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



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#### **COBRE VALLEY CASSEROLE**

#### Ingredients

- 1 pound ground beef
- 1 medium onion, chopped
- 1 celery rib, chopped
- 1 envelope taco seasoning
- 1/4 cup water

• 2 cans (16 ounces each) refried beans

- 1 can (4 ounces) chopped green chilies, optional
- 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded cheddar cheese
- 2 green onions, sliced
- 1 large tomato, peeled, seeded and chopped
- 1/3 cup sliced ripe olives
- 1-1/2 cups crushed tortilla chips

#### Directions

• 1. In a large skillet, cook the beef, onion and celery over medium heat until meat is no longer pink; drain. Stir in the taco seasoning, water, beans and, if desired, green chilies.

• 2. Transfer to a greased 11x7-in. baking dish. Bake, uncovered, at 350° for 30 minutes or until heated through. Top with cheese, green onions, tomato, olives and chips.

#### PASTA-CHICKEN-BROCCOLI BAKE

#### Ingredients

1/2 cup butter1/2 cup chopped sweet onion1/2 cup chopped red bell pepper





## **CASSEROLES**

- 2 garlic cloves, minced
- 1/4 cup all-purpose flour
- 3 cups chicken broth
- 1 1/2 cups half-and-half
- 1/2 cup dry white wine
- 1 cup (4 oz.) freshly shredded Parmesan cheese
- 1/4 teaspoon salt
- 1/4 teaspoon ground red pepper
- 1 (20-oz.) package refrigerated cheese-andspinach tortellini
- 4 cups chopped fresh broccoli
- 4 cups chopped cooked chicken
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan cheese
- 15 round buttery crackers, crushed
- 1/2 cup chopped pecans
- 3 tablespoons butter, melted

#### Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°. Melt 1/2 cup butter in a Dutch oven over medium-high heat; add onion and next 2 ingredients, and sauté 5 to 6 minutes or until tender.

2. Add flour, stirring until smooth. Cook, stirring constantly, 1 minute. Whisk in broth, half-and-half, and white wine. Reduce heat to medium, and cook, stirring constantly, 6 to 8 minutes or until thickened and bubbly.

Remove from heat; add 1 cup cheese and next
 ingredients, stirring until cheese melts. Stir in
 tortellini and next 2 ingredients. Spoon into a
 lightly greased 13- x 9-inch baking dish.
 Stir together 1/2 cup grated cheese and next 3
 ingredients. Sprinkle over casserole. Bake at 350°
 for 40 to 45 minutes or until bubbly.





#### HAM AND CHICKEN CASSEROLE

#### Ingredients

1 cup chopped onion 2 tablespoons butter 2 cups cubed fully cooked ham

2 cups diced cooked chicken 1 medium green pepper, chopped

1/2 cup chopped sweet red pepper

1 cup pimiento-stuffed olives

1 can (10-3/4 ounces) condensed cream of mushroom soup, undiluted

1 cup (8 ounces) sour cream

1-1/2 teaspoons salt

1/4 teaspoon pepper

8 ounces noodles, cooked and drained

3 tablespoons shredded Parmesan cheese

#### Directions

1. In a skillet, saute onion in butter until tender. In a large bowl, combine the ham, chicken, peppers, olives, soup, sour cream, salt, pepper and onion. Fold in noodles.

2. Pour into a greased 2-1/2-qt. baking dish. Sprinkle with the Parmesan cheese. Bake, uncovered, at 325° for 45 minutes or until bubbly.

#### **HEARTY CHICKEN CASSEROLE**

#### Ingredients

2 celery ribs, chopped 1 small onion, chopped







1-1/2 teaspoons olive oil 3 cups cubed cooked chicken breast

1 can (16 ounces) kidney beans, rinsed and drained 1 can (15 ounces) black beans, rinsed and drained 1 tablespoon chili powder 2 teaspoons ground cumin 1 can (14-1/2 ounces) no-



salt-added diced tomatoes, undrained 1 can (10-3/4 ounces) reduced-fat reduced-sodium condensed cream of mushroom soup, undiluted 1 cup (4 ounces) shredded reduced-fat cheddar cheese

#### Directions

1. Preheat oven to 350°. In a large nonstick skillet coated with cooking spray, saute celery and onion in oil until tender. Stir in chicken, beans, chili powder and cumin; heat through.

2. Transfer to a shallow 2-1/2-qt. baking dish coated with cooking spray. Combine tomatoes and soup; pour over chicken mixture.

3. Bake, uncovered, 20 minutes. Sprinkle with cheese. Bake 5-10 minutes longer or until heated through and cheese is melted.

Freeze option: Cover and freeze unbaked casserole up to 3 months. To use, thaw in the refrigerator overnight. Remove from refrigerator 30 minutes before baking. Preheat oven to 350°. Bake according to directions. Yield: 6 servings.

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



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

## **Dr. Geoff Gaunt** "Your Hometown Dentist"

Hello Readers,

This month we have a reader's question that fits right into our ongoing discussion of "getting back to basics"!

In fact, her name isn't even being withheld to protect the innocent!! Our question this month is from Sandra Bishop who asks, "How many times a day does a person swallow?"

Well, Sandra, I didn't know, but thanks to Google, I was able to find a few articles that had varying results. The best one was from the *Archives of Oral Biology* that made it clear that it is determined by several factors including the general health of the person and the different salivary flow rates during the course of the day. The greatest production of saliva occurs when a person is eating, and the lowest is during sleep. This particular study was of people of good health, and the testing included times of eating, sleeping and normal activity. The range among people was from 200 and 1000 times a day, for an average of around 585 times a day.

We typically will see fewer cavities in people with better saliva production. Saliva dilutes acids and sugars and essentially washes the teeth. Unfortunately, many medicines reduce salivary production, so people on more medicines are more likely to get cavities even if they have had good dental health their whole lives. Also, sugary snacks and drinks before bedtime is not a good idea because salivary flow is very low during sleep.
