

a process each year to nominate and select the site to feature.

Since 1962, the Tennessee Valley Art Association

has drawn artists from across three counties and has been offering opportunities for the artists to exhibit their work. The Tennessee Valley

Museum of Art was built in 1972 to serve these purposes, taking its place on the historic Commons of Tuscumbia. Today it is the site of visual art exhibits, special programming, and is headquarters for performances at the Ritz Theatre in Sheffield.

The ornaments are \$20 each and are available at the Tennessee Valley Museum of Art, Coldwater Seed & Supply, Helen Keller Library, Fiddledee D! gift shop, and at local financial institutions in the town.

The Civitan ornaments will also be available at the Tennessee Vallev Museum of Art during the "Winter Art Market", November 29 – December 23 which features the handmade goods of approximately 34 artisans.

When I was in law school I worked for a law firm in Birmingham. One of the attorneys there, Bill Gladden, was a really good trial lawyer with a big personality. He was an inspiration. He loved cars.

One day Mr. Gladden called me to his office and told me he needed me to drive him to the Porsche dealership to pick up his new car. He showed me a Car & Driver magazine with a Comet Gray Porsche 911 on the front cover with the caption

"Therapy Through Wretched Excess". Mr. Gladden had bought it and in 1986 it was an astronomical \$42,000,00

He took me for a ride in that Porsche, first one I had been in. I have never forgotten that car.

Since that time, I have had 23 Porsches. I started out with the 944s, then a 944 Turbo (4-cyclinders) and then moved to the 911s, but after having a 911 Turbo, very few cars compare (even Ferraris). Porsches are engineered for excellence, and their technology is always improving. I still drive one to this day. The beauty of the 911 is that it is the only car that has continued to evolve (since 1964). Porsche raced them, found the flaws, and improved them. For example, during a race the shinywindshield wipers created a reflection in the driver's eyes and from then on, all Porsche windshield wipers are non-reflective black. Once you fall in love with a brand, you become familiar with it and learn the history. Probably the best one I ever had was a RUF 993 air-cooled turbo, which I traded for a newer convertible turbo. That car is worth well over a million today.

Some days, the most fun I had was driving to and from work!



She did use some emphatic language, saying (accurately), "Society (accurately), "Society pushing that there are multiple genders and genders and should be everyone what they want to be is demonic."

In response, Curth asserted that Fulnecky's article was ideological and demanded empirical evidence. Ironically, exposed his own ideological bias.

Curth claimed gender norms reinforced by religious pressure and that, when writing a reaction paper, Fulnecky should use empirical evidence from scientific articles across disciplines such as biology and sociology. concluded exhorting her to use more perspective and empathy in her critiques and to avoid using ostensibly

offensive language.

Not The Bee.com published Fulnecky's essay in full. She tries to convey very philosophical ideas, though it's not a very well-written essay. If Curth's complaint was merely about that, then perhaps he had some standing he had some standing. However, to give her a zero was extremely malicious. Joel Abbott articulated

Fulnecky's beliefs with this very incisive observation:

'Ás a math professor once told me, even in mathematics, you will come to different answers with different starting premises, even though mathematics is empiricism in its truest

This is true for everything in all of life. Science is science, but how that data is interpreted does not, as much as the secularists like to preach, rely on empirical evidence alone.

Émpiricism teaches that we can understand everything through observation, and yet the Founding Fathers did not run tests to conclude the "truths we hold to be self-evident." Their conclusion that "all men are created equal and endowed by their Creator with certain inalienable rights" was based on the rationalistic idea that we have an innate nature and can

deduce things based on inner common sense.

The quality of the essay is beside the point, though. Frankly, unless this is a senior-level English class, it's reasonable to have low expectations for such an essay. Fulnecky articulated her beliefs coherently enough while calling out her fellow students who would likely conform to the beliefs held by her professor so they "don't professor so they step on people's toes.

She has a point. Most students lie to or exploit their Marxist professors to get a good grade.

For its part, the University of Oklahoma this Curth addressing controversy. been placed has administrative leave, and Fulnecky's bad mark will not count toward her overall grade in the class.

Oklahoma Governor Kevin Stitt also weighed in on the controversy.

"The 1st Amendment," he posted, "is foundational to our freedom & inseparable from a well-rounded education. The situation at OU is deeply concerning. I'm calling on the OU regents to review the results of the investigation & ensure other students aren't unfairly penalized for their beliefs."

While not surprising, even in deep-red Oklahoma, to find that a public university has a gender-confused professor teaching a class on "Lifespan Development," it's nice to see that the university is taking steps to address Curth's partisan actions. Perhaps nature is truly starting to heal.



## **Medicare Minute Prescription Drug Plans 3**

Last week we discussed prescription drug plan premiums, deductibles and coinsurance. This week we will continue to look at Medicare prescription drug plans by looking at copays, formularies and provider networks. When choosing a prescription drug plan these six things are very important to consider.

A copay is a fixed amount you pay for each individual prescription. Copays can vary depending on the tier of your prescription. Typically the lower the tier, the lower the copay. A tier 1 drug usually has a lower copay than a tier 2 drug, tier 2 drugs have a lower copay than tier 3, etc. Because different plans may categorize drugs in different tiers it's a good idea to know how your plan treats your prescriptions.

The prescription drug plan's formulary will tell you two important things. First, it will tell you if the prescription you are taking is covered under the plan. Second, it will tell you the tier of the prescription. Knowing the tier of your prescription is important in determining the copay. For example, Plan A may list your prescription as a tier 2 whereas, Plan B may have it as a tier 3. This should tell you that Plan A will have a lower copay on your prescription than Plan B. It will also tell you if your drug will fall in the deductible phase of the plan.

The plan's provider network is a list of pharmacies that accepts the plan. All pharmacies do not accept all plans so if you have a particular pharmacy you would like to use check to make sure they accept your plan. You can do this by simply asking your pharmacist. Also, pharmacies are listed as "preferred" and "standard" under some plans. In this case a "preferred" pharmacy may have lower copays than a "standard" pharmacy.
