#### Tumbleweed Smith

Anthony Goodson of Garland was inspired to make movies after seeing a video a fourth grader made.

"It's funny. I was at a friend's house and she showed me a video her son had made. It was just a pair of shoes walking across the room by themselves. He did it

Tumbleweed Smith from a cell phone and simply used the and play controls to move those shoes. And from that moment I was hooked. I thought it was the most interesting thing. I knew that I might be on to something at that point."

He's working on two documentaries and a movie now. His first effort at film making was a documentary about integration at Sulphur Springs schools. He grew up there. "For about twenty years or more my dad would tell me about him being the first black person to be integrated in Sulphur Springs High School in the mid 60s, so I had that in mind for a long time. Finally, when I got to the point I could make a film, I thought why don't I just capture my own small hometown and let people know about the situation black students faced with when they were integrated."

That first movie got some recognition.

"I put it out to film festivals. It got to Hollywood a couple of years ago and I got to watch it on the big screen and had the chance to meet some producers. It also went to Atlanta and it went to New York and Dallas. It even went to Cannes, France, believe it or not. It did real well there, it was a finalist for some kind of award. I didn't go to France, though."

He showed it before a large audience in Sulphur Springs.

"We showed it on the night of Juneteenth in a park. There were thousands of people in the park. It was really cool."

Anthony studied broadcast journalism at Stephen F. Austin and worked in radio after graduation. Later he sold pharmaceuticals and now is full time in the hospice industry. But in his spare time, he makes movies. He also does a podcast Wednesday nights on U-Tube titled Rebrand Us. He did some serious research on integration.

"I did a lot of interviews, went to library, school and newspaper archives, went to people who had photos and even some movies from that time. The most Important thing for me was to get the truth out there. Mostly integration in Sulphur Springs was a smooth transition. There were just a couple of incidents but nothing major."

He says a lot of the modern equipment makes producing a film a lot more convenient than in earlier times, but it's still a lot of work, putting thoughts together, facts and historic file footage and photos together. He spent 18 months working on the film.


