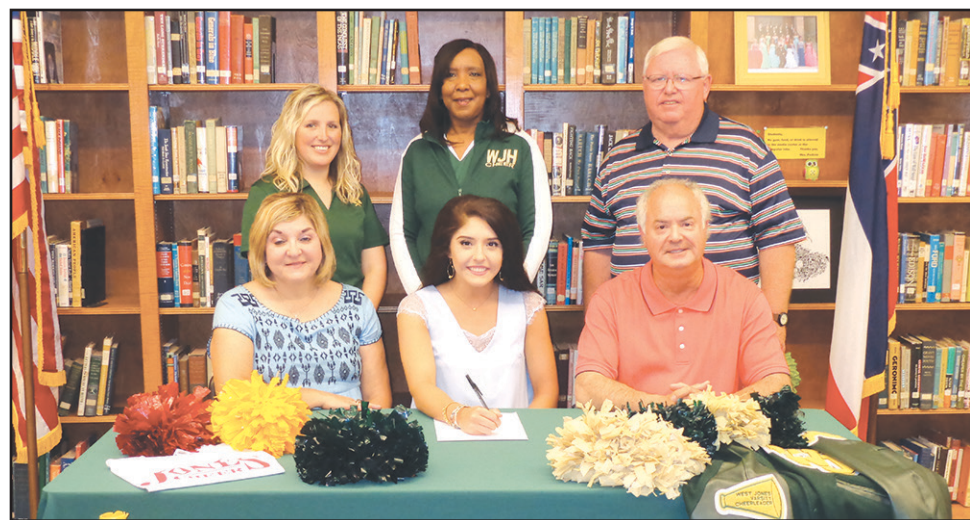

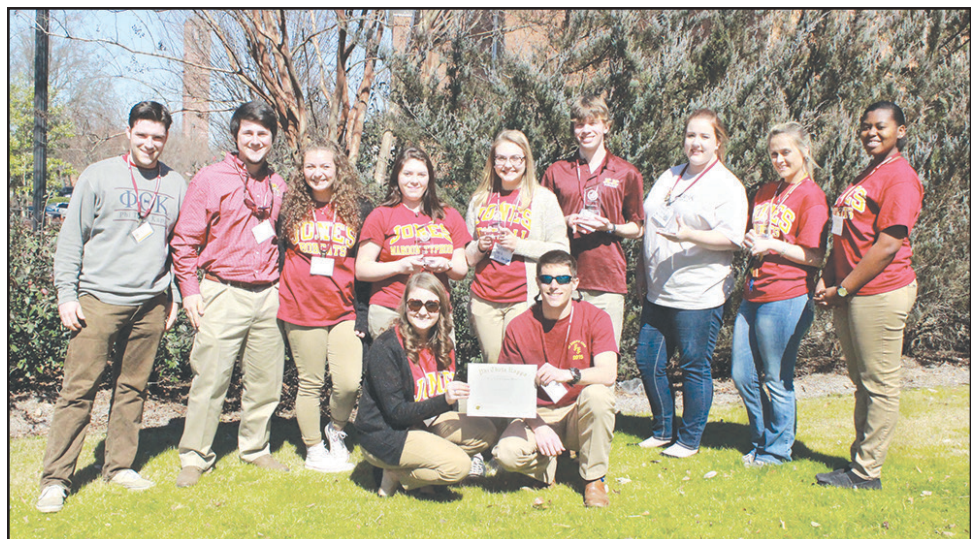

Sunshine at last!

If you worked as hard as I did this week; give yourself a break. You need it! This is the most beautiful spring I can remember; it almost makes the long dismal winter worthwhile. I trimmed up my burr rose – hate to cut those little sprigs off. The friend who gave it to me said to train it to a standard; this means one trunk with a rose umbrella at the top.

I've been a maniac with the loppers this week. I'm trying to train a yaupon, cut the bottom branches off that sucker. We saw a yaupon "tree" at the Dallas Arboretum; it was very attractive. My day lilies have gone mad; they are thick as thieves . . . wonder if it's too late to thin them out?

The dahlias are sprouting up; I wasn't sure if they would survive all this water. I just added three new ones to the mix. These are my new favorite flowers; they come in all shapes, sizes and colors. My favorites are the tall ones that grow as high as the rail on our deck. You do need to keep these staked; I just tie them to the rail.

Now that April is here and spring has arrived, we are all anxious to get out and get dirty. We fertilize the lawn, which is Centipede, only once a year, on April 15; who can forget that date? We like Milorganite, it is organic, slow release and won't burn your flowers or shrubbery.

This may sound ridiculous right now, after the massive amounts of rain this year, but remember it when summer gets here and everything begins to wither and dry.

During our Master Gardener training we learned that drainage is not about how fast water runs off your lawn, but how quickly it soaks in. For example, water runs off a

slope, but does it soak into the ground? This is more important than you may realize, if water runs right off the surface nothing gets watered. A drip system waters very slowly and can be helpful on slopes, you can also build a small earthen dam (berm) around your plants, to hold the water longer. Soil type affects watering, clay soil holds water and it runs right through sandy soil. Unfortunately, our soil is mostly clay and doesn't "percolate." This requires buying lots of topsoil to amend any growing beds.

When we add annuals or new shrubs to our garden, I like to water them in with a weak solution of fertilizer, this gives them a good start. Water regularly until they get settled in. After that, a general rule of thumb is that everything in your yard needs at least 1" of water a week, whether from rain or irrigation. If you're like I am and have a hard time judging how much is 1", a suggestion that I've heard is to cut the lid off a tuna fish can and place it where the sprinkler will hit it, if it fills up, you're in good shape. A rain gauge measures rainfall; you should be able to find one for around \$10. Every retiree has at least one rain gauge somewhere.

Have fun this spring, and enjoy this glorious weather!
