



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
HOLIDAY FRUICAKE COOKIE

50 Cookies Ingredients

- 1 cup salted butter softened
- 2 cups brown sugar packed
- 2 large eggs
- ½ cup buttermilk
- 1 teaspoon vanilla
- 3½ cups all purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking soda
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- ½ teaspoon ground cinnamon
- ¼ teaspoon each : ground clove and nutmeg
- 2 cups candied cherries cut in half
- 2 cups dates chopped
- 1½ cups pecans chopped
- optional pecan halves for the top of cookies

Directions

- 1. Preheat the oven to 400°. Line a cookie sheet with parchment paper.
- Cream together the butter and sugar, about 2-3 minutes. Add the eggs one at a time and mix for another minute.
- 3. Pour in the buttermilk and vanilla and mix another minute.
- In a separate bowl or on a piece of parchment paper, sift together the flour, baking soda, salt, cinnamon, clove and nutmeg.
- 5. Add the flour a little at a time to the cookie dough mixture, just until combined.
- 6. Chop the cherries, pecans and dates.
- 7. Stir/Mix in the candied cherries, dates and chopped pecans.
- 8. Drop the dough onto the parchment lined baking sheet, about a heaping tablespoon each.
- 9. If using the pecan half, place on top of each cookie, pressing down to adhere and spread the cookie a little.
- 10. Bake for 9-11 minutes.
- 11. They will be done when the very outside edge is just starting to turn golden. They are a very soft cookie due to the brown sugar, so they will seem under done in the center, but will firm up as they cool.



- 13. Let the cookies sit on the hot baking sheet for an additional 5 minutes, then transfer to a cooling rack to cool the rest of the way
- 14. Store cookies at room temp for up to 5 days.
- 15. Divide the layers of cookies with some parchment paper or waxed paper

CREAM CHEESE CHRISTMAS COOKIES 8 dozen cookies Ingredients

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 1 (8-oz.) pkg. cream cheese
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1/2 tsp. vanilla extract
- 2 1/2 cups allpurpose flour
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 1/2 tsp. salt
- 1/2 cup green sugar crystals
- 1/2 cup red sugar crystals
- 1 cup pecan halves

Directions

- 1. Cream together the butter and cream cheese. Add sugar and vanilla; beat until light and fluffy.
- 2. Combine the flour and salt; gradually add to creamed mixture, beating until well blended. Stir in chopped pecans. Cover bowl with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 15 minutes.
- On four sheets of parchment paper, shape dough into four 6-inch rolls, 1 1/2 inches in diameter. Wrap each roll tightly in foil and refrigerate over night.
- Preheat oven to 325°F (165°C). Line cookie sheets with foil. Remove rolls of dough from refrigerator one at a time. Coat each roll with red or green sugar crystals; cut dough into 1/4-inch slices.
- Place on prepared cookie sheets; top each cookie with a pecan half. Bake for 15 to 18 minutes or until bottom of cookie is lightly browned when lifted.

BUTTER PECAN COOKIES

24 Servings Ingredients

- 1 cup salted butter
- ½ cup light brown sugar
- ¼ cup sugar
- 1 tsp vanilla extract



- 1 large egg
- 2½ cup all purpose flour
- ½ cup toffee bits
- ½ cup pecans chopped

Directions

- In a large mixing bowl add the room temperature butter and sugars. Beat or mix together until combined.
- 2. Add in the vanilla extract and egg. Mix to combine.
- 3. Stir in the all purpose flour. Fold in the toffee bits and chopped pecans.
- 4. Divide the cookie dough in half. Lay a piece of plastic wrap on the counter. Place one half of the cookie dough on the plastic wrap. Using the plastic wrap, roll the dough into a long round shape. Roll it against the counter to get the dough compact and round. Make sure the cookie dough is completely wrapped in the plastic wrap and place in the fridge to chill. Do the same with the second half of the shortbread cookie dough.
- 5. Chill the cookie dough for at least 2 hours. Preheat the oven to 350 degrees.
- 6. Remove the cookie dough from the refrigerator and remove the plastic wrap. Using a large knife slice the cookie dough into 1/2 inch rounds.
- 7. Place the shortbread cookie rounds on a large baking sheet that is lined with a silicone baking mat or parchment paper.
- 8. Press the edges of the cookies in to smooth out from cutting.
- 9. Bake the cookies for about 12-14 minutes until cooked through. Cookies will be slightly golden on the outside. They will not spread much or rise.
- 10. Store the cookies in sealed containers at room temperature.

BUTTERSCOTCH PUDDING COOKIES

18 cookies Ingredients

- 1 (15.25 ounce) box butter golden cake mix
- 1 (3.4 ounce)
 package instant
 butterscotch pudding
 mix



- 1/2 cup melted salted butter
- 2 large eggs
- 1 cup butterscotch chips

Instructions

1. Preheat the oven to 350 degree F and line two baking sheets with parchment paper.

- 2. In a large bowl, combine the cake mix, pudding mix, melted butter, and eggs. Mix until well combined and a thick dough forms.
- 3. Fold in the butterscotch chips until evenly distributed throughout the dough.
- 4. Scoop about 2 tablespoons of dough for each cookie and place them on the prepared baking sheets, leaving space between each.
- 5. Bake for 10-12 minutes, or until the edges are set and the tops look slightly underbaked to keep them soft and chewy.
- 6. Let the cookies cool on the baking sheet for 5 minutes, then transfer them to a wire rack to cool completely.
- 7. Store the cookies in an airtight container at room temperature for 3-4 days.
- 8. The cookies can be frozen for up to 3 months in an airtight container or freezer bag. Thaw at room temperature before serving

OATMEAL CRANBERRY COOKIES

6 Dozen Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup butter, softened
- 1-1/2 cups sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon baking soda
- 2 cups quick-cooking oats
- 1 cup raisins
- 1 cup coarsely chopped fresh or frozen cranberries
- 1 tablespoon grated orange zest
- 1 package (10 to 12 ounces) white baking chips

Directions

Cool on wire racks.

In a large bowl, cream butter and sugar until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Beat in vanilla. Combine the flour, baking powder, salt and baking soda; add to the creamed mixture. Stir in the oats, raisins, cranberries and orange zest. Stir in baking chips. Drop by rounded teaspoonfuls 2 in. apart onto greased baking sheets. Bake at 375° until the edges are lightly browned, 10-12 minutes.



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

Love God with all our heart, with all our soul, and with all our mind.




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fool gives full vent to his spirit, but a wise person quietly holds it back." These verses emphasize managing anger in a Godly manner.



Claybank Master Gardeners December 2025

The carefully planned historical gardens of several of America's Founding Fathers were the subject of a fascinating presentation by Wiregrass Master Gardener Yvonne Hines during our November meeting. We learned that the United States was built as an agrarian society from its earliest beginnings.

George Washington's Mount Vernon gardens included orchards producing apples, pears, peaches, and apricots, some grown on espaliers against the brick walls of the homestead.

Thomas Jefferson's original maps for his gardens at Monticello were recently found and now his famous homestead is being redesigned to match his original plans. His vegetable gardens included 330 different varieties of plants along a 1,000-foot-long garden terrace.

John Adams' family home, "Peacefield", in Quincy, Massachusetts included decorative gardens and an apple orchard.

Focusing on native trees and plants, and exquisitely designed gardens, there are many more Founding Fathers who carefully designed their gardens for feeding their large households and delighted in showing them to visitors from around the world.

Gardening tips: If your outdoor potted plants are not

thriving, be sure to remove them from the pots to check out the roots. I discovered too late that there was a colony of ants busily tending gazillions of eggs in several of my plant pots. Also, less water is better than too much water, as plants slow down their growth in winter. Be sure to trim back and remove funky leaves, and your plants will thank you for washing off the

accumulation of dust from the leaves. A light spray of soapy water on the soil and the leaves will discourage gnats, aphids and other random insects.
