Still, people weren't sure that Jay Wright, in his 15th season as head coach, had what it would take to beat North Carolina. None of the people at The Kibbitz Room over on Springdale could imagine that the next morning, over nova lox and bagels, they would be passing newspapers and recounting what was surely the best basketball game they had ever witnessed. "Kris Jenkins" and "Archie Diacono" (Ryan Arcidiacono, the tournament's outstanding player) schmeared right in with "Curry" and "Laettner" in conversation.

Yet, there they were, local rushhour traffic be damned. 'Nova over nova, highlights over pizza, and Jenkins over North Carolina. Suddenly everything was sunny in the Philadelphia suburbs. Villanova delivered.




