THE HISTORY CHANNEL

• On May 19, 1715, the colony of New York passes a law making it illegal to "gather, rake, take up, or bring to the market, any oysters whatsoever" between May and September. This regulation was one of many passed in the early days of America to help preserve certain species.

• On May 22, 1856, Rep. Preston Brooks (D-S.C.) savagely beats Sen. Charles Sumner (R-Mass.) in the halls of Congress as tensions rise over the expansion of slavery. Wielding the gold-topped cane he used for injuries suffered in a duel over politics in 1840, Brooks entered the Senate chamber and attacked Sumner at his desk.

• On May 20, 1873, San Francisco businessman Levi Strauss and Reno, Nevada, tailor Jacob Davis are given a patent to create work pants reinforced with metal rivets, marking the birth of one of the world's most famous garments: blue jeans. They were originally called "waist overalls."

· On May 21, 1881, humanitarians Clara Barton and Adolphus Solomons found the American National Red Cross to provide humanitarian aid to victims of wars and natural disasters.

Is That Sniffle an Allergy or a Cold?

(NAPSA)—It's that time of year again. Your child is sniffling and sneezing, but is it a cold or aller-gies? Often, it can be hard to tell the difference.

Allergies occur frequently in children but sometimes parents remain unaware because it is easy to confuse the symptoms with a common cold. The American Academy of

Allergy, Asthma and Immunology (AAAAI) describes cold symptoms as nasal discharge or congestion, fever, aches and pain.

These symptoms are usually exhibited slightly at first, get worse within a couple of days, and then diminish in under a week.

Allergies on the other hand, come with symptoms which begin quickly and include a runny nose, sneezing, wheezing, watery or itchy eyes, sore throat and a cough that may be worse at night

cough that may be worse at night and in the morning.

Symptoms can remain all season or all year depending on whether your child has seasonal allergies caused by pollen or perennial allergies, which are usually caused by indoor pollutions and the substantial pollutions.

usually caused by indoor pollutants such as dust mites, pet dander, tobacco smoke and molds.

Here's how you can help:

• Keep the windows closed in your car and home, especially on days when forecasts call for medium or high pollen levels. You can check the pollen count in your area at www.cadr.org.

• Limit outdoor activity in the early morning, when pollen counts

early morning, when pollen counts are usually highest.

• Do not hang your laundry

outside to dry as pollen may collect. Instead, use a clothes

dryer.

• Take a shower before bedtime to help remove allergens



When buying an air cleaner, know the square footage of the room you want to treat. You'll want one that's large enough for the room.

Another option for reducing aller-gens in the air is to place a room air cleaner in your child's bedroom.





Don't Fear the Check Engine Light

(NAPSA)—Although the check engine light may look scary lit up on the dashboard, you don't need to panic. A glowing check engine light doesn't mean you have to immediately pull the car to the side of the road: it does mean you should get the car checked out as soon as possible.

"Motorists should not get

spooked when the check engine light comes on," says Rich White, executive director, Car Care Council, the source for the "Be Car Care Aware" campaign promoting regular vehicle care, maintenance and repair. "When illuminated, the check engine light usually means that a vehicle system, such as the ignition fuel injection or emission ignition, fuel injection or emission

control, is not operating properly."

Possible Problems

Some common malfunctions that can cause the light to illuminate include a faulty oxygen sensor, mass air flow sensor, or spark plugs and wires. If the light flashes, the condition is more critical and must be checked immediately to prevent severe damage, which may include catalytic converter problems.

"Even if the vehicle appears to

be running normally, ignoring the warning light could result in more costly repairs," adds White. "At the very least, the light could be alerting you to an engine problem that is negatively impacting fuel economy and costing you money."

Service and Solutions

When scheduling service, make sure the repair shop that exam-ines your vehicle has professional

technicians who are trained and certified in OBDII diagnosis and repair. The technician will connect your vehicle's computer system to a diagnostic scan tool, which will provide trouble codes indicating why the check engine light was activated. While the diagnostic tool is connected, the technician can analyze data streams such as the idle speed, throttle response, engine temperature, fuel system pressure, manifold vacuum, exhaust emission levels and many other key indicators. Once the problem is identified and the repair is made, the car's computer

FOOD IN PRINT

Women of African descent have contributed to America's food culture for centuries, but their rich and varied involvement is still overshadowed by the demeaning stereotype of an illiterate "Aunt Jemima" who cooked mostly by natural instinct.
