# **200 Years at Stony Point**

FLORENCE – The Stony Point church of Christ is celebrating 200 years as a congregation this weekend. Although the church dates back to Acts 2 on the day of Pentecost, the group known as Stony Point church has

been together since 1816.

The first meeting place for the church was located in a community called Brandon Mills now known as White's Lake. In this first location in a log building on Cypress Creek a great leader in the Restoration Movement, Tolbert Fanning, was baptized in 1827. In the 1850's the congregation moved to the Stony Point





### THE DIFFERENCE **BETWEEN AND** TRUCK WRECK AND A CAR WRECK

Joel and I have been representing people or their families killed or injured by 18 wheelers for years. Most truck drivers are professional drivers who take their job seriously. These drivers know the tremendous potential for injury in driving an 80,000 lb vehicle at highway speeds. These vehicles are often driven on retreads and trucks don't make money if they are not moving. Drivers are often asked to drive more than allowed and are required to move cargo as quickly as possible.

With a regular car wreck, you typically have two drivers neither of which is a professional. More importantly, in a regular car wreck case there is not a team of damage control experts on their way to the scene of the crash to do what they

can do to limit the liability of one side and not the other. We know of cases where the truck driver has to meet with trucking company lawyers after a fatality before he gets to go home.

In many cases that we see, the truck driver does not meet the qualifications that are required under federal law to be permitted to operate a commercial vehicle.

In these cases, a trucking company entrusted a tractortrailer and cargo to a person who should not have been behind the wheel as a matter of law. There are specific documents required at the time a professional driver is hired that must be in the driver's file. If those documents do not exist or cannot be found, then the driver is not qualified. Usually we get trucking cases fairly soon after the accident but not as soon as an automobile accident simply because the injuries are often catastrophic and catastrophic injuries require family members to take care of the person hurt.

It is absolutely vital for an attorney to quickly send a letter requiring the trucking company to retain all documents relating to the driver and the accident. Often a download of the "black box" on the truck can prove speeding or late breaking. If this letter is not sent and enough time passes by the trucking company doesn't have to retain some of these documents or they may get "lost". 

nutrition education and breastfeeding peer counseling support. In addition, participants have the option to receive up to three months of food benefits at a time for each qualified family member. Food benefits are redeemable at WIC authorized stores throughout Alabama.

Under the 2016 federal poverty guidelines, more families may be eligible for the program. WIC is open to participants with incomes up to 185 percent of the federal poverty level. Check the table below to see whether your family qualifies:

WIC participants must have both a limited income and a nutritional need. Families who receive Medicaid, SNAP, formerly known as Food Stamps, or Family Assistance, formerly known as TANF (Temporary Assistance to Needy Families) already meet the income qualifications for WIC. Éven families who do not qualify for these programs may be eligible for WIC because of its higher income limits.

Amanda Martin, WIC director of the Alabama Department of Public Health, said, "We encourage prenatal nutrition for healthy birth outcomes. Nutrition is also a focus for infants and children to ensure healthy growth and development. Healthy food choices made by parents help children develop healthy eating habits for life.'

According to these same sources, "coyotes" engaged in human smuggling and working for Juárez Cartel help move ISIS terrorists through the desert and across the border between Santa Teresa and Sunland Park, New Mexico. These specific areas were targeted for exploitation by ISIS because of their understaffed municipal and county police forces, and the relative safe-havens the areas provide for the unchecked large-scale drug smuggling that was already ongoing.

Former CIA agent Bob Baer also confirmed that ISIS cells are already in the U.S., and some of the members have already entered by crossing the Mexican border. Syrian nationals have been caught illegally entering America via Mexico.

Breitbart News cited two unnamed federal agents who said several Syrians were intercepted at the Lincoln Bridge **Tuarez** in Laredo, Texas. While the U.S. Border Patrol has yet to confirm this report, National Border Patrol Council Local 2455 President Hector Garza told Breitbart, "Border Patrol agents who we represent have been contacting our organization to voice concerns about reports from other agents that Syrians crossed the U.S. border from Mexico in the Laredo Sector. Our agents have heard about Syrians being apprehended in the area from other federal agents." While the scientists who deny the global warming farce are threatened with prosecution, the Obama administration ignores the real threats to our national security.

For the short time that I am usually there, the games are a reunion for me. Some of these folks I have known for 20 years, and once

Last week when I first stepped on the field, I came upon a circle of friends. They all wanted me to see their ribbons. I tried to touch each one's pinned ribbon, so that I could touch their hearts. Later, one friend athlete stopped me and said, "I won this one. The first one I did not win." She wanted a high

I have been the Health and ten, so I gave her one. We ran into each other twice and we celebrated both times. I told another athlete that I saw him run his race. He matter-of-factly said, "I did not run, I walked." He didn't say this with any animosity or disappointment. He was just saying what he did. It didn't need to be played up or played down. He was proud of what he did do.

Honesty, love and support

are the basis of these games. As I was sitting with some parents, a school group of athletes was sitting beside us. Anytime anybody with a ribbon walked in front of them, they clapped and cheered for them - no holding back - which resulted in the passersby lifting their hands in triumph. Oh, if only we all could cheer each other on - no holding back. I saw young volunteers who were obviously first-timers getting over their fear and awkwardness and helping and cheering on folks who live differently than they. I saw the blind giving the seeing purpose. Everyone working to create a positive, encouraging environment. Everyone getting over themselves to make the games happen and being proud of being able to do it to serve.

Oh, if we could only get over ourselves and create community. Humility. Just do what we do - without measure. If we could each just work to touch another's heart, the hugs would flow. Game on.





I am interested in buying a foreclosure.

Is there anything I need to know going Thanks, Chase

Chase, that's a great question. It sounds like you are already aware that the process of buying a foreclosure property is a bit more involved than just buying a

home. On the up side, sometimes you can really take advantage of discounted pricing. On the down side, it can be a long, complicated process. Foreclosure purchases are different from standard resale situations in several key ways. Let's talk about some of those differences.

• There's a little thing you need to know about called "Right of Redemption". Although there is a very slim chance of it happening, the property you purchase may be eligible for redemption by the former homeowner. That means that they could pay the bank the amount they owed on the property, plus pay you for "needed repairs" and get the house back. Needed repairs are those necessary for making the property livable, not upgrades or changes due to personal preference. While the redemption period in Alabama has recently been shortened to 180 days, circumstances could exist which would make the previous 1-year redemption period effective. Talk with your Realtor and/or your attorney to find out exactly which timeframe you're dealing with.

 Your lender may require what is sometimes called a surety, or redemption bond, which is an additional expense that you will incur because you're dealing with a foreclosure. Make sure you are clear about what this bond actually covers.

• Foreclosures are sold "as is". That means that you, the buyer, are responsible for any repairs that need to be done. Speaking from experience, the chances of a foreclosure property being in less-than-great shape are high. If you're using conventional financing, your mortgage lender may require that some of those repairs be done before closing.

• Foreclosure homes are sold at a discounted rate. That means that there is little to no room for negotiation. That also means that the chances of ending up in a multiple-offer situation are high. If you end up in a multiple-offer situation, the selling price is more than likely going to be above list price.

• Banks always require pre-approval to be furnished before they will even look at an offer. If you are a cash buyer, you will need to provide proof of funds. Your bank can assist you with these documents.


