O:I have an old cabinet pur-chased from a London museum by an Indian chief who became a millionaire in Connecticut during the 1920s. The man died during the 1930s. Anything you can tell me about this cabinet would be appreciated. — V.A., Rio Rancho, New

A. Your question is impossible to answer. Who was the chief? Where was the museum? Is there any documentation? Without these facts, it is simply another piece of old fur-niture. If you suspect your cabinet is valuable, hire the services of a good professional appraiser. There are several excellent ones in Albuquerque who can help you.
