Reel fun on the ice as anglers compete for fish and prizes



Ice anglers, grab your augers and lucky bait as one of winter's favorite traditions is back. The Woodtick Inn's Annual Rabbit Lake Ice Fishing Contest splashes down Saturday, Feb. 21, promising a chilly afternoon packed with competition, camaraderie and cash prizes.

The contest runs from noon to 3 p.m., with an entry fee of \$10. Anglers will compete in four fish categories — walleye, northern pike, panfish and bass — with cash prizes awarded to the top catches.

As always, all Minnesota DNR rules and regulations apply, and organizers are serious about a fair start: lines

go down at noon sharp — not a minute earlier. Fish must be alive at weigh-in to qualify, and northern pike must fall outside the protected slot limit, meaning any 24 to 36-inch northerns must be released immediately.

Fishing is allowed on both East and West Rabbit Lake, and the weigh-in station will be located at the Rabbit Lake Landing off County Road 31 north of Cuyuna. All participants must have a valid fishing license.

Winners will be announced back at the Woodtick Inn around 4 p.m., where bragging rights will be on full display.



Pre-party Feb. 20

The fun starts early with a Fishing Contest Pre-party on Friday, Feb. 20, at the

Woodtick Inn, located at 24916 Minnesota Avenue in Cuyuna.

A mega meat raffle gets underway at 6:30 p.m., with all proceeds benefiting the Cuyuna Fire Department (License #02163). Live music will follow the raffle, making it the perfect warm-up before hitting the ice.

Spots for the fishing contest are limited, so anglers are encouraged to sign up early at the Woodtick Inn before it fills up. For more information, call the Woodtick (or "the Tick") at 218-772-0252.

Whether you're chasing trophies, cash prizes, or just a great weekend on Rabbit Lake, this is one winter tradition you won't want to miss.

Jaycees Extravaganza

Over on Gull Lake, where the ice was plenty thick this year, Thomas Johnson, a Brainerd fellow, is the 2026 winner of the Jaycees Ice

Fishing Extravaganza. A 30-year event attendee, he rose to the top of the leaderboard with a 5.63 lb. walleye. He intended to keep the Grand Prize Ford pickup truck. Conditions were ideal for fishing this year with all the recent cold weather in the area.

Fishing in 48 feet of water, Johnson's fish was lured in with a buck-shot rattle lure and a fathead minnow. The proceeds from the tourney are donated to numerous area non-profits by the Brainerd Jaycees.

Justin Morneau Classic

The Justin Morneau United Heros League Ice Fishing Classic went on to the east on Mille Lacs Lake. This sporting event may be a little lesser known than the Jaycees Extravaganza but also boasts loads of great prizes. Morneau, a Canadian, played 11 seasons with the Minnesota Twins as a first baseman. The

tournament, which has limited species of fish, was held at Nitti's Hunter's Point Resort. Winner of the Ice Castle fish house was Austin Creher, while David Claypool won the Polaris 4-wheeler.

Winning anglers were Co-han Chep, with a first place 6.29 lb. walleye, who won an Otter XT Hide Out. Tara Bierer had the winning 7.38 lb. Northern and won an Otter Vortex Resort package. In the perch category, Locue Her and a whopping 1.99-pounder got a \$150 Scheels Gift Card and in the "Other" division, Trysten Guimont took home a Buddy Heater 9000 BTU.

The tournament beneficiary is The United Heroes. They provide sports equipment, offer sports camps, subsidize association fees, and distribute sporting event tickets and award special experiences to military children.

Two arrested by DHS at Brainerd restaurant, face federal charges

Two men were arrested Jan. 26 by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security at El Potro Mexican Restaurant in downtown Brainerd and have since been indicted in federal court.

Court records indicate both men entered pleas of not guilty. They are currently being held at the Douglas County Jail in Superior, Wisconsin.

In the days following the arrests, a sign advertising El Potro Mexican Restaurant for sale was posted in the front window of the downtown Brainerd business.

The Lakes Area has not escaped the unrest over immigration and enforcement by the Immigration and Customs Enforcement police (ICE). There was a rally against ICE on the streets of Crosby on February 1, where dozens of bicyclists rode by as a tribute to those killed by ICE.
