#### HORSEHEAD CELEBRATION



#### Tumbleweed Smith

Kirby Warnock of Fort Stockton says a lot of people don't realize the history they've got in their own back yard. He knows some history of Horsehead Crossing on the Pecos River between the small towns of Girvin and Imperial. The river has steep banks making crossing it almost impossible. But people, **Tumbleweed Smith** wagons and horses can cross at Horsehead.

Five years ago, a celebration took place at Horsehead Crossing honoring the 150th anniversary of the Goodnight-Loving Cattle Trail that crossed the Pecos at Horsehead. People were dressed in pioneer clothing, there were chuck wagons and all sorts of period items. The celebration has continued for five consecutive years. The first couple of years it drew small crowds but over the years, more people have found out about it. Last year over 1,200 people attended. This year it'll be October 10th and 11th. There is no admission charge.

"People can experience living history. The Comanche dancers will be there because the crossing was on the Comanche war trail. We will be set up there at the second most iconic location in the state of Texas next to the Alamo. We've got a stage coach coming that will commemorate the Butterfield Overland Stage. People can take a stage coach ride. There will be lots of cowboys to commemorate the Goodnight-Loving Trail that the movie Lonesome Dove is based on. We've also got a cadre of cannoneers. They like it because they can't fire the cannons in the city limits and places like that but out there they can shoot their cannons as much as they want. Military units crossed at Horsehead.

"We'll have nine chuck wagons there. The chuck wagon was invented by Charles Goodnight when he went on that first cattle drive that crossed the Pecos. The chuck wagon people will prepare food on an open fire like old school and we serve everybody breakfast lunch and dinner. No charge, we just ask for a donation."

The group has formed an association with a board and obtained 501C3 status. Kirby, who handles publicity, says the area is sparse, no electricity or other things people are accustomed to. No bed and breakfasts. It Takes an effort to get there.

"In other historic sites like the Alamo there are all sorts of modern conveniences, buildings, a gift shop, etc. But out here you've just got to stop and listen to the quiet and imagine a big tribe of Comanches, the cattle drives, and even the Spanish Conquistadors. You kind of have to imagine that but there's a ton of history that crossed here. Visitors can come and get on the ground floor of Texas history."





#### Roy King

A visitation will be held from 5:00-7:00p.m. Wednesday, October 1, 2025 at Murray-Orwosky Funeral Home. Roy passed away peacefully Friday, September 26, 2025 at Carriage House Manor surrounded by his family.

Roy Wayne King was born on April 24, 1948 to O. B. and Lucille (Green) King in Dallas, Texas. When Roy was five the family moved to Brashear where Roy was raised. Roy married Yvonne Miller Glenn on April 12, 1985. They had 40 years of family, fun, laughter, and enjoyed working their cattle and farming together.

Roy was a religious man and loved Jesus. He accepted Christ as his savior when he was 16 and was baptized at Brashear Baptist Church. After attending SSISD graduating in 1966, Roy attended East Texas State University in Commerce and graduated in 1970 with a B.S. degree with a double major in Animal Science and Chemistry and a minor in Math. After graduation he worked for Governor Rockefeller Farms in Sulphur, Oklahoma on a feed yard. He pre-conditioned cattle daily and all vet work until he decided to return to Sulphur Springs to accept a position for Specialty Foods as a supervisor and head of the lab department.

In 1973, Roy went to work as a Dairy Inspector for the City of Dallas. He covered Hopkins County and surrounding areas and was an Inspector during the big dairy boom in one of the largest dairy areas of Texas. Later that year he also began dairying on his own dairy farm. Five years later he resigned from the City of Dallas in order to be a full-time large dairy farmer and hay producer. In 1985, he sold his dairy cows under the dairy buy-out program and increased his beef herd and custom hay baling business.

In 1989, he also began working as a Field Representative for Mid-America Dairymen and again covered Hopkins County and surrounding areas. Roy was employed by Mid America Dairymen for five years until 1994. He then took a position with Sabine River Federal Land Bank of Texas as an Agricultural Loan Officer.

In 1999, he was offered a position with City National Bank as a Vice-President Loan Officer and worked from 1995 until 2019, specializing in agriculture loans. He retired as a senior Vice President where he had continued to build his clientele and longtime friendships. Roy wasn't ready to retire but after developing Alzheimer's from a fall at his shop, he decided it was time to retire and focus on family and traveling with friends.

Roy is a former director of the Hopkins County Chamber of Commerce and past president of the Northeast Texas Livestock Association, Professional Ag-Workers, NETBIO, the Hopkins County Fall Festival, and director of the Hopkins County Civic Center. Roy enjoyed being a member of the Sulphur Springs Adult Leadership class, Martin Springs Water Board, was honored as Texas IBAT 2011 Banker of the Year and 2021 Hopkins County Agriculturist of the Year.

Together, Roy and Yvonne successfully combined six children, 13 grandchildren and 8 great grandchildren. They are long time members of First Baptist Church in Sulphur Springs. But most of all Roy was a Godly man who loved Jesus and loved his family. He was a quiet, gentle man, faithful friend, a man of honor and integrity, and a man of his word.


