Clones are Lights out in White Out

Iowa State looked like a tired team who had traveled to Ireland to play a conference rival, traveled back to play a ranked FCS foe six days later, played their biggest rival a week later, then travelled to Jonesboro, Arkansas, have to drive an hour from their hotel to play in 100- degree heat, where they struggled to get by a mediocre Arkansas State team two weeks ago, 24-16. Fast forward past a bye week, into an electric, sold-out Jack Trice Stadium on a White Out night and this team looked like a completely different, energized group on Saturday night as the Cyclones destroyed previously unbeaten Arizona 39-14.

Iowa State took control of this game early, scoring on their



first drive after Rocco Becht hit Chase Townsend on a beautiful 45-yard catch and pass to the Arizona 1-yard line. Becht would push it into the end zone, and the Cyclones, who are now on their third string kicker due to injuries, would get creative on their extra point and actually hiked the ball to tight end Gabe Burkle who took it in for the two-point conversion to give ISU an 8-0 lead. Carson Hansen pushed the lead to 15-0 early in the second quarter with a 1-yard TD run and this time the Cyclones kicked the extra point with freshman walk-on Chase Smith drilling the extra point. Iowa State extended that lead to 22-0 on another Hansen TD run on a drive that was sparked by a big Becht to Brahmer 27-yard pass that moved ISU deep into Arizona territory after Jontez Williams had picked off a Noah Fifita pass and returned it to the Arizona 30. The Wildcats would finally get on the scoreboard at the end of the half to make the score 22-7.

The Cyclones quickly ended any thoughts of an Arizona comeback in the third quarter by scoring on the opening drive on another short QB sneak by Becht. The key play on this drive was another big pass to Sowell, this time 52-yards that moved the ball to the Arizona 38. The highlight of the second half was when offensive coordinator Taylor Mouser opened up the playbook and had tight end Benjamin Brahmer take a handoff and then pass to a wide-open Brett Eskildsen to the Arizona 1-yard line that resulted in Becht's third QB sneak TD of the night, pushing the lead to 36-7 and putting the game completely out of reach. Becht, Brahmer and Conner Moberly combined to go 15-22 for 288 yards against a defense that came into the night first in the nation in pass efficiency defense. Chase Sowell had the breakout game that Cyclone fans were waiting for with 4 catches for 146 yards, and Carson Hansen rushed for two touchdowns. The defense was very strong against a very good Arizona offense, picking off Fifita twice and limiting the Wildcats to just 14 points, 23 points below their average.

Iowa State moved up to #12 in the Coaches poll but somehow stayed at #14 in the Associated Press poll, which continues to show its SEC/Big 10 bias by having the entire Top 10 filled by those two conferences, even though the Big 12 went 8-6 vs the other Power 4 conferences while the Big 10 went 5-5. The Cyclones can't worry about the polls and just need to keep winning. What Coach Matt Campbell, his staff and these players have done is simply amazing. Iowa State is ranked in the AP Poll for the 50th week in the Matt Campbell era. The Cyclones had been ranked just 40 weeks total in the 80 years prior to that. Here's another crazy stat for you to consider; here are teams with 16 wins since the beginning of last season, Ohio State (18-2), Oregon (17-1), Penn State (16-3) and Iowa State (16-3), that's the list, that's it! The Cyclones will face a very tough test on Saturday when they travel to Cincinnati to face a 3-1 Bearcat team that is coming off an impressive 37-34 win at Kansas. ISU had some defensive injuries on Saturday and last week at practice lost cornerback Jeremiah Cooper for the season with a knee injury. Hopefully the injuries on Saturday are not serious, as the team was just getting back close to full strength before the Cooper injury. This is probably Campbell's deepest Iowa State team, and so far they have found a way to win the one-score games like last year's team did. If they can continue to do that, and stay healthy, this group could find themselves on the verge of another very special season. No matter what happens, Cyclone fans should definitely enjoy these times, for as Neil Diamond sings in the famed Sweet Caroline Cyclone anthem, Sweet Caroline these times are "so good, so good, so

Fall Harvest & Bake Sale

Helping people meet some of their food needs is the impetus behind the 18th annual Fall Harvest and Bake Sale, to take place Saturday, Oct. 4, from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. at Gary's Gardens, one block south of St. Luke's Lutheran Home in south Spencer.

A freewill offering will be taken for a bounty of fall produce, including potatoes, onions, several varieties of squash—including three different varieties of Butternut; Honeynut, Acorn, Delicata, Spaghetti and Buttercup; and more than 500 pumpkins for eating or decorating (including large flat 'stacker' pumpkins), along with gourds in all shapes and colors.

The produce will be pre-picked and available for pickup onsite, and baked goods will also be displayed and ready for purchase there. Children are welcome at this event. A corn shock will help further create a fall atmosphere, and a triple box wagon will be there for photo opportunities.

The event is organized and carried out by the Ruthven United Methodist Church, with proceeds going to their mission fund to help feed people locally, regionally and internationally, as much as they can.

Spokesperson Gary Holck said his own garden (measuring 100'x200') will help contribute to the produce sold, along with produce grown by their church members at their community garden spot in Ruthven.

Holck said they are aware of people who are elderly, live alone, or may be going through a rough time financially who could use a little help with food needs. Locally, more than 40 persons in and surrounding the Ruthven area are on their list of local recipients this year, and will receive "Smile Sacks." Smile Sack recipients receive one bag of food every six weeks or so, all year long. That project, funded by this fall event, was begun nearly a decade ago.

He said church members purchase and compile meat and grocery goods (cereal, eggs, cheese, peanut butter, etc.) for these sacks. He said some of the food is donated, and other foods are sometimes offered at lower prices, knowing the reasoning behind the purchase. If church members have fresh produce, they include that as well.

Holck said they also support other missions with the harvest and bake sale money, such as Head Start in both Clay and Palo Alto counties (since they have church members who reside in both counties), and internationally-based food support programs to help meet needs of people with food insecurity issues.

Ultimately, Holck said it's a harvest of goodwill, and that they hope to continue that again this year with proceeds from this annual fall event.

"It's a labor of love and helping people with needs," said Holck.

Dear Tony, Can you share a life lesson you learned earlier in your life that still impacts you today?

During my freshman year of college, I failed my first calculus exam. For someone who had always prided himself on hard work and good grades, the red ink across the top of that page hit me hard. My first reaction was to feel defeated—maybe advanced math wasn't for me, maybe college was going to be harder than I thought. But after a day or two of reflection, I realized I had a choice: I could let that failure define me, or I could take responsibility for it and change how I approached learning.

So I made a decision. I restructured my study habits, signed up for an additional support class, asked a friend to mentor me, and dedicated myself to understanding calculus rather than just memorizing formulas. The result? I went on to earn straight As in every advanced math class I took for the rest of college. That experience taught me one of the most important lessons of my life: I am responsible for my own outcomes. Life doesn't dictate the terms—I do.

This same principle of personal responsibility and agency applies to all of us, in every area of life. Here are several insights I've learned along the way:

1. Be 100% Responsible for Your Life

It's tempting to blame circumstances, other people, or even "bad luck" when things don't go our way. But true growth starts when we take full ownership. Being 100% responsible doesn't mean we control everything—it means we control how we respond to everything. That shift in mindset alone is life-changing.

2. Pause Before You Respond

Our world moves fast, and emotions run high. Yet one of the most powerful demonstrations of agency is the ability to pause. Pausing before we respond—to criticism, conflict, or challenge — gives us the chance to choose intention over impulse. In that moment, we move from being reactors to being leaders of our own lives.

3. Initiate, Don't Wait

Many people go through life waiting for something to happen: the right job, the right relationship, the right opportunity. But progress rarely comes to those who stand still. Initiative—taking the first step, sending the first email, starting the project before everything is "perfect"—is what creates momentum. Agency thrives on action.

4. Shift from "Life Happens to Me" to "I Create My Life" There are two types of people. Some live as if life is happening to them—they see themselves as victims of circumstances, powerless to change course. Others see themselves as active participants—they make decisions, set goals, and steer their future. The difference is not external; it's entirely internal. Which one we become is a decision we each must make.

5. Small Decisions Compound into Big Outcomes

Personal responsibility isn't only about the dramatic moments. It's about the small choices—how we spend an hour, what we eat for lunch, whether we pick up the phone to encourage a friend. Over time, these seemingly minor decisions accumulate into habits, and habits shape destiny.

6. Seek Help, but Don't Abdicate Responsibility

Asking for guidance isn't weakness—it's wisdom. My calculus turnaround began with admitting I needed help. But there's a crucial difference between seeking support and outsourcing responsibility. Mentors, coaches, and teachers can guide us, but we must walk the path.

7. Redefine Failure as Feedback

When we fail, we can either label ourselves as "not good enough" or treat failure as data. Every setback gives us information—what worked, what didn't, what needs to change. Failure isn't the opposite of success; it's part of the process.

8. Energy Follows Choice

The energy we bring to life—enthusiasm, perseverance, resilience—flows from the choices we make. When we choose to take ownership, we naturally invest more energy. We lean in. We fight harder. We inspire others. Our choices generate the momentum we need to keep moving forward.

9. Responsibility Creates Freedom

It may sound paradoxical, but the more we accept responsibility, the freer we become. When we stop blaming circumstances, we free ourselves from the chains of resentment and excusemaking. We reclaim the power to shape the life we want, on our terms.

10. Agency Is a Daily Practice

Finally, agency isn't a one-time decision—it's a daily practice. Each morning, we're given new opportunities to decide how we will live. Each evening, we can look back and ask: Did I take responsibility today, or did I let life just happen to me?

Stop drifting and start directing. When we lead ourselves well, we create the life we truly desire.





is nearly complete and many people have asked about crossing Highway 71. There will not be an official trail crossing at this location; however, trail users may use the

230th Street intersection to access either side of the trail. The Iowa DOT did not permit an official crossing, so the current setup is the best option available for now. While it may seem counterintuitive not to have signage or a designated crossing, the intent is to avoid giving motorists on Highway 71 the impression that they should stop for bicyclists waiting to cross. Responsibility rests with trail users: they have a stop sign and should only cross when it is safe to do so, just as any vehicle would at an intersection.

The benefit of aligning the trail crossing with 230th Street is that it leaves future opportunities open. One potential option is a tunnel under Highway 71, as the elevation differences could allow for that design, though funding will remain a significant challenge. Another option being discussed is continuing the trail north along the west side of 230th Street into Milford, a project the city is very interested in. Additionally, 230th Street west of Highway 71 is scheduled to be paved next year, which would provide another bike route into and around the west side of Milford.

There is no set timeline for either the tunnel project or the northern trail extension into Milford. However, once the trail connection to Clay County is completed, attention is expected to shift toward improving the crossing situation at 230th Street.





To The Editor: While Gov. Reynolds recently vetoed HF 639, it is clear that activists intend to push even more extreme anti-energy legisla-

tion during next year's legislative session. The table is being set for bills that will harm Iowa's energy landscape and undermine our ability to build critical infrastructure at a time when we need it most.

Six out of every 10 Iowa households use natural gas as the primary method of heating their home, and many more use propane for home heating, livestock buildings, and grain drying. Additionally, nearly 2.55 million gasoline-powered cars are registered here. With little naturally occurring crude oil or natural gas, this fuel is largely brought to Iowa by pipeline.

Pipelines of all kinds are vital for our state to thrive, including Iowa's biofuels industry. And yet, bills like HF 639 would make it harder, or even impossible, to build them.

Sadly, their supporters persist in spreading rumors and fear about this safe, necessary infrastructure. As energy usage rises, this is the wrong approach at the wrong time.

As we approach next year's session, the upcoming primaries, and the 2026 elections, I would encourage every Iowan to carefully consider each candidate's views on energy. We need leaders who will move Iowa forward and ensure that we can build a great future for our state.







Banned Books Week was launched in 1982 in response to a sudden surge in the number of challenges to books in libraries,

bookstores, and schools. Typically (but not always) held during the last week of September, the annual event highlights the value of free and open access to information and brings together the entire book community librarians, educators, authors, publishers, booksellers, and readers of all types - in shared support of the freedom to seek and to express ideas.

Banned Books Week for 2025 will be October 5–11. The theme for this year is Censor-

ship Is So 1984 — Read for Your Rights.

By focusing on efforts across the country to remove or restrict access to books, Banned Books Week draws national attention to the harms of censorship. The ALA Office for Intellectual Freedom (OIF) compiles lists of challenged books as reported in the media and submitted by librarians and teachers across




