Aitkin School Board to vote on \$67 million new school April 18 Remodeling, building options mulled over at three-hour meeting March 29

The Aitkin School Board received a Community Task Force Recommendation on March 29 to build a new \$67.7 million school for grades 5-12. An alternate recommendation is to remodel and add on to Rippleside Elementary and the Aitkin High School for about \$40 million.

The new school would be built on 60 acres of land, yet to be determined, but within two miles of downtown

Aitkin. It would also include areas for community use.

The Community Task Force and the school board, held nearly a three-hour meeting on March 29 in the Aitkin High School auditorium where there was a turnout of 70-100 people. At its last meeting, 21 of 31 task force members attended, and -- at the end of a long meeting -- voted 13-8 to recommend the new school option. If that fails, the remodeling option could be offered in

an election six months later. However, school district voters turned down a proposal for remodeling in January of 2015, and since then, the school board has worked with consultants and the task force to come up with a plan that both it and the voters can support.

The new grades 5-12 school /community center project would have a tax increase of \$237 on a \$100,000 home; \$778 on a \$250,000 home; \$1,653 on a

\$500,000 home; \$1,705 on a commercial property valued at \$250,000; \$3,057 on a commercial property valued at \$500,000 and \$6,362 on a commercial property valued at \$1 million.

The remodeling option would cost \$136 a year on a \$100,000 home; \$445 on a \$250,000 home and \$945 on a \$500,000 home.

Commercial property valued at \$250,000 would pay \$803 more in taxes; a \$500,000 commercial prop-

erty \$1,748 and a \$1 million property \$3,638.

All the information can be found on the isd1.org website by clicking on the red long-range planning button in the upper left corner. The school board also pledged at its March 29 meeting that those without access to a computer can get written material at the school district office located in the high school.

The tax increase would be

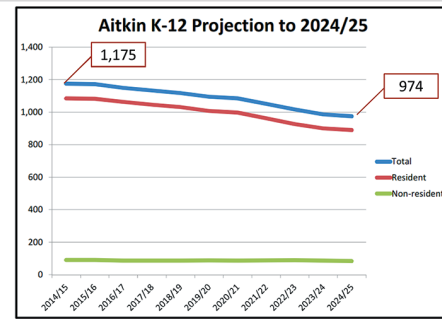

for 20 years. If the school board votes in favor of holding an election, the referendum question will be put before Aitkin School District voters either in the August 2016 primary election; the November 2016 general election or a special election yet to be determined in 2017.

The tax increase would also apply to seasonal "lake cabin" property.

Highlights of the March 29 meeting

About 70-100 people attended the special school board meeting on March 29 located in the high school auditorium. The room seemed mostly composed of those in favor of improving school district facilities – school board, task force members, teachers, former teachers, parents and grandparents.

The meeting, although nearly three hours long, was orderly and civil.

After taking care of a transportation equipment issue, the board turned the meeting over the task force. Board Members Dennis Hasskamp, John Chute, Peter Welshons, Kevin Hoge, Cindi Hills and Jeremy Janzen were all present, with David Burgstaler in contact via computer.

Task force members sat in the front row and were also scattered throughout the audience.

Highlights of the presentations:

Terry Butenhoff has two children who are AHS graduates working as nurses and one child yet to graduate. Because there was a 10-year gap between her second and third child, she saw a big change

in learning. Her youngest daughter does everything on the computer. "I care about the students in the school district," said Butenhoff. She said she's been a school district volunteer for 20 years and will continue to do so even when all her children have graduated.

Kathleen Christy, a present teacher and AHS graduate, noted that enrollment will be dropping over the next 10 years, from 1,175 to 974. She also spoke about a phone survey of 400 residents where 38 percent said they would vote yes to a \$70 million referendum. She referenced 20 community listening sessions that resulted in a list of the 10 greatest school district needs.

Rob Williams, an elementary teacher and parent of three, said: "Regardless of what comes out of this we are a community."

He pointed out that the two buildings are energy-efficient due to upgrades. But a slide on educational adequacy, where each school was evaluated on 17 factors, showed that the high school needed improvement in 16 areas and Rippleside needed improvements in 10 areas (with two areas not applicable at Rippleside). The graphic was

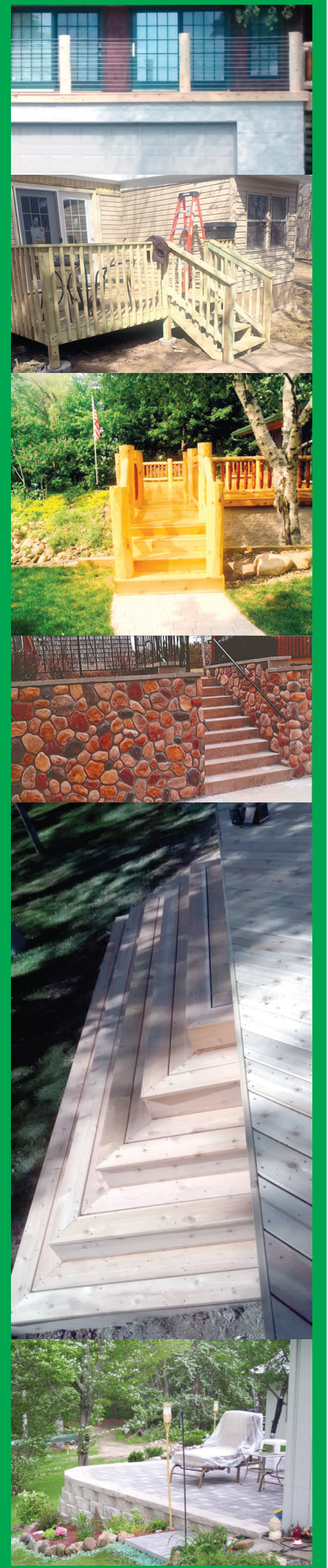

What You Need

- 1 lb ground beef
- 1 pkg taco seasoning mix
- 16 wonton wrappers
- 1 c Mexican blend shredded cheese
- 1 large chopped tomato
- 1/2 c shredded lettuce
- 1 small onion, diced
- 1 can black olives, sliced
- 1/2 c water
- 3/4 c canola oil

Directions

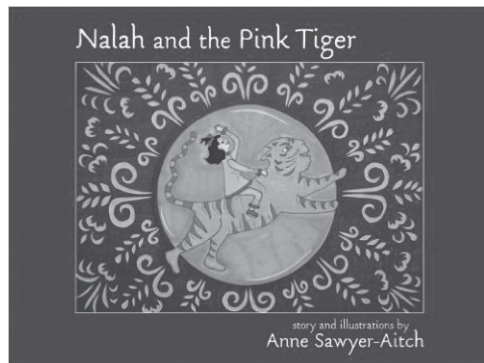
- In a skillet, brown hamburger until no longer pink, drain.
- Add taco seasoning and 1/4 cup water. Let simmer.
- Chop all veggies, set aside.
- Fill wonton wrappers with 1 Tbsp hamburger, sprinkle with cheese, fold in a triangle.

based on stoplights, with areas colored as red or yellow when deficient and green when up to par. Much talk throughout the evening centered on "turning them all the green."

"At Rippleside we are emptying storage rooms to put people into." Williams said that Rippleside lacked adequate square footage while the high school had adequate square footage but lots of outdated spaces.

He and teacher Scott Miller, who spoke next, talked about how education delivery has changed drastically. With the 21st Century learning models, students work in small groups with teachers providing a "compass" not a "map."

"Ultimately, that's why we need renovation of current buildings or a whole new building," said Miller, a high school social studies teacher with children in the district. "Education has completely changed."

Communication, collaboration, critical thinking and cre-

ativity are the skills modern-day employers are looking for.

Bob Cummings, a school district parent and insurance agent, was in favor of a remodeling option. "This creates a viable option that is using our current facilities. We felt we need to keep costs down. It turns red to green on the chart."

Secure entrances at both buildings and a safe car and bus drop-off area at Rippleside were task force priorities.

The remodeling option would cost \$40,527,770: about \$12.2 million at Rippleside and \$28.3 million at the high school. It would necessitate removing the varsity baseball field from north of Rippleside to make more space and relocating it and acquiring property adjacent to the high school for expansion there.

"Lots of this is renovating that probably should have been done over the last 30-40 years," summed up Cummings. "It's a good plan, it meets our needs and wants, and it turns the reds into greens. It gains the support of the Task Force and gains the support of the School Board and most importantly, we want a plan that is acceptable to the taxpayers. In the words of Donald Trump: 'Let's make Aitkin High School great again.'"

Building new

Brian Leitinger and Henry Palm, both parents of school-age children, made the case for building new.

"A new school is a good-long term solution," said Leitinger. The school would be sited on 60 acres within two miles of town. The old high school would be sold or demolished. The present ball fields and tennis court on the edge of town would be sold for new development.

The new school could consolidate everything and include a community center, athletic space and an auditorium. An elementary wing could be added at a later date. This plan would include an estimated \$9.8 million to remodel Rippleside, a new \$36.9 million school; \$1.95 million for the site; \$1 million for utilities and \$18 million for a community center and auditorium for the grand total of \$67.7 million.

"If we are going to build a new campus, let's do it right the first time," said Leitinger.

He noted that this would be safer for students and gives an opportunity for retired people and everyone in the community to use the school. He highlighted that the dedication of the football field as Veterans' Field last fall brought the whole community together for a school event. Land prices and interest rates are favorable now, it was noted, and a new school will attract families and new businesses.

Audience comments

Many spoke positively about the project when the meeting was opened up to the community. Pros and cons were given on holding the election in conjunction with the primary or general elections. The county will absorb the cost of this election if it is not a stand-alone special election. One man said if he had walked into the Crosby High School first before he came to Aitkin he would have picked Crosby because the school is so much nicer.

Aitkin Street Commissioner Bob Nicko cautioned the board that if they aren't in the city limits it will cost three times the regular rate to hook up to the sewer and three times the regular rate to dump into it. Also, the city council could possibly deny the project if it is located in an area where the city doesn't have the capacity to take the utilities on.

"How much can downtown cover for taxes, how much can new families afford? Think about that before you make a decision," said Nicko.

The school board will vote on April 18. In the meantime, more defined information on possible sites will be pinned down.
