

B-WISER Science Camp for Teen Girls hosted by The College of Wooster

This residential STEM camp enrolls students completing grades 7-10.

B-WISER is a team-taught, hands-on science experience. Campers stay on campus in a residence hall and participate in laboratory-based classes in state-of-the-art science facilities. Curriculum for the Middle School camp (grades 7-8) includes biology, chemistry, physics, geology, engineering, and select special topics. Middle school campers also learn about careers in various STEM fields. High school camp (grades 9-10) classes cover advanced topics such as microbiology, forensics, neuropsychology, astronomy, radiation, botany, and environmental science. High schoolers attend college-readiness seminars as well. Girls advance their skills, make new friends, and increase self-confidence.



Established in 1990, the mission of B-WISER is to encourage young women to pursue their interests in the sciences. This non-profit program is made possible by the Martha Holden Jennings Foundation, the Ardelle and Theresa Glaze Foundation, and other donors. Since 2006 we have honed an interactive self-directed (but well supervised), technology free experience for the children of our community. Kids enjoy and explore farm animals (horses, cows, goats, bunnies, & chickens) participate in horseback riding (weather permitting), an end-of-week trail ride, crafts, games, cooling off in the Chagrin River which is both shallow and located on the property, and "Feed-em-Friday" when kids are permitted to bring apples and carrots to feed the animals.



The benefits of attending summer camp

Summer camp is something akin to a rite of passage for millions of youngsters each year. Many adults look back fondly on their experiences at summer camp, often crediting such times as formative periods in their lives.

Summer camp benefits children in myriad ways. Recognition of the many advantages of attending summer camp can serve as a great reminder of just how fun it can be for children to spend their time away from school at a camp of their choosing.

Campers continue to socialize throughout summer. Socializing isn't just for the school year. While children in high school might be independent enough to come and go with their friends during summer break, kids who are still in elementary school or middle school might not be old enough to handle such freedom. That can make it

hard to stay in touch with friends, which in turn can contribute to feelings of boredom and loneliness. Camp provides ample opportunities for young children to socialize during a time of year when they might not see their school friends as often as they're used to.

- Campers can expand their horizons. Though some summer camps are exclusive to residents of certain communities, many tend to feature children from numerous towns or municipalities. Such camps provide an opportunity for campers to expand their horizons by engaging with youngsters who come from different backgrounds. Indeed, the Graduate School of Education at Harvard University notes that summer camp may be the first time children spend substantial amounts of time with people whose backgrounds differ from their own.

- Camp can get kids off their devices. Modern children are growing up in a digital world, and parents know how hard it can be to get kids to put down their devices and get outdoors. But the key to making that pivot could be access to outdoor play spaces. A 2025 study from researchers at the University of Michigan published in the journal *Health and Place* found that efforts to reduce kids' screen time are more successful when children are given a chance to play outside. Many summer camps are structured around outdoor play, making them a potentially invaluable ally as parents seek to help children cut



back

on the

time they spend using their devices. Children who do not attend camp and live in households where both parents work or in single-parent households where Mom or Dad works may be forced to spend much of summer indoors, which could increase the frequency with which they turn to devices to occupy their time.






