

"The weights have been pretty good lately," Lambert said. "I'm not sure if we'll reach 97 pounds like (Greg) Hackney did the last time we were here, but the winner will definitely have over 80 pounds. You're going to need average at least twenty pounds a day to have a shot.

"A lot can change on this river system in a few days, especially with really warm temperatures," Lambert went on to say. "Tournaments on Pickwick have the reputation as being electronic tournaments, but there are going to be many fish caught shallow that we're not looking at on our graphs and depth finders."





legacy will live on through the new tree."

Hunter and his wife, Phyllis, operate American Heritage Trees on a 75acre farm in Lebanon, Tennessee that has been in his family since 1800. Hunter was sad when he learned that the Helen Keller Oak had been cut in 2015 because it was dying and in danger of falling.

"It was a piece" American history," said. "Thirty years ago the tree was estimated to be more than 200 years old. It is very likely that the tree was a sapling in 1776 when America was born. It was definitely here during the Civil War and for all the ups and downs of our nation."

The old tree was more than 10-feet wide at its base. The stump remains next to the spot selected for the new tree.

Sue Pilkilton is the executive director Ivy Green. According to Pilkilton, Anne Sullivan once climbed the tree to rescue Keller. Helen, who was deaf and blind. enjoyed climbing the tree and feeling the textures of its bark and leaves. She had become stranded high in its branches as a powerful

thunderstorm took aim Tuscumbia. Mike McMackin, president of the Helen Keller Birthplace board of directors, said the tree was one of Helen Keller's favorites at Ivy Green.

When Tom Hunter learned of the demise of the Helen Keller Oak, he urged Pilkilton not to worry because American Heritage Trees had successfully germinated several of the acorns he collected from the tree in 2014.

"We collect seeds and cuttings from America's great trees that have grown up at the homes and sites of America's heroes like Helen Keller," Hunter said. "We use those seeds and cuttings to grow new trees to replace the great trees as they are lost. We also sell some of the trees we grow to help pay for the work we do to preserve the legacies of America's great trees."

Garrett Reid is a second rader who helped plant the new tree. He said it was a thrill to be a part of giving the Helen Keller Oak a new lease on life and suggested that it be called the Anne Sullivan Tree.

Addisyn Hatton, who also helped with the planting, said she looks forward to visiting Ivy Green to watch the new tree grow.

This is #7 in the series about why we should be concerned with seniors taking so many pills: <u>Tips to reduce Polypharmacy</u>;

A study in 2010 [Archives of Internal Medicine] showed it's possible to reduce the number of drugs seniors take—without causing any major problems.

For each medication, six questions were Dr. Robert Webb asked: 1) "Is there good evidence to use

the drug at its current dose and do the benefits outweigh known side-effects?" If "yes", then the drug was continued. But, if the answer was "no or not sure", the researchers asked the next five questions below, which, at each step, could result in stopping the drug, trying a different one, or 'make no change'.

2) Is the reason for using the drug appropriate in this age group and disability level?

- 3) Do the possible side-effects outweigh the benefits?
- 4) Are any side-effects present?
- 5) Is there another drug that may be superior?
- 6) Can the dose be reduced without significant risk? If the drug hadn't been stopped or changed, then the

same dose would be continued or the patient could try reducing it anyway.

Using this method, 58% of all drugs were discontinued (averaging 4.4 drugs per patient), with no bad outcomes. The seniors, who averaged 82 years and 7.7 drugs, only had to restart 2% of drugs.

Anyone can do this, but preferably with your doctor's support. Clarifying your health goals will help decisions. For example, if your goal is "live comfortably" and don't want a lot of pills which may only add a few more months of possible suffering – the quality vs quantity issue—then you could stop all the 'non-comfort' drugs.

In general, it is a fact—confirmed in hospice—that generally seniors who take fewer drugs not only feel better but often live longer.

for the third honors consecutive season. The 2014 GSC Pitcher of the Year became the program's all-time leader in pitching victories this year and owns a 62-13 career record. This season, the junior from Hatton has a 1.78 EAR with a 21-3 record.

Madeline Lee led all second basemen in the GSC with a .355 batting average. The senior from Alabaster is third on the team with a .720 slugging percentage after totaling 19 extra-base hits and 10 home runs. Her .855 slugging percentage ranks third in the league.

Raven Cole was the only pitcher to finish Gulf South Conference play with an undefeated mark, posting a 14-0 league record. Her season ERA is 2.12 with 143 strikeouts. The junior from Orange, Texas álso has 17 complete games and 139 innings pitched on the year. Her 23-1 overall record set a new single-season record for pitching wins at UNA.

Reagan Tittle picked up where she left off after a solid freshman season. This year the Lynn, AL native batted .376 with nine doubles, a triple, 10 home runs, and drove in 43 runs. Her 15-game hitting streak was the longest on the team this season.

Cozart becomes the first coach from UNA to win Coach of the Year honors since Ande Jones in 1986. The third-year coach for the Lions has compiled a 122-37 record at the school, including a 46-5 mark this year to set a record for most wins in a season. The team's 30 GSC victories is also a conference record. In the preseason GSC coaches poll, UNA was picked to finish fourth in the league

GSC awards were voted on by head coaches from around the league. Schools were not allowed to vote for their own players or coaches.





Destructive Aliens

Dear Sir:

Donald Trump has taken heat for his proposal to ban Muslim entry into the United States. Some pundits have insisted that the courts would stop him for what they say is an illegal act. I think Trump is on solid ground and that can be done according to law. I was aware of the law which will be discussed later. However, I did not relate it to the current crisis until I read a letter published by the *Washington Times* in December of 2015. I wish to share a paraphrase with your readers.

The Immigration and Nationality Act passed June 27, 1952 revised the laws relating to immigration and

naturalization in the United States. That act became Public Law 414 and established both the law and the intent of Congress regarding the immigration of aliens to the United States. It remains in effect today.

Among the many issues it covers, one in particular, found in Chapter 2 Section 212, is the prohibition of entry to the United States if an alien belongs to an organization seeking to overthrow the government of the United States by "force, violence, or other unconstitutional means." This should rule out Muslim immigration to the United States and acceptance of Muslim refugees, but the law is being ignored by the White House.

Muslim immigration to the United States would be prohibited under this law because the Koran, Sharia Law, and the Hadith all require complete submission to Islam. This is in opposition to the U.S. government, the Constitution, and the republic.

All Muslims who attest that the Koran is their lives' guiding principal subscribe to submission to Islam and its form of government. The politically correct crowd would say that Muslims cannot be prohibited from entering the United States because Islam is a religion. Whether it is a religion is immaterial because the law states that aliens who are affiliated with any organization that advocates the overthrow of our government are prohibited.

HAVE pay-for antivirus and security suites. That's all fine and well. Store-bought antivirus programs generally have a few bells and whistles that the free stuff doesn't offer such as data backup, robust firewalls and

email protection. But despite paying for a quality antivirus program, our clients still get infected. So is "pay-for" antivirus worth it? Probably not,



in my experience. You can get the same capabilities with free stuff if you know where to look.

If you want to do it yourself for free, you're going to have to piece-together some things to get the same protection afforded by store bought stuff. Keep in mind that store-bought programs also

come with free support from the vendor. I'd rather yank out my toenail with pliers than speak to a "support specialist" on the phone but some of you find this valuable. You are on your own if you get a virus using the free stuff I'm about to mention. So without further adieu, here is a short list of programs I recommend instead of buying antivirus software.

ANTIVIRUS: You absolutely must have current and updated antivirus software. Windows 7 users should check out Microsoft Security Essentials. Windows

8 and 10 users already have an updated version of Security Essentials called Windows Defender. This is what I use. "Avast!" antivirus is another quality bit of antivirus with decent user interface. Get it from Avast.com. Another that is worth looking into is Panda free antivirus. Get it from Pandasecurity.com. All of these programs have tested satisfactorily in independent antivirus tests. You should only install ONE antivirus program or they will fight each other and slow your computer down.

MALWARE REMOVAL: The next thing I'd recommend is an antimalware program or two that supplements your antivirus program. These programs only run "on demand" and serve as a second opinion for your primary antivirus program. You need to manually run these programs about once a month or so and delete whatever they find. The first on this list is Malwarebytes Anti Malware. This program finds and removes junk programs and other bits of malware that antivirus programs often miss. Get it from Malwarebytes.org. Superantispyware is excellent at removing some malware and tracking cookies. Get it from Superantispyware.com. FIREWALL: A firewall is

a bit of software that stands between you and the outside world that helps prevent "brute force attacks" from the internet

wilderness. Windows has a firewall that is sufficient for most users. However, if you are uber-concerned about computer security, a more robust firewall may be in order. For those users, I recommend ZoneAlarm. Be aware that add-on firewalls are pretty aggressive and require a bit of interaction from a knowledgeable user. I suggest you try it but be prepared to uninstall it if it gets to be annoying. Get it from ZoneAlarm.com.



was in automobile accident and the other driver the scene of the accident. The police found the car but the person it was registered to said it must have been stolen. I have broken bones in my foot and my car is not drivable. All I have is case is that if the car was liability insurance. What can I do?

Some people make the decision to carry liability insurance only. That insurance is required by law to obtain a tag and registration for an automobile. Liability insurance only protects another driver for injuries and property damage and then only when you are at fault. Liability coverage accomplishes the goal of protecting the other party to some degree but does nothing to pay your medical bills, lost wages, repairs for your car.

All too often we see people declining uninsured motorist coverage usually designated by the insurance company as "IIM coverage". This as "UM coverage". coverage is mandated to be offered as a matter of law and must be declined in writing. Occasionally we find a person who may not have bought UM coverage but didn't decline it in writing and we can make the insurance company provide the coverage. Usually insurance companies are pretty good about having the person sign a waiver of UM and in those cases there is no coverage when an uninsured motorist causes you to be injured.

Uninsured motorist least expensive and best coverage anyone can have.

motorist coverage as part of your automobile insurance.

In your case, we would want to see a signed document where you declined uninsured motorist coverage but the practical reality of your stolen, people who steal cars don't have the money to pay to repair yours. If David, Tuscumbia, AL the owner of the car was the driver and fled the scene due to alcohol or drugs, you would want to see the police report where the car was reported stolen and an insurance claim on the theft if the car was insured.

In this case, after the police report is reviewed and your automobile insurance coverage is checked to make sure that you absolutely declined uninsured motorist coverage in writing, there is really nothing else to be

an Always include uninsured accrue daily charges. If it is totaled, sell it for scrap and move on. Certainly, there are situations where choosing liability coverage only is necessitated by economics but it certainly, as you now know, can be a costly decision.







story of Tubman working the Underground Railroad before the Civil War.

Few may know that Tubman sustained head injury as youngster and dealt with

n a r c o l e p s y, seizures, and dizziness seizures, throughout her adult life. Tubman's owner tried to sell her in the late 1840's, but there were no takers because of her illness. A year later when her owner's family decided to sell the rest of their slaves, Tubman planned their escape. She didn't want her family to be separated so she used the

Underground Railroad to

get to Pennsylvania. She defied unjust laws and fled slavery escaping in 1849. After that Tubman was always armed, usually with a pistol, sometimes with sword, and sometimes That pistol book. went with her on rescue missions. Not only did it offer some protection from slave catchers, it also gave encouragement to some runaways tempted to turn back, risking the safety of the others. Those looking for Tubman knew she couldn't read, so when slave catchers were around she would pull it out. Estimates vary on the number of slaves she led to freedom. There were at least hundreds, maybe thousands.

Records indicate that Tubman also used disguises to her advantage. She was used as a spy during the Civil War carrying a sharp-shooters rifle. She was a cook for troops, and was a nurse at Virginia's Fort Monroe.

Tubman also helped lead 150 black union soldiers in the 1863 Combahee River raid in South Carolina. She has the distinction of being the only woman known to lead a military operation during the Civil War.

After the war historical references have Tubman working actively with Republicans in the women's

suffrage movement. Unfortunately she died in 1913, seven years before her efforts came to fruition.

Tubman underwent brain surgery at Massachusetts

General Hospital in Boston in her later years to alleviate the pain and symptoms from that life-long head injury. She was not able to be sedated during the surgery. She went through the procedure while awake and like many of her Civil War brothers, just withstood

following The are three quotes historically attributed to Tubman:

"I had reasoned this out in my mind; there was one of two things I had a right to, liberty or death. If I could not have one, I would have the other; for no man should take me alive. I should fight for my liberty as long as my strength lasted, and when the time came for me to go, the Lord would let them take me.'

Twant me, 'twas the Lord. I always told him, 'I trust you. I don't know where to go or what to do, but I expect you to lead me,' and He always did."

"I freed thousands of slaves and could have freed thousands more if only they knew they were slaves.

Sure, replacing Jackson on the \$20 bill may stir up some anger from traditionalists. It may cost Nashville some tourism dollars in the long run. However, Tubman is well-deserving of the recognition as a true American hero regardless of gender, color, resources, or education level.

Many question whether Tubman has the credentials to stand with others of national stature.

Maybe we should be asking which of them is worthy of standing with






