

their first-ever national softball title. The team broke or tied 29 individual and team school records at the single-season and career levels.

Aside from the national title, UNA also won the Gulf South Conference regular season and

tournament championships before taking home its first ever South Region title in the playoffs. The Lions finished the regular season with a 46-5 record before posting a 14-2 mark in the postseason. North Alabama won twice on the same day to advance in the regional, super regional, and national finals.

National runner-up Humboldt State finished just short of its third championship national before falling to UNA. The Jacks (54-8-1) finished #2 in the final rankings. National semifinalists State Armstrong and Southern Ärkansas came in at #3 and #4 respectively. West Texas A&M entered the post-season as the nation's top-ranked team and finished at #5.

A celebration was scheduled May 31 with a Walk of Champions down Court Street from Rogers Hall to 306 Barbeque.



I was in an automobile accident and the other driver left the scene of the accident. The police found the car but the person it was registered to said it must have been stolen. I have broken bones in my foot and my car is not drivable. All I have is liability insurance. What can I do?

Glenn, Muscle Shoals, AL

Some people make the decision to carry liability insurance only. insurance is required by law to obtain a tag and registration for an automobile. Liability insurance only protects another drive for injuries and property damage and then only when you are at fault. Liability coverage accomplishes the goal of protecting the other party to some degree but does

nothing to pay your medical bills, lost wages, pain and suffering or repair your car.

All too often we see people declining uninsured motorist coverage usually designated by the insurance company as "UM coverage". This coverage is mandated to be offered as a matter of law and must be declined in writing. Occasionally we find a person who may not have bought UM coverage but didn't decline it in writing and we can make the insurance company provide the coverage. Usually insurance companies are pretty good about having the person sign a waiver of UM and in those cases there is no coverage when an uninsured motorist causes you to be injured.

Uninsured motorist coverage is some of the least expensive and best coverage anyone can have. Always uninsured motorist coverage as part of your automobile insurance.

In your case, we would want to see a signed document where you declined uninsured motorist coverage but the practical reality of your case is that if the car was stolen, people who steal cars don't have the money to pay to repair yours. If the owner of the car was the driver and fled the scene due to alcohol or drugs, you would want to see the police report where the car was reported stolen and an insurance claim on the theft if the car was insured.

In this case, after the police report is reviewed and your automobile insurance coverage is checked to make sure that you absolutely declined uninsured motorist coverage in writing, there is really nothing else to be done. Don't let your car sit at the tow yard and accrue daily charges. If it is totaled, sell it for scrap and move on. Certainly, there are situations where choosing liability coverage only is necessitated by economics but it certainly, as you now know, can be a costly decision.

I wish you the best of luck. Buckle up and drive safely.





# Safe Oil, Gas Nothing to Complain About

eologists at the University of Cincinnati just wrapped up a three-year investigation of hydraulic fracturing and its impact on local water supplies. The result? There's no evidence

· zero, zilch, nada -- that fracking contaminates drinking water. Researchers hoped to keep these

findings secret.

Why would a public research university boasting a top-100 geology program deliberately hide its work? Lead researcher, Amy Townsend-Small explained, "The groups that had given us funding in the past were a little disappointed in our results. They feel that fracking is scary and so they were hoping our data could point to a reason to

That an environmentalist ideologue would see evidence of fracking's safety as "disappointing" is to be expected. However, that a university would so flagrantly put politics before science is deeply troubling.

Hydraulic fracturing has significantly bolstered America's energy independence by unlocking an abundance of domestic oil and gas. In fact, our country has officially surpassed Russia and Saudi Arabia as the global leader in natural gas and oil production, respectively.

Equally important is that these newfound energy resources have delivered economic benefits to Americans. In 2012 the average U.S. household had an extra \$1,200 thanks to the energy boom. The oil and gas industry, meanwhile, supports more than two million jobs -- a number that is expected to grow to nearly five million by 2025.

This energy renaissance has also helped the environment since fracking provides a cheaper and cleaner alternative to coal. Last April energy-related CO2 emissions hit a 27-year low, according to the U.S. Energy Information Administration. This decline was due largely to a widespread transition from coal to natural gas.

None of these benefits would matter if fracking endangered drinking water. So the University of Cincinnati's report comes as good news. Of course, the findings only



received a hundred calls over the past week from irate clients who were tricked into upgrading. One of those was my dear wife who was minutes away from giving an important presentation when Microsoft decided she needed a juicy steak.

Windows 10 is a worthy upgrade. It's faster, more secure and even free until July 30th. But some of you just don't like change or might have old software that doesn't play well with Windows 10. Or maybe you're a vegetarian and just don't eat steak.

Microsoft's new pop-up notification tells PC owners they are scheduled for a recommended upgrade to Windows 10" at a specific time in the near future, and bears a prominent "OK" button. Most of you don't ever read this stuff and simply click the prominent "OK" box instead of the tiny print that says "Click here to change or cancel upgrade." As a result, many of you insist that you never gave permission for the upgrade.

This free juicy steak is available until July 30th. After

that, the upgrade will cost about \$120.00. Why is Microsoft doing this? The deal is that Microsoft` promised their software developer partners that they would deliver at least 1 billion new Windows 10 customers that would frequent Microsoft's "Store" and buy stuff from those developers. The Microsoft store is just like Android's Play Store or Apple's App Store, but for Microsoft PCs, tablets and phones. So far, they've only attracted about 300 million. So Microsoft is feeling the pressure to make good on their promise to their developers. They are transferring that pressure to you.

If you are one of those victims, I'd recommend you try to hang with Windows 10 if you can. But if you insist, it's easy to downgrade back to your previous operating system. Simply perform a search for "recovery" in the

new Cortana search bar and all will be revealed. It will take about 10 minutes to complete the process. You only have 30 days to downgrade. After that, Windows 10 becomes permanent. For those who never want to be bothered with the upgrade again, download a program called "Never10" from GRC.com. It's 100% free and dead-simple to install.





# BEE CAREFUL

# What to do if a bee stings your pet

Then my dog Harper was a young puppy, a bee stung her **V** V on a hind leg. I didn't know what was causing all the screaming and running in circles until I saw the bee fall to the ground. I called the veterinarian, who recommended a quarter tablet of Benadryl and a cold compress. It was hours before Harper was willing to eat or go outside to potty.

It's bee season again. Spring is a busy time for bees, as they have come out of hibernation and are gathering food, pollinating plants in the process.

Bees are beneficial and for the most part beneficent, but like most of us, they can become cranky when it's hot and humid, rainy or if other bees are robbing their hives. And dogs or cats who take a curious or aggressive interest in bees or wasps are likely to receive payback in the form of a sting on the nose or head.

An angry bee is a danger to pets. Dr. Marty Becker and I have gathered some tips to help you prevent or treat the stings

❖ "Beeproof" your yard and home. It's good to have bees visit your flowers to pollinate them, but to prevent them from setting up housekeeping full-time in your yard or home, remove or cover possible nesting sites, such as overturned flower pots, holes in trees or walls, drains or attic vents. Call an expert about removal if you

find a nest in the eaves of your home, in the attic or in trees.

♣ Honeybees may want to drink from your pet's outdoor water dish. If you are an urban beekeeper (and who isn't these days?), provide bees with their own source of water and place pet dishes well away from hives. To further discourage bees from sipping a pet's water, mix two tablespoons of vinegar with a gallon of water, and fill pet dishes with it.

❖ If you see your pet get stung by a bee, remove the stinger right away. Instead of grasping it with tweezers, which can inject more venom into the wound, scrape it away with the edge of a credit card.

❖ A mild bee sting can cause a burning or itching sensation that lasts for several minutes or more. You may notice your pet chewing, licking, rubbing or scratching at the area. Mix water and baking soda to make a paste, and apply to the stung area to help relieve the pain. A cold compress can also help to bring down swelling or reduce pain.

❖ Grow aloe in your yard. The gel that oozes from a cut leaf helps to soothe bee stings.

❖ Keep Benadryl on hand. This antihistamine provides relief from itching, swelling and irritation. The dose depends on your dog's size. Call your veterinarian now and ask how much Benadryl to give your pet if he is stung, then write it on the box.

When you purchase Benadryl, be sure the only ingredient is diphenhydramine.

Reactions to bee stings range from slight swelling and pain to anaphylaxis, a sudden, severe allergic reaction that can be fatal if not treated immediately.

Some formulations contain acetaminophen, which is toxic to pets.

❖ Know the phone number and location of your nearest veterinary emergency hospital. Some animals suffer severe reactions to bee stings because they are allergic to bee venom. Known as anaphylaxis, this intense inflammatory reaction causes swelling from excessive fluid buildup in body tissues; itchiness; vomiting; respiratory distress; and collapse or death. It's an emergency. Take your pet to the veterinarian right away.

Pets can also suffer dangerous swelling if they are stung on the head or neck. If those areas swell, they can inhibit a dog or cat's ability to breathe. If you notice swelling on the face or neck, seek immediate veterinary assistance.

## Some new pet owners get time off from work

• "Pet-ternity leave"? It's a thing in the U.K., according to research by pet insurance provider Petplan, which found that nearly 1 in 20 new pet owners are employed by companies that offer paid leave when people acquire a new pet. The time off ranges from 10 hours to several weeks and can be used for training classes, vet visits or helping the pet get settled. Companies include pet food manufacturer Mars Petcare and IT company BitSol Solutions. In an unscientific survey by U.K. tabloid The Mirror, readers said 2 to 1 that pet leave was "a purr-fect idea."

• One of the world's oldest dogs died last month. Maggie, a kelpie who lived on a dairy farm in Australia, was thought to be 30 years old. Her status as world's oldest dog couldn't be officially verified by the Guinness Book of Records though, because owner Brian McLaren was unable to find the paperwork from her purchase as a puppy. That leaves the title of longest-lived dog to Bluey, an Australian cattle dog who made it to 29 years and 5 months. Bluey, who also lived in Australia, was a working herding dog. Is it something in the water?

• The Himalayan wolf is so critically endangered that scientists weren't even sure where it could be found, but an international research team reports evidence of the ancient type in Nepal's largest protected area. Their findings, published in the open access journal ZooKeys, describe a wild dog who differs from other wolves with its smaller size, unusually long muzzle and stumpy legs. Woolly body hair and white fur around the throat, chest, belly and inner thighs also distinguish the species. Conflict with humans over livestock predation is the main reason the wolves are threatened.







confirm what experts and policy makers have been saying for years.

For instance, in 2011 former EPA Administrator Lisa Jackson admitted that there hasn't been a proven case where the fracking process itself has affected water. Two years later current EPA Administrator Gina McCarthy affirmed Jackson's remark, stating, "I am not aware of any definitive determinations that would contradict those statements.'

A review of the available research bears out both claims. Consider Ground Water Protection Council's recent study on gas exploration in Ohio from 1983 until 2007 and in Texas from 1993 until 2008.

According to that report, neither officials in Texas nor those in Ohio identified groundwater single contamination incident at any of these horizontal shale gas wells during

those periods.
Similarly, a 2013 USGS study on the Fayetteville Shale in North-Central Arkansas found that shale gas development in this area has been done without negatively impacting drinking water resources. A 2015 EPA draft report confirmed these findings.

Fracking's impressive safety record is due in part to the energy industry's own vigilance; it has worked aggressively to improve the safety of oil and gas production.

University fracking Cincinnati's research further what establishes myriad of studies have already shown: concerns groundwater contamination are baseless. As Townsend-Small stated, 'We haven't seen anything to show that wells have been contaminated fracking.

This might be disappointing to certain environmentalists Townsend-Small suggests. Additionally, it may interfere with the university's fundraising

efforts. But for the rest of us, the study demonstrates that fracking is a safe source of jobs, prosperity, and low-cost energy.

# Is Jesus Not Being Specific?

During the last several months this space has included comments for and against the requirement that one must be baptized in order to be saved and go to heaven.

We are justified by Jesus' blood according to Romans 5:9 - again no mention of baptism. Romans 10:1-13 mentions only belief and faith as necessary for salvation. Paul doesn't mention anything man can do, other than believing and having faith. In fact, Paul condemned those who tried to add any physical act as necessary for salvation.

There are four specific references in the New Testament indicating baptism is necessary for salvation. I find nineteen that refer only to belief and faith as necessary for salvation and twelve used by either group. That is an overwhelming indication baptism is not necessary for salvation!

Finally, my problem with any belief that without baptism one is not saved means God has a double standard! Is the soldier who accepts Jesus as Savior then instantly killed, or dying in the desert who repents of his sin and then dies, or the person in a space capsule who accepts Jesus in repentance and faith and then capsule explodes in space, denied heaven? Scripture says judgment immediately follows death (Hebrews 9:27). Do these individuals go to hell after expressing their belief and faith in Jesus? If so, the implication is Jesus lied - Scripture says God and Jesus cannot lie. Therefore, someone else is wrong.

Stating baptism is necessary for salvation harks back to man trying to insert something into God's plan to earn his salvation. Salvation cannot be earned. Ephesians 2:8-

9 says, "For you are saved by grace through faith, and this is not from yourselves, it is God's gift - not from works, so that no one can boast." Where is baptism?



# **4 Basic Exercises to Improve Strength and Balance**

(NewsUSA) - As you grow older, being physically active is one of the most important things you can do to stay healthy. Whether you're well into your golden years, a baby boomer or younger, studies show regular exercise can lower your risk of heart disease. some cancers, diabetes and dementia. It also helps improve your mood, energy level and overall well-

"The great thing is, no matter what your age, size or fitness level, it's never too late to start exercising," said



Jaza Marina, M.D., a Kaiser Permanente physician who specializes in elder care. "We strongly recommend seniors do exercises that maintain strength, balance and flexibility. Our goal is to reduce their risk of falls and injuries, so they can stay healthy and independent.'

Dr. Marina advises that good ways to exercise include low-impact aerobic activity, swimming, tai chi and yoga if you're physically able. "We have 80-year-olds who run 5k or 10k races. Everyone is different, so pick an exercise that you enjoy.

She believes walking is probably the easiest exercise. All you need is 30 minutes a day, five times a week. If that's too much, you can break that up -- 10 minutes in the morning, 10 in the afternoon, and 10 in the evening. Some seniors walk at their local indoor shopping mall.

The important thing is to get off the recliner, turn off the T.V. and get active," said Dr. Marina. Below are four basic exercises to get you started.

to a sturdy chair or counter at your side, keep your back straight, feet on the ground and gently bend your knees and lower your body. Then, raise your body back up. It's a slight squat but not a deep one. Repeat 10-15 times.

**2.** Heel raises. Holding on to a chair or counter at your side, raise up on toes slowly and then lower the heels to the ground slowly. Heel raises strengthen the calf muscles. Repeat 10-15 times.

**3. Side leg raises.** Holding

**1. Knee bends.** Holding on on to a chair or counter at your side, raise one leg out to the side and bring it back down. Repeat 10-15 times

and switch to other leg.

4. Sit to stand. If you're able -- sit in a chair and rise to a standing position with arms stretched in front of you. Make sure the chair is in a stable position or against a wall so it won't fall over. Sit back down and repeat 10

Also, talk with your physician before starting a new exercise routine.





# A New Shoal Creek Launch

FLORENCE-The Alabama Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries Division (WFF) has recently opened a new boat landing on the northwest side of Shoal Creek Bridge near Florence. Construction of the new facility began in October 2015 and includes a 20-foot-wide launching slab and paved parking for 36 truck and trailer rigs. WFF secured the property from the Alabama Department of Transportation (ALDOT) for the purpose of constructing a new public boat launch to meet the growing demand of the area. The facility can be accessed off of Highway 72 immediately west of the bridge.

The new access area

was necessary since the land surrounding the existing boat ramp left no room for expansion to accommodate any additional facilities," said **Damon Abernethy**, WFF Assistant Chief of Fisheries. "The Conservation




