
Heartbreak Again for Hawks

It looked like the streak was finally going to end in the pouring rain on Sunday night in Kinnick Stadium. It looked like Iowa was going to get their first win against a ranked team since October 9th, 2021, after quarterback Mark Gronowski had scampered in from the 3-yardline on a fourth and goal play to put Iowa ahead 16-15 with just 1:51 remaining. However, heartache once again happened for this Iowa football team, as they lost their third game of the season in the final 2:00 when Atticus Sappington drilled a 39-yard field goal to give #9 Oregon a hard-fought 18-16 win over Iowa in front of 69,250 drenched, stunned and

silent Hawkeye fans. This game sadly mirrored Iowa's other two losses to ranked foes this season; a 16-13 loss to then #16 Iowa State, where the Cyclones' Kyle Konrardy booted a 54-yard field goal with 1:52 remaining to break the Hawkeyes' hearts, and then a 20-15 loss to then #11 Indiana where the game was tied at 13-13 with 1:29 remaining before Indiana took the lead on a 45-yard touchdown pass. In all three of Iowa's losses, they have battled ranked foes oh so close, only to come up with oh so painful losses. These losses all follow a similar pattern with Iowa falling behind early, rallying to either tie the game or take a late lead, and then the defense being unable to hold on a late drive. You have to give the offense credit in this game as there were several times that I thought they were out of the game, but each time they responded with clutch drives. The first was when Oregon took a 9-0 lead after a safety on an errant snap on a punt caused by a wet ball during the rainy weather and a 19-yard Dierre Hill TD run. Iowa responded with a clutch 75-yard drive that was capped off by a 3-yard Grownowski to DJ Vonnahme TD pass to trim the lead to 9-7. Grownowski then orchestrated what I thought would be his defining moment as a Hawkeye quarterback with a masterful 93-yard touchdown drive that included a 40-yard pass against the nation's #1 pass defense to Vonnahme on third and seven from their own 10-yard line. Later, facing a fourth and three and the game on the line, Grownowski hit Central Lyon alum Reece Vanderzee for a 15-yard gain to keep the drive alive. Grownowski would later waltz into the endzone untouched to give Iowa their first lead of the game and send Kinnick Stadium into a complete frenzy, only to have Sappington sap that energy out of the stadium with his 39-yard field goal with just :03 remaining.

This heart-breaking loss ends Iowa's chance of making the College Football Playoffs and a shot at a B1G Championship Game appearance, but I don't expect the Hawkeyes to fold up their tents and cash in their season. Iowa is definitely playing their best football of the season, as they continue to improve each week, and they will get another opportunity to end their streak of losses to ranked foes on Saturday as they travel to Los Angeles to battle #19 USC. Who knows, maybe this game will have a Hollywood ending instead of a Heartbreaking ending for the Hawkeyes?



Iowa Lakes Music Department Hosts Winter Recital



A Pioneer's Constitution -History LIVES! with John Sandy

Wednesday, November 19 at 7:00, Judge John Sandy, Spirit Lake native and member of the Iowa Court of Appeals, will present "A Pioneer's Constitution" as part of the Dickinson County Museum's History LIVES! speaker series.

Judge Sandy says, "Iowa's constitutional story starts on the prairie, not in a marble courthouse. When settlers first came into what would become Dickinson County in the 1850's, they were carving out lives in a place where winter could kill you, where cabins were rough, and where the nearest formal court was far away. Families settled around Spirit Lake and Okoboji because the land was beautiful and promising, but they also knew it was dangerous. In that setting, people couldn't afford chaos. So even before the state built courthouses, the settlers built order."

Sandy continues, "That order was guided by a belief in fairness and self-governance. That spirit shaped the Iowa Constitution of 1857, drafted by ordinary citizens who made equality its foundation. Even in local disputes over fishing rights or lake access in Okoboji, the constitutional command for uniform laws took real form – rules applied equally to all. The story of Dickinson County and the Iowa Constitution is ultimately one of endurance: pioneers who demanded justice in their daily lives, and generations who have renewed that promise so that "free and equal" remains not only words in law but the lived ethic of Iowa itself."

Judge Sandy is an outstanding speaker and educator. This presentation is not to be missed! All are welcome – no charge, but donations are appreciated to support current and future programs at the Dickinson County Museum. Judge Sandy's presentation will also be live-streamed.





The Gallery at Arts on Grand on Thursday, November 13. The special author event is scheduled to begin at 5:30 PM.



In every corner of the business world, competence is the quiet current that carries everything forward. It doesn't demand attention, yet when you encounter it, you instantly know. So, this week, take inventory of your craft. Where can you grow? What skill can you improve? What habit can you sharpen? The world needs more people who take pride in doing things well.

Because competence isn't just about being good at something. It's about honoring the work, honoring the people you serve, and honoring the potential within you. And when you do that, the world always notices.







Eat Well Every Day!

Food as Medicine-Let Food be thy medicine. The food you eat can either be the safest and most powerful form of medicine, or the slowest form of poison. Every time you eat or drink, you are either feeding disease or fighting it. Define food as medicine: Prioritizing food in an individual's health plan with the goal of preventing, reducing the symptoms of, or reversing the disease state. Medical Nutrition Therapy is as follows: Evidence-based clinical health practice that uses a food plan for the management of disease. Because the evidence is so good, and a visit to the dietician to set up this plan can be reimbursed by Medicare, Medicaid, and private insurance plans. Go now and get a food plan!!

The Mediterranean Eating Style is well prescribed. Vegetables: 2 per day, at least one green. Phyto-nutrients Bioactive. It's the color! Anti-inflammatory, anti-oxidant, anti-diabetic, anti-tumor, anti-hypertensive, neuro-protective, and more. Vitamins and Minerals. Necessary for metabolic processes. Necessary for neurotransmitter production.

Olive oil-Mostly monounsaturated fatty acids, which reduce inflammation, unlike polyunsaturated oils. Multiple phytonutrients to benefit gut health and brain health. Best used as a condiment and only at low heat. Extra virgin cold-pressed is the best.

Fruit-5 per week. Deep red, blue, or purple is the best. Look for the special blueberries that are natural from your area and not the big plump kind. Whole grains: 3 or more servings daily. Sourdough bread is

very good. Whole grains have all three parts of the grain. Fiber feeds our microbiome and helps bind environmental toxins. Gives consistency to stools. Examples are oats, whole wheat, brown rice, quinoa, whole cornmeal, etc.

Choose protein sources wisely! Beans, nuts, eggs, yogurt, cheese and chicken. Eggs curb your appetite longer. Navy beans every day is good. Protein is filling.

Eat trash food less than 5 per week-They cause inflammation to brain and body. They contribute to poor gut health, they lack adequate nutrients, and increase food craving. "You cannot eat just one potato chip!" So, it is best to have no sugar, no fat, and instead have oatmeal with cinnamon and honey.

Supper options: Salmon, roasted potatoes, and asparagus with melon. Navy bean soup, crust whole wheat grain bread, spinach salad with tomatoes and feta cheese, topped with olive oil and balsamic vinegar, and tart cherry juice.

Whole grain noodles, marinara, roasted zucchini and mushrooms, Parmesan cheese, big green salad, and red wine. Day 4 eat seasoned baked chicken, sweet potato, and roasted Brussels sprouts with raisins. You can use frozen vegetable.

Breakfast options. Day 1-Oatmeal with cinnamon, berries, walnuts and flax seeds, plus a dash of Greek yogurt topped with raw honey and cup of black coffee. Day-2 let's eat the following: Omelet with omega-3 eggs and vegetable like spinach, onions, tomatoes, and half pepper with a couple slices of whole wheat toast topped with peanut butter and side of purple grapes. Next day, eat the following: Buckwheat pancakes with blueberries topped with cinnamon, applesauce, fresh turkey sausage and V8 juice. Next day eat whole wheat toast with avocado slices, Swiss cheese, drizzled with olive oil (1 tsp.) and topped with

red pepper flakes plus a fresh orange. Bran flakes are okay. Lunch options are as follows: Chicken tacos on a corn tortilla topped with fresh cilantro, tomato, and onion. Add a side of brown rice and seasoned black beans. Day 2 have vegetable and barley soup with cottage cheese and pineapple. Day 3 have green salad and vegetables topped with olive oil and light balsamic vinegar. Have a good tuna choice in water, whole grain crackers, and a dish of strawberries. The next day, have the following: a Peanut butter and banana sandwich on whole wheat bread. Add sides of carrots, cucumbers, and celery sticks with hummus for dipping. Finish with an apple.

Need a snack if you get hungry? Jolly Time popcorn is very good and healthy. Make up a mixture of raisins, peanuts, dates, cashews or pecans, and dried apricots and have ready for that snack time in between meals. Apple slice dipped in almond butter. Whole grain crackers with guacamole, Fresh vegetables with hummus. A cup of green tea. 1 ounce of dark chocolate. A cup of fruit with strawberries, blueberries, blackberries, and a small ginger snap cookie.


