

Tullahoma Area Chamber of Commerce earns statewide honor

THE TULLAHOMA Area Chamber of Commerce (TACC) was recently named Tennessee Chamber of the Year by the Tennessee Chamber of Commerce Executives. This well-deserved honor shines a light on years of their efforts to promote local business, education, and community connection.

“They partner with our school system to create educational opportunities, known as CEO,” said Hope Nunley, executive director with the Tullahoma Area Chamber of Commerce.

“They highlighted our participation with our board and ambassadors who support the chamber, and the number of community members they have.”

TACC’s recognition reflects excellence across four key categories: networking and communication, education and workforce development, advocacy and government relations, and community engagement and social impact.

The chamber hosts over 70 events annually, attracting more than 14,000 people from across the region. 

Creating connection and curiosity

This is an inside look at the program bringing Coffee County's leaders together to learn, serve, and grow.

COFFEE COUNTY Leadership is a hands-on introduction to the people, places, and traditions that make their community unique. In Coffee County, leadership means understanding the heart of your community, discovering its hidden gems, and building connections that last a lifetime. That’s exactly what this program aims to do: open eyes, encourage curiosity, and inspire action.

Originally launched as a volunteer-led effort, Coffee County Leadership has evolved into a partnership between the Tullahoma Area Chamber of Commerce and the Manchester Chamber of Commerce.

“Both teams are really excited when we get to work together,” said Hope Nunley, the executive director with the Tullahoma chamber.

“It’s amazing to see two communities come together to celebrate what makes each of them unique, while learning from one another.”

The first class launched in 2021, and the program now welcomes its fifth group of participants. Each month, on the second Wednesday, the group gathers for a full-day “field trip” centered on a specific theme — ranging from agriculture and education to government and economic development.

Each day is designed to help participants discover the inner workings of Coffee County and the people who make it extraordinary. It’s hands-on, immersive, and often eye-opening.

Agriculture Day (“Ag Day”) is one of Nunley’s favorites. On this day, after participants enjoy a fun meal and presentation by Coffee County Central High School’s National FFA Organization students, they hit the road to visit local farms, meet multigenerational farmers, and see firsthand how the county brings farm-to-table experiences to life.

Agriculture has seen a noticeable shift in recent years. However, Nunley believes visiting the farmers market is a small way anyone can make an economic impact — and it keeps local traditions alive.

Education Day offers a glimpse into how learning has evolved in Coffee County. Participants visit all three school systems, often beginning at Westwood Elementary before heading to Tullahoma High School to explore programs like the Virtual Academy and Career and Technical Education departments.



“It’s incredible to see how many changes have been made since I was in school and the opportunities that exist for students today,” Nunley reflected.

Government Day is equally immersive. Participants tour the county jail, sit in courtrooms, and visit hospitals — an immersive experience that brings to light how local systems operate together.

“We really try to cover all the bases,” Nunley explained. “We want participants to leave with a real understanding of the community and all the assets it has.”

Curiosity is the common thread Nunley explained.

“One word I’d use to describe our participants is curious,” Nunley said. “They want to know why Coffee County is so special, what’s here, and how they can connect and contribute.”

Nunley graduated from the program in 2011 and still keeps in touch with many of her classmates.

“When I see them, it feels like a happy reunion,” she said. “We’re still connected through our love for our community.”

At its core, Coffee County Leadership is about learning and growing. Participants leave both informed and inspired to make a difference in the place they call home. It’s about building relationships, asking questions, and discovering what makes this community special. Each year, Coffee County Leadership cultivates both informed citizens and engaged, lifelong advocates for their hometown.

INNOVATION THAT SHAPES THE FUTURE

The complex has propelled aerospace advancement for decades, leaving a lasting legacy of progress and purpose.

HEADQUARTERED AT Arnold Air Force Base, Arnold Engineering Development Complex (AEDC) is recognized as the world's largest and most advanced ground test facility. Established in the 1950s and named for Gen. Henry "Hap" Arnold, the father of the U.S. Air Force, AEDC has played a pivotal role in testing and advancing aerospace technologies for decades. The complex's mission remains the same as when it opened its doors to the world 75 years ago: to provide world-class test expertise and environments, enabling early solutions that accelerate war-winning capabilities.

Today, AEDC's reach extends far beyond Tennessee, with operating locations in Maryland, California, Utah, New Mexico, Colorado, and Ohio. But its greatest impact is felt right here at home. In fiscal year 2024, Arnold Air Force Base generated an economic impact of \$1.1 billion. This included payroll, local spending, and expenditures for supplies,

utilities, fuel, and services, along with the spin-off effects of those purchases.

The base employed 2,813 personnel last year, including active-duty military personnel, Air Force Reserve personnel, civilian employees, and more than 2,300 contractors. Payroll alone totaled \$382.2 million, while direct expenditures reached \$280.4 million. The indirect spin-off impact added another \$464.8 million to the local economy.

Beyond its direct workforce, Arnold AFB created an estimated 3,641 secondary jobs in the surrounding area, bringing total employment tied to its operations to 6,454. These jobs span industries from home construction to retail and health care, underscoring AEDC's vital role in sustaining the region's economic health.

Arnold Engineering Development Complex is not only a cornerstone of aerospace innovation — it is a driving force for local economic prosperity.



THE DAISY AWARD

At VTHH, the DAISY Award honors caregivers whose compassion makes healing possible.

BEHIND EVERY patient story at Vanderbilt Tullahoma–Hartom Hospital (VTHH) is a team of caregivers whose dedication makes all the difference. Nurses stay late to support families, technicians and physicians go the extra mile, showing just how much the hospital relies on its people.

One of the most visible ways VTHH recognizes exceptional caregiving is through the DAISY Award. This prestigious accolade honors nurses who go the extra mile, helping patients feel supported and at ease while receiving the care they need.

“For the individual nurse, receiving this recognition is a deeply personal acknowledgment of their hard work, skill, and commitment to patient care,” Ellis noted.

Celebrating a recipient is a team effort. Staff gather to escort the nurse to their recognition ceremony, joined by family members, patients, and fellow awardees.

The honored nurse receives a signature DAISY statue and a personalized jacket honoring the passion they bring to every patient. Aside from the individual recognition, the award inspires the entire team, empowering them to celebrate empathy and excellence.

Ellis recalled a moment that perfectly captured the essence of the DAISY Award.

“A family shared how Sara [an emergency department charge nurse] went above and beyond when

their adult son, who had ALS and was on hospice care, unexpectedly passed away.”

Sara provided exceptional care during the patient’s final hours at the hospital, followed the ambulance home, comforted the grieving family, and ensured the patient’s wish to pass at home was honored.

On the day she received the DAISY Award, the entire team witnessed a powerful display of selflessness, leaving no dry eyes in the room.

While the DAISY Award celebrates extraordinary patient care, VTHH also understands that its caregivers need support.

Ellis acknowledged the toll a health care career can take. VTHH supports the well-being of its staff with counseling services, stress-relief activities, flexible scheduling, and quiet spaces for reflection.

As part of Vanderbilt University Medical Center, VTHH blends the resources of a major medical network with the warmth of a local hospital. Since joining VUMC, it has doubled patient capacity, added over 200 jobs, and expanded services with a dedicated critical care team, advanced chemistry analyzers, and a 128-slice CT scanner — bringing world-class care to the Tullahoma community.

At VTHH, excellence is a standard, compassion is a practice, and community is at the core of everything they do. Here, patients are neighbors, and every caregiver strives to leave them not only healed but deeply cared for.

A LIFELONG ADVOCATE FOR TULLAHOMA CITY SCHOOLS

Kim Uselton career has been devoted to supporting students, teachers, and excellence in education.

FEW PEOPLE embody the spirit and dedication of Tullahoma City Schools like Kim Uselton. A 1978 Tullahoma High School graduate, Uselton has spent most of her life connected to the district as a student, teacher, volunteer, and, for the past 14 years, a member of the Tullahoma City Schools Board of Education. Her deep love for education and her community has guided every step of her journey.

Uselton's devotion to learning began in childhood, inspired by what she deems a "wonderful" first grade experience.

"There was no public school kindergarten when I started school in September 1966, so I didn't attend kindergarten; I started school in first grade," explained Uselton. "I had the most wonderful teacher in Emalou Huddleston, who hugged us and was just very gentle, loving, and caring. I loved school from the very first time I went, and it was at Robert E. Lee (Elementary), and I still can walk into that classroom to this day and have those feelings."

Uselton said that her love of learning quickly grew into a lifelong calling. After returning to Tullahoma when her husband, Clay's, military commitment was complete, she found her way back to the classroom — this time as a teacher. She began teaching fifth grade at Farrar Elementary and later completed two interim teaching assignments, teaching first grade at Robert E. Lee Elementary. Her teaching career was just one of many ways Uselton has served the district. Over the years, she's been a volunteer, Parent-Teacher Organization leader, and educational assistant, giving back to the schools that shaped her. She stated that some of her proudest moments have been learning that she made a positive lasting impression on her students.

"A former student of mine who is actually now a teacher herself said that what she remembered about me most as her fifth grade teacher was that she and her fellow students always knew that I loved them. I'm so proud of that and thankful that they knew that's the way they felt because I did genuinely love

them,” Uselton said. “I always loved them and cared greatly about them. And I still have all those feelings all these many years later. I’m 65, and I still care so greatly for our students and our employees.”

Uselton’s family also shares her strong ties to Tullahoma schools with her children, Sam and Jack, both of whom have graduated from Tullahoma City Schools.

Even after decades of involvement, Uselton said her joy in serving the school system remains as strong as ever.

“I just selfishly receive incredible joy from being a part of the school system,” she said. “One of my very favorite things is to go into a school and hear the whole school saying the Pledge of Allegiance. To hear children’s voices reciting the pledge, singing, or playing, gives me chills,” she said.

That love for the schools runs deeper than nostalgia. For Uselton, the Tullahoma school system is one of the foundations of Tullahoma’s success.

“I think the school system exists for the education of children, so obviously, the thing that I love most is having the opportunity to educate children and give them all kinds of wonderful experiences. I also believe that it’s foundational to our city. And it is a draw for families to live here and for businesses to come here,” she explained.



She emphasized that strong schools and strong communities go hand in hand. Through her work on the school board, she’s seen firsthand how collaboration between families, educators, and local businesses continues to strengthen Tullahoma.

“Our schools thrive because of those partnerships, and our community thrives by having good schools,” she said.

Looking ahead, Uselton said she hopes the district continues to grow while staying true to its mission of supporting every student.

“I hope that we continue to lay strong foundations, and that we understand that the best schools are strong in lots of areas — academics, arts, and athletics — and that we continue to provide all students with experiences that make them feel like they are a part, and they belong, and they find their place, and they grow from that. Also, I hope that people continue to understand the value of public education,” she said.

CONNECTING CLASSROOMS AND COMPANIES

Tullahoma's Creating Educational Opportunities program builds bridges between classrooms and the community.

IF YOU spend any time in Tullahoma, you'll notice something special about the way people here connect. Friendly smiles and polite small talk are common, but what stands out is the genuine investment neighbors make in one another. This culture of connection is deeply intertwined in the community's identity, and nowhere is it more visible than in the Creating Educational Opportunities program, known as the C.E.O. program.

C.E.O. began more than 30 years ago as an idea between a handful of local business leaders and educators, and has grown into one of the longest-standing partnerships in Southern Middle Tennessee. Today, the Tullahoma Area Chamber of Commerce (TACC) coordinates more than 80 business partners who work hand-in-hand with the



city's eight public schools to mentor and tutor students and build bridges between education and the professional world.

Whether small businesses or major organizations, these partners pour time and resources into students in ways both meaningful and memorable.

The program is built on a simple philosophy: a handshake, not a handout. Local businesses don't merely donate money or supplies — they show up. They read to students, host class tours, serve as mentors, and offer hands-on lessons that connect textbook learning to real life.

Walk through any Tullahoma school and you might find a local banker teaching financial literacy, a firefighter helping with the annual pumpkin drop, or a small business owner leading a career day session. Florence from Clayton's Shoe Store has even become a local

legend at her partner elementary school, known for teaching kids to tie their shoes.

This mix of large and small partners provides students with a wide range of exposure and experience, creating a well-rounded program that engages every corner of the community.

"We're always seeking and welcoming new business partnerships to connect with our schools," said Hope Nunley, executive director at TACC.

"Rather than targeting specific businesses, we view this as an open opportunity for any business interested in serving our community and positively impacting education. We encourage all businesses to get involved and join us in supporting our local schools."

At the high school and virtual academy levels, partnerships focus on preparing students for what comes next

— mock interviews, job shadowing, and career exploration that help them see the many paths available right here at home.

Launched in the spring of 1990, the program started with eight schools and 15 businesses. By 1999, the Tullahoma Area Chamber of Commerce had taken the lead in coordinating the effort, ensuring it continued to grow and evolve with the community's needs.

That collaboration has become a cornerstone of local life more than three decades later. It's not uncommon to see a business owner volunteering at a school event one day and sitting in the stands at a student's ball game the next. These relationships often outlast the school year, turning into mentorships — and sometimes even employment opportunities — long after graduation.

"Most importantly, students benefit by having caring adults invest in their success and cheer them on, helping them feel supported and valued both in and out of the classroom."

What makes C.E.O. truly remarkable is how naturally it fits into the core of Tullahoma. Visitors passing through can see the community in action, united in helping the next generation dream bigger and reach higher.

"We're incredibly honored to serve as the facilitator of this program and to work alongside Tullahoma City Schools," said Nunley.

"Our school system has an outstanding reputation, and this partnership program is just one more example of what makes it exceptional."



BRIDGING SERVICE AND CIVILIAN SUCCESS

The SkillBridge program at UTSI helps service members transition smoothly into civilian careers through hands-on experience.

TRANSITIONING FROM a military career to a civilian one can be both exciting and daunting. After years — sometimes decades — of service, many veterans face the challenge of redefining their professional identity, learning new systems, and navigating the civilian job market. Recognizing these challenges, the University of Tennessee Space Institute (UTSI) adopted the nationally recognized SkillBridge program in 2024 to help smooth that transition and connect military experience with civilian opportunities.

Introduced just a year ago, the SkillBridge program at UTSI is one of just 15 higher education partners out of the almost 4,000 partners that support the program. Since its launch just over a year ago, the program has already proven to be successful. To date, there have been 11 participants — including the program’s current manager, David Byrd.

“SkillBridge at UTSI helps veterans make the jump from military life to a civilian career, especially in fields like aerospace or engineering, by translating our military experience into civilian experience and language,” Byrd explained. “They help translate what service members did every day into what they could be doing as a civilian, also coaching and mentoring, but also expanding upon their military experience. Examples of this include accounting for a squadron versus accounting for facilities, machining parts on a ship versus machining parts for a

wind tunnel. Some military members are retiring from the military, and that’s all that they have known for 20-plus years.”

Byrd added that support has already led to tangible results. Graduates of the program have gone on to hold impressive roles, including lead systems engineer for SAFRAN Federal Systems and Naval Information Warfare Systems Command, a contract administrator for Aviation & Missile Solutions, and a procurement analyst for Crown Laboratories, known as REVANCE. Byrd said that he himself is a testament to the program’s success, now serving as its manager and advocate for new participants.


By connecting highly trained veterans with industries in need of skilled workers,

Byrd said SkillBridge not only changes individual lives but also strengthens the local workforce and economy. Programs like this ensure that Tennessee continues to attract and retain talent while honoring the service of those who have worn the uniform.

“The program offers a low-risk, high-fit, disciplined, and talented pipeline of service members who remain on military pay during SkillBridge,” he explained. “Think of it as sort of a try-before-you-buy for organizations that can assess, fit, shape, train, and often convert these interns to full-time hires. It’s also the right thing for a region to help and try to keep people in Tennessee’s workforce.”

For local employers seeking to fill critical roles with disciplined, motivated professionals, SkillBridge offers more than an internship — it provides an opportunity to invest in both individuals and the community’s future.





BACKYARD BREWS & HOMETOWN STAPLES

Ole Shed Brewing Company with humble beginnings, a big heart, and a taste of home in every pour has become a community favorite.

IF YOU drive down Montclair Street in the Tullahoma Industrial Park, you might pass it without a second glance. It's a modest brick building where the real beauty waits inside, conversations drift through the doorway, and the smell of hops meets you before the sign does. Before your eyes adjust to the soft glow of the taproom lights, the sound hits you first: laughter ricocheting off the wood-paneled walls, the pop of a can cap, a guitar tuning up for the night's first set. Mike Thornburg, who built this legacy with his own hands, works diligently behind the bar.

For Thornburg, owning and running a brewery right here in Middle Tennessee is something to be proud of. It's the freshly brewed hops on a humid afternoon, the clink of glasses between friends, and the satisfaction of knowing every pour is the product of hard work, a tight-knit team, and a love for the community that raised him.

Ole Shed started in an actual shed. Thornburg and his friends brewed their first beer right out the back of his house. That old shed taught them more about patience and persistence than any manual ever could.



THE TASTE OF HOME IN A GLASS

Step inside the taproom on a Friday evening and you'll understand why Ole Shed has become a gathering place for locals and travelers alike. There's always a guitar or fiddle warming up in the corner, a family sharing a flight of ales, or a couple of regulars debating which brew pairs best with Catrina's tacos.

Thornburg takes pride in crafting approachable, flavorful beers that bring people together and tell a story with each sip. Some recipes carry remnants of his childhood in Indiana, where farm life deepened his respect for ingredients and the value of honest labor.

Others are born from collaboration with local farmers, food trucks, and even the musicians who bring life to the taproom stage.

"We also enjoy collaborating on events and fundraisers that bring people together — whether it's featuring local musicians or supporting community causes," said Danae Greenwood, Ole Shed Brewing Company's marketing and event coordinator.

When the brewing's done, even the leftovers serve a purpose. The spent grain goes straight to nearby farmers to feed their cattle, which fits perfectly with Thornburg's community-first philosophy.

WHERE EVERYONE KNOWS YOUR PINT

For anyone driving in from out of town, Ole Shed offers what might be the purest form of Southern hospitality. From the moment you walk in, you're greeted like a regular. No pretense, no frills — just cold beer, good conversation, and a space that feels like it's been waiting for you.

"What truly sets Ole Shed apart is our focus on community, authenticity, and Southern hospitality," Greenwood shared.

"We're a family-owned and operated brewery, and you can feel that personal touch in everything we do — from the way we craft our beer to how we treat every guest who walks through our doors."

This year, there's even more reason to visit. Ole Shed recently unveiled brand-new golf simulators, allowing guests to grab a beer and play a round of golf.

Starting this November, guests can book tee times, crack open a cold one, and play a few holes without ever leaving the taproom.

COMMUNITY ON TAP

As tourism continues to grow across Middle Tennessee, the brewery stands as both a destination and a reflection of what small-town life still does best: connect people.

"Our taproom is a place where locals and travelers come together to share stories, laughter, and good beer — it's the kind of place that feels like home, even if it's your first visit," said Greenwood.

THE ROAD TO THE SHED

Visitors who come for a weekend beer run often stay longer, drawn in by good company, friendly chatter, and that unspoken sense of community that seems to rise with the steam off a fresh pour.

"We want every guest to leave knowing they were welcomed like family, felt at home, and shared

in good times that brought people together," said Thornburg.

"That's the Ole Shed experience — and what keeps people coming back. Cheers... This Shed's Good!"

GOOD BEER, GOOD PEOPLE, GOOD TIMES

If you come to Ole Shed for one reason, make it this: to feel connected, take a breath, slow down, and enjoy something created by people who still believe in doing things by hand, with heart, and for each other.

"We're always striving to craft something that not only tastes great but also tells a story worth raising a glass to," Thornburg shared.








Explore TULLAHOMA

A CITY FULL OF HISTORY AND FUN

BEECHCRAFT HERITAGE MUSEUM

Founded in 1973, the Beechcraft Heritage Museum has been serving Tullahoma, providing flight training, educational seminars, and maintenance seminars to the community. Originally known as the Staggerwing Museum Foundation, the 78,000-square-foot space has become home to 38 aircraft, along with art, artifacts, and memorabilia that chronicle the history of Beechcraft models since 1932.



TULLAHOMA MUNICIPAL AIRPORT

The Tullahoma Municipal Airport is a central part of today's Tullahoma and a historical marker of the past. The airport was first constructed for the U.S. Army Air Corps, holding B-24 and B-25 bombers during World War II. It is also known as the William Northern Field, in honor of the first Tennessee-born aviator to die in the war. Today, it has 140 aircraft, operates 68 aerodynamic test units, and participates in many of Tullahoma's local events.



SKYDIVE TENNESSEE

For those who desire unique and gravity-defying entertainment, Skydive Tennessee may be just the thing. Based at the Tullahoma Municipal Airport, the Skydive Tennessee program allows both beginning and experienced skydivers. Introductory tandem packages let first-time divers go with USPA-certified tandem masters, and for those who want to learn how to dive solo, license training is available.



MACHINE FALLS

Machine Falls is the most popular waterfall at Short Springs, with a circular trail of only 3.1 miles. The waterfall drops more than 60 feet and is nearly that wide. The black Chattanooga shale alongside the course is just as stunning.



MONTANA DRIVE-IN

The Montana Drive-In was established in Tullahoma in 2004 to bring families nostalgic entertainment and lifelong memories. Aside from the double features shown on three screens, the drive-in offers a full restaurant menu.



SHORT SPRINGS NATURAL AREA

Beautiful waterfalls and excellent hiking trails sit about 3.5 miles northeast of Tullahoma. The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation calls it one of the very best spring wildflower locations in the state, and the nature preserve is open year-round to visitors. Rare flowers you might spot include the large-flowered trillium, Southern red trillium, barren strawberry, and the state-listed endangered plant species, Nestronia and broad-leaved bunchflower.



DOWNTOWN TULLAHOMA

Downtown Tullahoma has good food, exciting events, and fascinating history. The North Atlantic Historic District-Depot District boasts Victorian homes and a historic depot. History Park (Caboose Park) allows visitors to eat and relax alongside a 1964 L&N caboose. Discover antique shops, 100-year-old shoe stores, live music, and much more.


VETERAN MEMORIALS AT CABOOSE PARK

Caboose Park currently holds three veteran memorials, which are incredibly important. The Blue Star and Gold Star Memorial Markers are a tribute to the U.S. Armed Forces. The Gold Star Memorial was created after World War I and honors families who lost loved ones in military service. The Blue Star Memorial was created after World War II in gratitude to all veterans. These memorial markers exist across the nation, but this site, in particular, was chosen because of the railroad nearby. Thousands of service members traveled on that railroad through Tullahoma to Camp Forrest. Connecting the two markers to the park's caboose is the third memorial: a 69-foot sidewalk listing over 500 veterans' names.



NORMANDY LAKE

Fourteen minutes from Tullahoma sits Normandy Lake — another reservoir operated by the Tennessee Valley Authority (TVA). The reservoir is a popular fishing site, with four free public boat access sites and two public fishing piers. Nearby are Barton Springs Campground and Cedar Point Campground.



RUTLEDGE FALLS

The Rutledge Falls trail is much easier than Machine Falls, with less than half a mile's distance out and back. While the trail is on private property, the owners work with local officials to allow public access. The trail is open year-round and considered a great swimming hole.

TIMS FORD LAKE

Run by the TVA, Tims Ford Lake stands as a dam and reservoir on the Elk River. The lake is a popular bass fishing and recreational spot, with 20 cabins and six islands available for camping and exploring through the Tims Ford State Park. Golfing, hiking, and boat rentals are also available.

GYMNASTICS

Tullahoma Gymnastics and Cheer holds classes for every skill level, from age 2 to competitive gymnasts. The cheer and gymnastics teams regularly compete against other all-star teams and learn personal and physical skills that will help them for years to come.



SOUTH JACKSON PERFORMING ARTS CENTER

The South Jackson Performing Arts Center began in 1979 as the South Jackson Civic Center and has operated since then as a presenting organization, museum, and community resource. The various programs include a home-school theater curriculum, educational outreach, and a performing arts series alongside the many community events.



DANCE STUDIOS

The Long School of Dance (est. 1975) and the Dance Company of Tullahoma (est. 2001) have long histories in Tullahoma and are dedicated to serving their students. The Long School of Dance offers ballet, tap, jazz, pointe, and creative movement. The Dance Company of Tullahoma offers ballet, tap, jazz, hip-hop, lyrical, pom, and pointe.



TULLAHOMA FINE ARTS CENTER

With a combination of art and history education, the Tullahoma Fine Arts Center works to preserve the past and bring quality art experiences to Tullahoma. The original owners of the building, the Baillet sisters, are honored through a memorial gallery, and the Veterans Memorial Gallery showcases other local Tullahoma history. A permanent member artists' gallery showcases local and regional artworks, and the center offers regularly rotating exhibits and lectures.

THE PAINTED HOUSE

Art students ages 3 and up can find a home in Annie Rone's Painted House with its art classes, summer camps, and art gallery. The goal of the business, which began in 2016, is to encourage appreciation of all art to motivate students to continue creating independently. The business is also available for birthday parties, where high-quality materials are used to create lasting memories.

DISC GOLF

TULLAHOMA MURALS

From the popular "Wisteria Maiden" to "Bertha the Octopus," murals are everywhere in Tullahoma, and the number is ever-growing. Many have been organized and supported by Do. More. Art. (DMA), a nonprofit working to change the face of rural America through art. One of the most recent pieces, "Shift," was painted by DMA's first artist from abroad and celebrates the evolution of individual identity. SPLASH ISLAND

Splash Island is the perfect place to relax and have fun with a splash pad, three 25-foot water slides, and a 300-foot lazy river. The pool was initially an Olympic-sized pool, built in the late 1970s, but since its renovation in 2015, it has become an incredible family-friendly spot in Tullahoma. Splash Island also features a concession stand, a basketball court, and an indoor pool.



FARMERS MARKET

From April to September, residents of Tullahoma and the surrounding area can get fresh produce from the Farmers Market of Tullahoma. Located on South Jackson Street, the market offers fruits, vegetables, bread, and many other locally sourced items from 3-6 p.m. every Monday.



HANDS-ON SCIENCE CENTER

The Hands-On Science Center is just the place for a unique science experience in its many forms. Interactive exhibits inspire curiosity, scientific literacy, and a love of science for visitors of every age. The Hands-On Science Center now offers virtual learning and take-home science kits for those who can't make it in person.



BOWLING

At Tullahoma Lanes, Tullahoma residents can join leagues, participate in tournaments, join a youth program, or simply host a party. The organization hosts local, state, and national tournaments and has participated in several charity bowling fundraisers.



LAKWOOD GOLF & COUNTRY CLUB

The Lakewood Golf & Country Club is a private club that offers practice areas, tennis, a pool, and a clubhouse alongside the regular golf course. The organization was founded in 1926 and relocated to its current location in the 1950s. Decades later, its 18-hole course continues to serve Tullahoma and the surrounding communities.





