmingly voted in favor of a one-cent sales tax to fund the construction of a new hospital in partnership with St. Vincent's Health System. Nobody likes taxes, but this sales tax was a necessary investment to ensure access to the level of care that only a hospital can provide 24 hours à day, 7 days a week. The people of Chilton County saw what life was like without access to care, and almost 80% of them voted in favor of the tax to support the new hospital. And Chilton County is not alone. Other areas such as Bibb and Randolph Counties have found similar ways to keep healthcare in their communities. People will sacrifice when it may make the difference between life and death for a loved one.

The voters in these cases did not want an Alabama without care, and legislators should take notice. The current Medicaid funding proposed in the General Fund Budget is painfully inadequate. Unless it's fixed with new revenue, some hospitals will have to cut services, cut staff, or close altogether. Why would any community want to find out what those in Chilton County learned the hard way? Concerned citizens should contact their legislators and urge them to fully fund Medicaid in order to ensure access to care in our communities.







ging is accompanied considered part of the aging process. Anemia is often a symptom of a hidden problem that needs to be addressed promptly.

Anemia is one of the most

common blood disorders, affecting more than three million Americans, says the National Heart, Lung, and Blood Institute. The Society American that Hematology notes anemia is characterized by insufficient levels of red blood cells in the blood. Anemia also occurs when red blood cells, which are responsible for carrying oxygen to the various organs and tissues throughout the body, are not functioning

properly.

Very often the signs of anemia are overlooked or go unnoticed until a blood test determines low hemoglobin (Hb) or hematocrit (HCT) concentrations. people discover they have anemia as they attempt to donate blood, at which time their red blood cell count is found to be inadequate. When the body lacks oxygen, any number of the following symptoms may be experienced:

- weakness
- dizziness
- extreme fatigue - shortness of breath
- fast or irregular heartbeat

- pale or yellow skin - cold hands or feet

existing Frequently, disorders or conditions, such as congestive heart failure, are made worse by anemia. But unless doctors specifically consider anemia as a possible cause of symptoms, its presence

can go undiagnosed.
The American Academy of Family Physicians says the most common causes of anemia among older men and women include chronic diseases and iron deficiency. Vitamin B12 deficiency, folate deficiency, gastrointestinal bleeding, myelodysplastic and syndrome are other causes of anemia.

The main way to treat anemia is to discover its source and reverse the outcomes. For instance, a gastrointestinal bleed may need to be repaired. If iron deficiency is the source of the anemia, iron supplements may be prescribed. Many methods to correct anemia involve trial and error and experimentation, especially when the source of the anemia is unknown.

Anemia is a condition that can affect aging adults but does not need to be accepted as a natural consequence of aging. Correct diagnosis and treatment can mitigate symptoms.





discuss men's outdoor recreational pursuits from the late 19th to early 20th century with much of the discussion being centered upon hunting. Ownby addresses how the meanings associated with hunting, freedom, and masculine identity have significance for the more recent history and the expansion in the fishing industry.

With TVA projects came a tremendous surge in opportunity for anyone with a boat to begin to chase fish. With an expanded public waterway system came greater opportunities to experience a newfound freedom in the great outdoors

According to Project Director John Agricola, Alabama Rigged: A Cultural History of Fishing in North Alabama promises not to disappoint as an exciting weekend activity for the whole family.

The first lecture delivered at the Guntersville Museum by a fly fishing professor at the University of Alabama, Dr. Michael Steinberg, was well-received. Steinberg discussed a broad history of fly-fishing and explained that there is room for growth in this sport right here in Alabama. This tracks the exhibit's focus, demonstrating a close parallel between art and fishing.







FAT CATS

Feline obesity is out of control. Here's how to get your cat back on track to a healthy figure

Then we at Pet Connection say "fat cats," we're not talking Wall Street bankers. The percentage of cats considered to be overweight (10 to 19 percent greater than ideal weight) or obese (20 percent or greater than ideal body weight) has reached a whopping 58 percent, according to a survey by the Association for Pet Obesity Prevention.

That makes excess weight the No. 1 nutritional disorder in cats. Carrying too many pounds is linked to a number of feline health problems. Obese cats are more likely to suffer a liver disease called hepatic lipidosis; feline urinary tract disease; diabetes; lameness; complications from anesthesia; and non-allergenic skin conditions.

What's the skinny on the increase in tubby tabbies? It may be as simple as a lack of recognition of what a healthy cat looks and feels like. A study published in the Journal of Feline Medicine and Surgery in 2010 found that nearly 34 percent of owners underestimated their cats' body condition score.

Body condition scores rank cats on a 5-point scale, with 1 being emaciated, 2 thin, 3 ideal, 4 heavy and 5 grossly obese. In a hands-on test, it should be easy to feel a cat's ribs and other prominent bones using light pressure. If your cat falls into category 4 or 5, it's time to institute a kitty weight loss plan to help him regain a slim, trim figure.

Start with a veterinary exam to rule out medical problems that might be causing the weight gain. A weigh-in establishes current weight so a goal weight can be determined.

Your first thought might be to cut back on the amount of food you give, but that just leads to a cat who is hungry and unhappy. A different food may be a better option.

Feeding a diet that swaps out carbohydrates for proteins appears to be useful for weight loss, says Margie Scherk, DVM, speaking on feline weight management at the World Feline Veterinary Conference in San Diego, California, last October. And be aware that even 10 extra pieces a day of kibble formulated for normal weight maintenance can cause a cat to gain a pound in a year. Measure food and give it at regular mealtimes instead of free feeding.

Diet is a big part of helping cats lose weight, but getting them moving is important, too. You might not be able to take your cat jogging or get him to walk on a treadmill, but there are plenty of creative ways to add exercise to your pet's life and at the same time provide a more stimulating environment.

An easy way to keep him moving while you're gone during the day is to divide the amount of food he receives daily into six or seven portions. Place each portion in a small container, and hide them throughout the house. Mix up your hiding places so he has to work to find his food each day.

Interactive play is also important. Use toys to encourage him to walk and run around the

house. Your cat is a predator, so focus on his love of stalking and chasing. Cats have short attention spans, so playtime of two to five minutes a few times a day is plenty. Since cats are nocturnal, you may find that he is more interested in being active after the sun goes down.

Introduce exercise gently and gradually. Cats who are overweight or obese can injure their joints if they do too much too quickly.

Most important, remember that prevention is best when it comes to obesity. Weight gain is more likely after cats turn 2 years old, so don't let them become sedentary as they mature. That's a heck of a lot easier than trying to change their eating habits or food after they have put on too many pounds.

Cats don't thrive on veggie diet

• Can cats be vegetarian or vegan? That depends on how long you want to have a cat, says Kristi Krause, DVM, a board-certified specialist in feline medicine. Cats, with their claws and teeth made for taking down and eating meat, are obligate carnivores, meaning they require certain proteins that can be obtained only from meat. Supplements don't contain enough of the essential amino acids cats need to thrive and survive. Cats who eat a diet that's not meat-based can develop vitamin and mineral deficiencies that affect bone and muscle development; an enlarged heart

from lack of taurine; and vision problems.
• Until recently, neuroscientists
believed that neurons such as the eye's photoreceptor cells did not regenerate after being damaged. But new findings from researchers at the University of Pennsylvania School of Veterinary Medicine showed that in certain forms of early canine blindness, photoreceptor cells in the retina continued to divide when puppies were between 7 and 14 weeks old. Further research will focus on genes involved in turning cells on to divide, in the hope of developing a therapy to interfere with cell death and retinal degeneration. It could eventually help not only dogs, but

also people with similar disorders.

• Rabbits are an age-old symbol of fertility, and for good reason. The furry breeding machines can produce six or more litters a year, with each litter containing five to eight kits (what baby rabbits are called). Do the math: That's at least 30 to 48 baby bunnies per year. During their breeding season, which runs from February to September, female rabbits are constantly pregnant. They can become pregnant again within 24 hours of giving birth. To prevent unwanted pregnancies, spay or neuter rabbits ASAP; they reach sexual maturity between 3 and

6 months of age.




