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
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


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HOW LONG IS THE TRIP





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CABBAGE SALAD

Ingredients Dressing:

- ½ cup vegetable oil
- ½ cup white sugar
- ¼ cup wine vinegar
- 1 tablespoon soy sauce
- Salad:
- 2 (3 ounce) packages ramen noodles (without flavor packets), lightly crushed
- 1 cup sesame seeds
- ½ cup slivered almonds
- 1 head napa cabbage, chopped
- 1 bunch green onions, chopped

Directions

- 1. Make the dressing: Whisk oil, sugar, vinegar, and soy sauce together in a bowl until sugar dissolves. Refrigerate until needed.
- 2. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F (175 degrees C).
- 3. Spread broken ramen noodles onto a baking sheet with sesame seeds and almonds.
- 4. Bake in the preheated oven, stirring often and watching carefully to prevent burning, until lightly browned, about 15 minutes. Remove from the oven and let cool for 5 to 10 minutes.
- 5. To serve, mix cabbage, green onions, and toasted ramen mixture together in a salad bowl until thoroughly combined. Add dressing and toss to coat.

POUND CAKE

Ingredients

- 1 lb butter, softened
- 3 cups sugar
- 6 eggs
- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- ¾ cup milk
- 1 teaspoon almond extract
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract

Directions

- 1. Cream the butter; gradually add sugar, beating at medium speed of an electric mix until light and fluffy.
- 2. Add the eggs, one at a time, beating after each addition.
- 3. Add the flour to butter mixture alternately with the milk, beginning and ending with flour mixture.
- 4. Mix after each addition.
- 5. Stir in almond and vanilla extracts.

- 6. Pour the batter into a greased and floured 10-inch tube pan.
- 7. Bake at 300 degrees for 1 hour and 40 minutes or until a wooden pick inserted in the center of the cake comes out clean
- 8. Cool in pan for 10 to 15 minutes.
- 9. Remove to wire rack.
- 10. Cool completely.

VEGETABLE CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 1. Nonstick cooking spray
- 2. 12 oz.frozen mixed vegetables
- 3. 2/3 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 4. 2/3 cup mayonnaise
- 5. 2 cloves garlic
- 6. 1/4 tsp. ground black pepper
- 7. 3/4 cup crushed crackers
- 8. 2 Tbsp. salted butter

Directions

Prep Pan

- 1. Preheat oven to 350°F. Coat a 2-qt. square baking dish with nonstick cooking spray.
- 2. Mix Ingredients: In a large bowl combine frozen mixed vegetables, shredded cheddar cheese, mayonnaise, minced garlic, and ground black pepper.

Make Topping

1. Spread vegetable mixture in prepared baking dish. In a small bowl combine crushed crackers and melted salted butter; sprinkle over vegetable mixture.

Bake and Serve

1. Bake until golden brown and bubbly, 30 minutes. If you like, top with additional crushed and/or whole crackers.

GREEN BEAN CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 6 strips bacon
- 1/2 yellow onion (finely diced)
- 1 1/2 cups chopped button mushrooms
- 3 cloves garlic (minced)
- 2 (10.5-ounce) cans cream of mushroom soup
- 1/4 cup milk
- 1 cup shredded Monterey Jack cheese
- salt and pepper
- 4 (14.5-ounce) cans cut green beans (drained)
- 1 1/2 cups French fried onions





Instructions

- Preheat the oven to 350°F and lightly spray a 9X13-inch baking dish with nonstick cooking spray.
- 2. In a large skillet, cook the bacon over medium low heat until crisp. Remove to drain on paper towels, then crumble. Drain away all but about 2 tablespoons of the bacon grease, then return the pan to medium heat. Add the onions and cook, stirring occasionally, about 5 minutes or until translucent.
- 3. Add the mushrooms and cook, stirring occasionally, for 5 minutes or until the mushrooms are golden brown. Add the garlic and cook for 1 minute, or just until fragrant. Stir in the undiluted mushroom soup and add the crumbled bacon back. Stir to combine. Stir in the milk and cheese. Stir until the cheese is melted. Add salt and pepper to taste. Fold in the green beans until well combined.
- 4. Pour the mixture into the prepared dish. Top with the fried onions. Bake, uncovered, for 30 minutes or until the casserole is hot and bubbly.

POTATO CASSEROLE

Ingredients

- 1 (8 ounce) block cream cheese,
- 1 cup cottage cheese
- 1/2 teaspoon onion powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 sleeve Ritz crackers, crushed (32 crackers)
- Fresh parsley or chives, chopped for garnish
- 1 (10.5 ounce) can cream of chicken soup
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1/2 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1/4 teaspoon pepper
- 1 (32 ounce) bag frozen diced hash brown potatoes, thawed
- 1/4 cup butter, melted

Instructions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 375°F (190°C). Lightly grease a 9x13-inch baking dish with cooking spray.
- 2. In a large mixing bowl, blend the cream cheese until smooth. Scrape the bottom and sides of the bowl and mix in the cream of chicken soup, cottage cheese, sour cream, onion powder, garlic powder, salt, and pepper.
- Stir until well combined. Taste and adjust the seasoning as needed.

- 4. Gently mix in the shredded cheese and diced potatoes until evenly combined. Then, spread the potato mixture into the prepared baking dish.
- 5. In a small bowl, mix the crushed Ritz crackers with the melted butter. Sprinkle the buttery cracker mixture evenly over the potatoes.
- 6. Bake uncovered for 50–60 minutes, or until the top is golden and the edges are bubbling.
- 7. Remove from the oven and let rest for 5-10 minutes. Sprinkle with fresh parsley or chives, serve hot, and enjoy!

STUFFING

Ingredients

- 1 cup dried apricots
- 1 cup orange liqueur
- 1/2 cup butter
- 1 cup onion
- 2 stalks celery
- 2 clove cloves garlic
- 1 Tbsp.fresh thyme
- 1lb. spicy Italian sausage
- 12 oz. Italian bread
- 2 cups Gouda cheese
- 1/2 cup slivered almonds
- 4 large large eggs
- 2 large egg yolks
- 2 cups whole milk
- 1 cup heavy cream

Directions

- In a small saucepan combine apricots and orange liqueur. Bring to boiling; remove from heat. Cover and let stand at room temperature overnight. Drain apricots; reserve liqueur.
- 2. Grease a 3-qt. baking dish. In a 10-inch skillet melt butter. Add onion and celery; cook and stir over medium-high 5 minutes. Add garlic; cook 1 minute. Stir in thyme and 1/2 tsp. salt. Transfer mixture to an extra-large bowl. In same skillet brown sausage; drain. Add sausage to onion mixture. Stir in bread cubes, cheese, almonds, and apricots. Spoon mixture into prepared dish.
- 3. In a bowl whisk together remaining ingredients, 1/2 tsp. black pepper, and 2 Tbsp. of the reserved liqueur. Pour over mixture in dish. Cover and chill at least 4 hours or overnight.
- 4. Preheat oven to 325°F. Bake 55 to 65 minutes or until a thermometer registers 165°F. Let stand 15 minutes.


5:12). That's why we aren't always satisfied with what we have.




Greetings Gardeners!

This time of year brings many of the most beautiful and endlessly diverse tiny flying creatures we call pollinators, which our Creator has provided to help spread fruitful new plant life to our food supply and flower gardens. In one tiny corner of our yard grows a beautiful patch of pinkish/lavender October daisies which are attracting clouds of these various pollinators.

One evening I watched with delight as several groups of tiny orange butterflies, fluttering in groups of three, hovered over those daisies. We also keep a birdbath freshened daily, which is a respite for many of the pollinators, including bees, due to the months-long drought we have been experiencing here in this area.

According to the Alabama Extension's SOW app, fall

and winter veggie seeds that will grow well now are: chives, garlic, garlic chives, kohlrabi, onions, parsley



and radishes. Strawberry, collards, and kale and lettuce transplants can go in the ground now, too. Cilantro prefers temps below 80° .

The Wiregrass Master Gardeners will be hosting a Lunch and Learn at the Dothan Main Library on November 19th at 12 noon with Barbara Jowers on how to make "Natural Decorations" for the holidays. Last year Mickey and Debbie Breedlove demonstrated ways to create beautiful natural decorations with greens from our own yards, which were less costly and more personable and appealing than store-bought!
