### Geneseo's Bear Finds a New Temporary Home

On Wednesday May 4th, Emmeline (the Geneseo Bear) was no longer homeless. The icon had stood atop Geneseo's fountain for many years until a recent traffic accident brought her down. With the support of Village Mayor, Dick Hatheway, the bear is now housed at the Livingston County Museum for all to view at 30 Center Street in the Village of Geneseo.

This is a rare opportunity for visitors who come to the museum to get a close up look at the famous bronze bear. "Her features are amazing", said Museum Administrator Anna Kowalchuk, "up close you can really admire the sculpture." Anna was the first of many who have come to visit the museum to take a "selfie" with the bear. Rub the bear's nose and make a wish!!! The Museum suggests those who photograph themselves with Emmeline make at least a dollar donation, although all donations are graciously accepted.

The fountain and bear are icons in the Village of Geneseo, originally erected in 1888 by the sons of Emmeline Wadsworth in memory of their mother. "I don't know how long until Emmeline will be perched back on her post in the center of Main Street. Until then though, the Livingston County Museum is delighted to provide an opportunity for visitors to see her up close."

The Museum will be open on Graduation Day, May 14th from 10:00am-3:00pm in addition to regularly scheduled hours which are Thursdays and Sundays from 2:00-5:00pm.



### New Exhibit >>>>



On May 1st, 2016 the Livingston County Museum hosted an opening reception for their latest exhibit **Our Towns: The History of Livingston County in 25 Objects.** "If the Smithsonian Museum could exhibit "101 Objects that Made America" and the British Museum could exhibit the "History of the World in 100 Objects", then we could tell the story of Livingston County Towns in 25," commented Museum Administrator, Anna Kowalchuk.

This exhibit introduces visitors to a handful of stories that contribute to the mosaic of life in Livingston County. It's interesting how objects can tell stories about people, our history, culture, and society. Using artifacts representing central stories from the 17 towns that make up Livingston County, as well as eight additional objects from the Museum's collection, the exhibit incorporates the following themes: early inhabitants; industry; enterprise and community; and communities and everyday life.

Next steps will include an interactive component so visitors can explore a particular town's history in greater depth. Additionally, next year, visitors can participate in a passport program while visiting other museums and historical societies in towns in Livingston County which would make them eligible to win a cash award if selected.
