





I was hurt on the job and my employer's worker's compensation insurance paid for all my medical bills and sent me money while I was off work. My doctor has said I can go back to work on limited duty and my employer has said that they will find me something to do. Overall, I've been treated pretty well but what happens when the doctor removes all the restrictions and I've finally recovered and go can back to my old job? I am a

Workers compensation is there to pay your medical bills and pay 2/3 of your wages while you are off work. The 2/3 of your wages is known as temporary total disability or TTD. That is supposed to approximate your true wages because that pay is tax free. In real life, people find

TTD to be less than their wag es and they end up short on money unless they savings or a spouse that has an income.

welder.

Your employer is saving money by accommodating your restrictions. Everything that you cost them from medical bills to the final settlement will be recovered by the insurance company in the form of increased workers compensation premiums. Nonetheless, many employers treat workers well and welcome them back to work while others are not so kind. Many employers don't want an injured employee on their premises and really resent an employee that gets hurt.

I talk to people that are injured on the job every day, several times a day. Often people who get hurt want to tell me why it is the employer's fault or a co-employee's fault that they were hurt. I explain to them that under the law of workers compensation, they don't have to prove who was at fault. There is an interesting case where an employee had a trip and fall injury and could not say why they had a trip and fall injury or what they tripped over and the court held that that was not a work related injury even though it happened on the job at Wal-Mart.

Under the Workers Compensation Act if you have a permanent injury, typically after surgery, you will be entitled to some payment for that permanent injury. If you make a full recovery, and I hope you do, and the doctor gives you no restrictions and a zero impairment rating and you haven't had surgery, after your medical bills are paid and your TTD is paid and your mileage is reimbursed that probably concludes your claim. If you do have a permanent injury, depending on what part of your body was injured, you will have a claim for payment. Under certain circumstances, workers have the right to insist on vocational re-training for a job more suitable for them after their injury.





cancel flights.

Since hot air balloons go where the wind takes them, pilots are at the mercy of nature. The best times for balloon flights is early in the morning and late afternoon. At those times the winds are calmest and most predictable.

The Alabama Jubilee is one of the few balloon events remaining that allows the public to walk on the field during balloon launches and operations. Visitors are allowed to freely walk among the balloons and are encouraged to spend the day seeing these magnificent flying machines in action and asking pilots questions. spectators even Some get pulled into crewing spontaneously!

While on the field please remember to follow the rules and comply with all pilot requests. Do not touch the balloon equipment or walk over the tether lines unless you are cleared to do so by the pilot or crew members.

Saturday morning is the 'hare & hound' race, and during the evening there is the always popular Balloon Glow that lights up the night sky.

Sunday morning balloons fly into the field in the Lynn Layton Key Grab. Sunday evening many balloons offer free tethered rides!





# A visit to South America inspires a new goal to help dogs

ou've probably heard the phrase "all dogs go to heaven." If you ask your dog if he likes his life, he'd probably tell you that living in your house is heaven on earth. But what about quality of life for dogs in other countries or continents? How are they treated?

I've been blessed to have traveled to more than 80 countries in my life and career. While there are places where canines live lives that are as good as or better than what ours have in North America — I think of France as a great example — in most developing countries and some modern societies, dogs are lucky to survive. Only a precious few thrive.

My wife, Teresa, and I recently took a six-week trip to South America, where we visited several countries, including Argentina, Chile, Peru, Bolivia and Ecuador. In Argentina, we saw many "paseadores de perros," or dog walkers, on the streets, with six to 10 dogs at a time. As you know, walking is good for both a dog's mind and body, and this is a great social activity. Unfortunately, the vast majority of dogs we saw were living lives that focused on the basics of food, water and shelter.

At home, we watch our dogs like children. We have fenced yards, walk our dogs on leashes and are diligent about protecting them from dangers ranging from antifreeze spills and poisonous plants to traffic and aggressive dogs.

In most of South America, many dogs are let inside to sleep at night but are turned

out in the morning to go explore the farm, neighborhood or town. You see them moving down sidewalks or roadsides like commuters headed to work. They spend the day rummaging or begging for food, playing, grooming each other, exploring or snoozing in the sun. We never saw anyone physically abuse an animal by hitting, kicking or throwing rocks, but we also saw that people had little physical contact with the dogs. It was rare to see anybody petting or hugging them, let alone kissing them. They were largely treated like animals, not family members.

Almost all of the dogs on the street (who weren't being walked on a leash or carried) had fleas. It was two steps forward, stop, scratch, continue on. Or they'd lie down, close their eyes, wake up to scratch or bite those pesky fleas and close their eyes again. Because of the fleas, lack of regular bathing and poor nutrition, the dogs' coats were typically coarse, dry and thin, with skin that looked and smelled unhealthy.

Being a veterinarian and a lifelong pet lover, I always look for ways to interact with local dogs. I can tell you from having done this at least 100 times in six weeks, every time Teresa or I approached a dog, baby talked to him and pet him on the neck or chest, he'd close his eyes with pleasure and lean in for more. Many would roll over for a belly rub. Most of these dogs didn't suffer from physical malnutrition but instead from emotional starvation.

This trip and our travels throughout the world have redoubled our support of World Vets, who do so much for animals all over the globe.



Dear Meghan, First of all, congratulations on his being clean for two years. That's awesome! The longer he stays clean, the more he'll begin to normalize his mechanical activities with things like money.

I agree with not putting him in charge of large sums of money just yet. However, we work with addicts all the time at my company, and I don't agree that you can't have any money in the house when he has been clean for two years. You might not want a big pile of cash lying around, but there's no reason you can't run the envelope system out of your purse. I mean, at this point if you can't trust him to stay out of your purse, then you've got other major issues in your marriage.

I think you need to be on a debit card and the enve-



My husband is a recovering lope system. I also think you need to be controlling about 98 percent of the money for now. For what he's doing, I'd work daily cash allowances and expand that to weekly when you're comfortable with it. Also, ask for some accountability from him as to where the pocket mon-ey goes. Ask him to keep receipts, and turn them in as if he were working for a company and taking a petty cash withdrawal. That holds him accountable for spending it on what he said he was spending it on, and it's healthy for someone who's a recovering addict.

When someone's fresh recovering from being an addict, and especially because heroin is so addicting, I probably wouldn't let him legally have access to the household account for a while longer. He can look at it, and you two can make financial decisions together, but you are in control of it. I wouldn't want it where he can just reach over and clean out the account if he has a relapse.

Obviously, this guy has gotten some healing and I'm very proud of you both. Heroin is a big deal and a hard habit to kick. The fact that he has done it this long is awesome!

other day. I acted out on an almost irrational flood of frustration. And this time it involved food too.

Once when I was around thirteen or fourteen years old, I was home alone or at least I was until my dad showed up. He had been drinking, as he had most of the nights of my childhood. I heard him come in, but didn't go check on him. just continued what I was doing. Since I had been home alone, I had decided to treat myself to some brownies. You have to understand that in my growing-up house we only had dessert on Sundays. Every now and again during the week, my mom would allow my sisters to make chocolate pudding from one of those little boxes or they could make Jell-O that got solid in the refrigerator - just plain Jell-O without fruit in it. I never knew people put fruit in Jell-O until I was in high school. Now, I don't know if these things, Sundayonly desserts and no-fruit Jell-O, were so because we couldn't afford otherwise or my mother just didn't want us eating dessert. But I had decided I didn't care about all that on this night. I was going to treat myself to some brownies.

When the baking time was up, I went to check on the brownies. They were burned! Someone had turned the temperature of the oven up. Well, there was only me and my dad. I went and found him stonecold asleep lying across his bed. Well, I picked up a pillow off that bed and started hitting him on the head, on the back... Hitting him and crying and shouting and hitting him. Saying, "You burned my brownies!" "You burned my brownies!" "Why can't I just have one night to enjoy some brownies!?' One night that he didn't affect... One night to treat gmail.com

It happened again the myself. Oh, the flood of frustration over always having to accommodate his problem... Always having to be nice anyway. "You burned my brownies." Oh, I get tired now thinking about how wiped out I was when I finished beating him with that pillow. It felt so\_good.

I felt just a touch of that same frustration the other day at Chick-fil-A, when after I sat down, husband reached over and ate the biggest fry that was falling out of my container. Now, you have to understand, I have intentionally cut down on carbs and once a month, on the 15th of the month, I treat myself to some french fries. And he had just reached over and ate my fry. "You ate my best fry!" "You ate my biggest french fry!" I didn't grab anything and start hitting him, but everyone near us could hear my protest. 'Once a month I get fries!" "Why didn't you order fries!?" Why can't I have one moment for me?... Why can't I have something that is just for me? It was a flood of frustration over wifehood, motherhood, over personhood. If I had beat him with my straw maybe I would have felt better.

Absent of Congressional action, patients may lose access to those life-saving medications in emergency situations and established practice will be disrupted because laws have not kept up with the evolution of medicine.

To remedy this dilemma, Congressman Hudson has authored H.R. 4365, the Protecting Patient Access to Emergency Medications Act. This legislation will clarify that the current practice of physician Directors Medical overseeing care provided by paramedics and other emergency medical service practitioners via standing statutorily allowed and protected. The use of standing orders is necessary so

Directors can establish these pre-set protocols which emergency medical service practitioners follow in delivering emergency medical care. In the absence of standing orders, patients would not have access to the time-sensitive and potentially life-saving interventions they desperately need.

H.R. 4365 patients will continue to receive these vital medications by:

\*Codifying the practice of standing orders by a physician Medical Director for the administration and delivery of controlled substances, maintaining physician oversight of medical decisions while making the EMS Agency liable for the receiving, storing, and tracking of controlled substances, similar to current procedure at hospitals.

This Legislation endorsed by: American Academy of Emergency American Medicine, of Pediatrics, Academy National Association of Police Organizations, and over a dozen other medically-related associations.





Where do hummingbirds migrate?

According to Hill, Ruby-Throated hummingbirds migrate from Central America across the Gulf of Mexico to the United States. Hummingbirds visit North America in the spring and summer.

During their travel, Ruby-Throated hummingbirds help pollinate. <sup>'</sup>They carry pollen to the flower and the flower gives the hummingbird a sweet nectar in return.

### Why do we want to attract hummingbirds?

Besides being beautiful birds, they eat a lot of annoying pests, such as mosquitos, beetles, flies, and spiders such as daddy long legs.

What colors attract hummingbirds?

They are attracted to the color red. So any red plants such as Buckeye flowers catch their attention. A lot of gardeners keep red hummingbird feeders in their gardens to attract them.

"Hummingbirds have been trained by humans," Hill said. "If they recognize a (red) feeder, they know to stop at it."

What plants attract hummingbirds?

There are many of plants that could already be attracting hummingbirds to your garden such as azaleas, buckeye flowers, cape honeysuckle, cardinal flowers, cypress vines, and petunias just to name a few.

Do hummingbirds actually hum?

3 - Let it cool before putting it into the feeder. You don't want to hurt hummingbirds with boiling water!

So, if you are trying to attract hummingbirds, be sure to plant some of the red plants suggested or get a red feeder! If you have an old feeder that you don't feel like replacing, be sure to tie a red ribbon on to it and that will easily help attract hummingbirds.




