



#### Driver's License 438-1915

Tests for Driver's License and/or permits are given at the Driver's License Station, 4110 Thornton Taylor Parkway on every Monday through Friday from 8:30 A.M. until 5:00 P.M., all testing is finished by 3:30 P.M. You must furnish the car for taking the test.\* You can obtain a manual to study before you go take the test by going by the Driver's License Station. Applicants must show social security card or certified document with social security number on it. All first time applicants must bring birth certificate and 2 proofs of residence. \*Do not do road tests in bad weather.

#### **Pet Laws**

The ordinance regarding pet laws within the City Limits of Fayetteville states that dogs must be confined or controlled by a leash and all pets should be given rabies shots, and must also wear their identification tags indicating they have had these shots, and they must be licensed within the City of Fayetteville. If, for any reason, an animal needs to be picked up off the street, one can call the Animal Control Office number, 433-3726. Rabies clinics are sponsored by the Health Department during the spring of each year and are announced in the newspaper and on the radio. The rabies shots are given by any of the veterinarians in the City throughout the year.

#### **Voting Laws** 433-6220

Newcomers to the City and County may register to vote after living in the state of Tennessee as soon as they become residents. The Election Commissioner's Office is located at 208 E. Davidson Drive. Anyone who is 18 years of age or who will be 18 on the day of the next election, can register to vote. The books for voter registration are closed 30 days before an election. The hours of the Election Commission Office are 8:00 A.M. until 4:00 P.M. Monday through Friday. Any registered voter can vote early.

#### Property Taxes City: 433-6154 • County: 433-1371

Property taxes are due on the first day of October of each year, and are delinquent as of the first day of March. There is a 1.5% interest rate per month and a penalty charged to any delinquent taxes. City taxes are payable at the City Clerk's Office in the Municipal Building in downtown Fayetteville. County property taxes are payable in the Trustee's Office, Room 103, at the County Courthouse.

#### Automobile Tag and Title 433-2454

If you have moved to this area from outside the state, you need to apply for a title and a Tennessee license plate. You need to make the purchase as soon as possible. These licenses may be obtained from the County Court Clerk's Office in the Lincoln County Courthouse. The office is in Room 102 and is open Monday–Friday 8:00 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. It is open the last Saturday of the month from 9:00 a.m.–12:00 Noon. You must also purchase a wheel tax sticker, which is \$50 per year. Registration and proof of insurance must be in the glove box of the vehicle.







There is no better place to enjoy the variety of entertainment and displays of agricultural products than a county fair, especially the Lincoln County Fair, one of the most decorated and recognized fairs in Tennessee.

"Over 100,000 people come to the fair here each year to enjoy the livestock, 4-H and agricultural exhibits, handicrafts, art, commercial displays and the family-friendly entertainment," said Jimmy Carter, president of the fair's Board of Directors. "We've got one of the best fairs in the state, and it's all without any taxpayer funds from the county or city."

The fair, approaching its 112<sup>th</sup> year, has three times been crowned the state's Champion of Champions Fair, a distinction given by the Tennessee Association of Fairs.

"This is a result of many hours of hard work and dedication by a board of volunteers committed to sharing their enthusiasm for our community, for agriculture and for family fun," said Carter. "It is also due to a great community of people who love to come to the fair. Without all of you who enjoy the fun, food, exhibits and entertainment, there would be no fair."

Known for its harness racing as well as such events as the demolition derby, truck and tractor pull, draft horse and mule shows, just to name a few, the fair keeps people coming back.

"We are a true county fair where people who don't live on farms can learn about agriculture, where hundreds of local children can participate in 4-H and compete on the local and state levels," he continued, noting that 80 percent of the income generated by gate admission fees is put back into the production of the fair, including paying premiums and/or prize money. Much

of the remaining 20 percent, coupled with loan proceeds and matching state Department of Agriculture grants, have funded approximately \$370,000 in improvements at the fairgrounds over the last five years," states Carter.

"Corporate sponsorship donations from local businesses help cover costs of advertising, catalog, hiring entertainment and many other expenses that are necessary to start up the fair each year," said Carter.

"Putting together the fair is a major production," he said. "And it takes everyone pulling together, from the local groups to the businesses and industries, to make it a success."

Situated on 33 acres near the heart of Fayetteville, the Lincoln County Fairgrounds is actually owned privately by stockholders, who do not receive dividends except for a season pass each year to the fair. In its 100-plus-year history, it's survived many adversities, from the Great Depression, World War II and other challenges.

"While the Lincoln County Fair board supports economic growth in Lincoln County, we also want to continue to support the deep-rooted traditions that make this county a great place to live," he added.

In 1991 a group of citizens began brainstorming to begin a local festival to promote Fayetteville Lincoln County and the downtown area. A Christmas themed festival was decided upon and Host of Christmas Past was born.

In keeping with the annual Christmas Open House tradition, The Flower House began twenty five years prior, the date of the 2nd weekend in November was set. Since then, more businesses and organizations have participated, making this truly a community event. While the downtown area is still the center of activities, other areas of the community have seen the benefit from participating. An estimated 18,000 people attend each year.

Bedford County and named for the Revolutionary War hero, Gen. Benjamin Lincoln. This region came from lands ceded by the Cherokee and Chickasaw nations some years earlier. These historic

tribes and others had used the area as hunting grounds for the fur trade. Centuries earlier, large permanent populations of early, middle and late woodlands people occupied what is now Lincoln County; and village sites, graves, and artifacts, as well a number of mounds offer ample evidence of their presence. In the first decades of the county's history, settlers pouring into the region cleared the river and creek bottoms of vast seas of cane and felled the great forests on the hills and ridges. Among these pioneers was the renowned David Crockett. Surplus produce, chiefly in the form of whiskey and lard, was shipped down the Elk River on flatboats into the Tennessee, the Ohio and, finally, the Mississippi Rivers to markets in Natchez of New Orleans.

By the mid nineteenth century, Lincoln County was a prosperous agricultural section, producing a variety of grains and some cotton. The limestone of this ancient sea bed made for splendid pastures, and the county was noted for its fine livestock. Commercial distilling was also a significant industry, and the distinctive Lincoln County process for sour mash whiskey provided another valuable export. Several turnpikes, a railroad connection and the remarkable Stone Bridge over the Elk made access to Huntsville, Nashville and more distant markets possible.

This period of prosperity came to a rapid end with the advent of the Civil War. Both Confederate and Federal armies stripped the county for food, livestock and fodder. From 1863 until the conclusion of the war, Lincoln County was occupied by the Federal Army, and the once prosperous agricultural economic base was devastated. Within a few decades the county recovered and, again, its prosperity was based on diversified farming, livestock production and a few local industries. Among the latter were lumber milling, textiles, flour and grist mills and distilling. From the early decades of the


after World War II and the loss of large creameries transformed the landscape and the county's agricultural base, as well as its demographics. Today, much of what was once cleared and cultivated land is either in permanent pasture for beef

cattle or in woodlands. Lincoln County leads the state in beef production, and with the re-introduction of whitetail deer and the wild turkey is a hunter's paradise.

Shortly after the first county court met, plans for a county seat were made. The state had mandated the town be planned around a central courthouse square. On one hundred acres obtained from the area's first settler, Ezekiel Norris, the town was platted and lots sold in 1810. From its inception Fayetteville has been the county's governmental and economics center. In its first decade, Fayetteville entered regional history where Gen. Andrew Jackson mobilized an army across the Elk at Camp Blount for his campaign against the Creek nation. The young Sam Houston, hero of Horseshoe Bend, was among those who mustered here. In honor of a young Fayetteville attorney who fell in that battle, the state of Alabama named its capitol city.

The courthouse square remains viable and attractive. A number of well-preserved commercial buildings attest to the significance it once held in the nineteenth to mid twentieth centuries as the county's economic hub. It still boosts such essential businesses as hardware, drug, clothing, jewelry, and book stores, as well as gifts and antique stores and offices of real estate and law firms. As of old, there are restaurants, pool halls and a theatre.

The Lincoln County Fair whose roots can be traced to the antebellum period, persists, celebrating the county's agricultural heritage and its pride in harness racing. A noteworthy, privately maintained county museum preserves physical evidence of "Old Lincoln's" history. In its bicentennial year, the citizens of this county have good reason for celebrating their heritage.



Camp Blount Historical Park
This park celebrates the must of the TN Volunteers with General Andrew Jackson before they left to defeat the Creek Indians at the Battle of Horseshoe Bend. Rich in Frontier and Civil War History, Lincoln County is the home of numerous historical landmarks such as Camp Blount, one of the few historic sites in Tennessee associated with the War of 1812.



ajor companies like Frito-Lay, Franke Foodservice Systems, C&S Plastics, Copperweld, Gregory Manufacturing and Genesco have long been big players in the Fayetteville business community, but that hasn't kept a large number of residents from traveling to Northern Alabama—or beyond—for employment opportunities nevertheless. The Fayetteville-Lincoln County Industrial Development Board (FLCIDB) vies to keep more of the talent local by bringing in new industries and providing them with space in which to thrive.

"The number one goal is to create job opportunities in the community," says Elaine Middleton, executive director for the board, adding that more than 4,000 residents commute out of the county each day, many of them to the Huntsville area.

Since making this a priority in 2012, the FLCIDB has seen three industries expand and one existing industry acquire assets, Middleton says. It was also announced in January that two global companies will move their operations to Fayetteville.

"We are excited that Nippon Steel has decided to locate its first U.S. plant here in Tennessee," Randy Boyd, Tennessee Department of Economic and Community Development Commissioner, said in a statement. "It is great to have Nippon Steel joining Team Tennessee and I want to thank them for creating valuable jobs in Lincoln County." The metal substrate manufacturer, a major subsidiary of Nippon Steel & Simitomo Metal Corporation, will invest \$5.7 million and create 65 new jobs. Less than 10 days after this announcement, Toledo Molding & Die, Inc. unveiled plans to build a new manufacturing facility in Fayetteville, too. A global, full-service supplier of interior and air and fluid management systems for the automotive industry, TMD plans to invest \$20 million and create 250 new jobs. "Tennessee's rural communities are the heart of our state in so many ways, and we're building on our work to create a measured, thoughtful approach to supporting economic development in our rural areas," Governor Bill Haslam said in a statement. "We appreciate TMD for providing new opportunities for so many hardworking Tennesseans and bringing us one step closer toward our goal to make Tennessee the No. 1 location in the Southeast for high quality jobs."

The city's trio of industrial parks—Bullington Industrial Park, Runway Center Industrial Park and Fayetteville-Lincoln County Industrial Park—has made it an attractive place for such companies to take up residence. Nippon Steel's 62,000-square-foot space and TMD's 126,000-square-foot manufacturing facility will both occupy the newest of the three, Fayetteville-Lincoln County Industrial Park. The addition of these companies to the local economic landscape was welcome news in the wake of Daikin's announcement last year that it would be moving all of its U.S. operations to Houston—taking with it roughly 1,800 jobs.

"We're working to offset that as much as possible. Our hope is that we can get many of the other companies here to replace [those jobs]," Middleton says, explaining that the board will continue to focus on existing industries rather than solely bringing new ones in. "It's easier to build upon what you already have. The new industries are fabulous, but the bulk of job creation in your community comes within your existing industry."

Pending government approval, construction of an 80,000-square-foot spec building in the Fayetteville-Lincoln County Industrial Park is also on the docket, which will allow Lincoln County "to participate in opportunities to attract new industries through the community," Middleton says.

"Eighty-five percent of the folks looking for [space] are looking for existing buildings," she says. "A lot of these companies are trying to find a building that may not be the perfect fit but something they can retrofit in a short amount of time to get their business either started or relocated and up and operational."

in having such spaces available for companies to lease has kept it ahead of the curve and that Lincoln County has been lucky to have government with the mindset: "you've got to have inventory to market."

"We're really fortunate to have the existing industries that we do," she concludes. "We go above and beyond to ensure that we capture any opportunities they may have for growth. My hope is that, in 10 years, our industrial parks that we currently own are completely full with new or expanded industries and that we're searching for land."

These schools provide opportunities for area post high school youths to acquire further technical skills. In addition, these facilities offer supplementary job training programs for those workers interested in acquiring new skills or improving their technical ability for upgrading themselves in their present job.

Course schedules are available upon request from the schools.

Continuing Education courses are offered by the Lincoln County Department of Education, Motlow Community College and the State Area Vocational-Technical Schools.

Fayetteville, Lincoln County and surrounding areas will pass into this next century with the capability of a more highly skilled trained work force and a higher quality of life as a result of the Don Sundquist Center For Advanced Technology, which is located behind Motlow State Community College on Winchester Highway.



### A Word From City Mayor Jon Law


