VanCamp takes the reins as new saddle club queen

Kristi Van Camp, a horsewoman from Aitkin, Minnesota, who competes in barrel races, pole weaving and keyhole, and many other speed events, faced off challengers to capture the title of Queen of the Western Saddle Clubs Association, a prestigious

Starting out 30 years ago as Princess for the local Bit N Bridle Saddle Club in Aitkin, Kristi (Patnode) VanCamp continues her dream of living her life centered on faith, family and horses.

Kristi and daughter Auli travel all over to horse shows, rodeos and competitions. The family, with husband Gabe, has a camper for their horsey travels. Daughter Zoey, a teen, is pursuing other interests now.

Kristi will preside as queen and add public speaking, judging, special programs, award presentations and more during her Saddle Club Association reign. They are on the road a lot with their family and up

to four competition horses. Their horse trailer has living guarters in the front, and they have a generator so they can camp anywhere.

An athletic horsewoman at age 40

As part of her horsewoman skills, she competes with her horse Dassi, a muscular and fast quarter-horse. "I rescued Dassi from a kill pen just before she loaded a trailer to head to slaughter when she was three years old," explains Kristi. "I have done almost all of her training since she started and it was challenging but so fun to grow with her as a team. Competing with her during the Queens Contest was a true honor and very sentimental for me. I've put so much time and love into Dassi over the past eight years and to be able to do the riding portion on her and do so well made my heart so happy! Even though the crown was placed on my hat, she is a huge part of that title! She has helped me grow as a person and as a rider - there is no way this would have been possible without her."

What do you like best about being Saddle Club **Association Queen?**

"I love connecting with people-especially youthand sharing my passion for horses. Nothing brings me more joy than inspiring others to let their light shine and follow what sets their soul on fire. I'm passionate about all aspects of horse life—from caring for horses to growing as a horsewoman. Most of all, I love helping young riders discover their confidence and joy in the saddle, just as I did," Van Camp says about her new role.

What am I learning as I participate in my program?

"I realized how fortunate we are in Minnesota to have an organization like WSCA. We offer so many opportunities for all ages and disciplines, and it's pretty special

to be part of an association that provides many ways

to stay involved with our horses year-round. We are truly lucky to have such an active and supportive horse community!"

Kristi shares her coronation experience:

I was crowned on September 21, 2025, at the WSCA Champ Show royalty coronation in Cannon Falls, MN. The competition season started in July when I wrote a short essay about myself and why I was running for WSCA Queen. It continued in August when I went to an all-day event where we had two written tests – on Equine and WSCA knowledge – plus a live interview with six judges. That evening we had a

banquet and each contestant gave a speech about "what does WSCA mean to you and how have you been involved in WSCA and your saddle club?" and also had to answer an impromptu question.

"The horsemanship contest continued at the 2025 Champ Show in Cannon Falls on September 17, 2025. We were judged on our riding ability and horsemanship by performing an intricate riding pattern with our horses and doing a salute Queens Ride.
