MIDPOINT CAFE

Tumbleweed Smith

There is always customer chatter during lunchtime at the Midpoint Caf  in Adrian, a panhandle town of 115 people. There is a reason for the name of the business. "It's the midpoint between Chicago and Santa Monica," says Brenda Hannit Bradley, owner. A marker across the street from the cafe designates the spot as the exact

midpoint of Route 66, a popular destination for European visitors. "I can have people from ten different countries in here at the same time," she says. "It's a big thing overseas. It really is. I have repeat customers from people who live in France, Belgium, just all over." Some of those customers give her things. "They give us stuff all the time like their money. I have them sign it and date it and I stick it on the wall. They'll send license plates.

I get presents from all kinds of people. This job is so much fun. The people I meet are amazing." Travel reporters from three countries were in the cafe while I was having a hamburger.

A gift shop attached to the cafe offers Route 66 shirts, caps and other items related to the famous highway, which is celebrating its centennial year. It was completed in 1926 to provide the first continuous route from the Midwest to the West Coast. People along the route are expecting an influx of tourists driving the entire nearly 2,500 miles, 178 of which goes through the Texas panhandle. The movies CARS and THE GRAPES OF WRATH were filmed along the Texas portion of the highway.

The cafe offers a variety of hamburgers. One is called The Triple and has one pound of hamburger meat. "Believe it or not I's the little bitty people who order The Triple. That's a lot of meat. I have some big boys and they can't finish one."

The cafe opened in 1928. Brenda has had it since 2018. She cooked there thirteen years before buying it. "I worked at a Stuckey's once and loved the travelers. I just love to feed people and horses. Before Stuckey's I raised race horses for a living. Now we have cats."

She makes pies. "Well, there's chocolate, our Elvis, which is chocolate, peanut butter and banana; we've got blueberry banana, we have apple, cherry apple, chocolate pecan, regular pecan, peach, cherry and blueberry cobbler, cherry vanilla, strawberry banana and on and on."

The cafe offers other things. "BLTs, chicken salad sandwiches, quarter pound hot dogs, chili. One of our specialties is a fried bologna sandwich. It's a special type of bologna that I have to order six weeks ahead of time. Costs an arm and a leg. People complain when I don't have it. I put grilled onions on it and sometime green chilis. It's yummy good."

Some movie stars have dined at the Midpoint. "The last one was William Shatner. He's nice. He told me it was the best fried bologna sandwich he ever ate."
