Decisions, Decisions: guidelines for what to do when someone has a serious or chronic

The following is a <u>brief</u> summary of questions and principles which may be helpful for families facing a serious, life-limiting, or chronic illness. Discussing these within one's family before a crisis occurs can prevent suffering, allowing for more peace and comfort as we age.

\* Do you want to actually 'live' -- or just 'be kept alive'? In other words, how do you want to die: 'with your boots on', doing something you enjoy; or, confined to a bed with others wiping your bottom? It's the 'quality' vs 'quantity' dilemma!

\* Are pills a burden? [most seniors say 'yes'; the evidence confirms, we live better on fewer pills]

\* First, do no harm. Always relieve suffering. [the primary goals of medicine].

\* Treatments can cause suffering! [doctors are under pressure to use the newest technology and drugs- resulting in unintended sideeffects!]

\* Acceptance [of a condition that can't be fixed] can lead to serenity. [as in the Serenity Prayer].

\* Should having Dementia influence decisions about other problems? Since dementia is terminal, we often prolong patient and family suffering by treating other terminal medical problems! Left untreated, that other problem could cause an earlier death, thereby allowing a patient to escape [what many families have described as] a 'fate worse than death'—the progression to end-stage dementia. [More families therefore are choosing to stop all non-comfort treatments before the end-stage develops.]

\* Do seniors with a LLD [Life Limiting Disease—one eventually causing death] take treatments just because their kids want it? [and thereby suffer longer?]

And, for family having difficulty 'letting go' when a patient has severe dementia:

If your loved one could tell you what to do, what would they say? If it was you in bed, what would YOU want?





old boy had fallen some fifteen feet into about eighteen inches of water at the base of the gorilla habitat. Zookeepers signaled the gorillas in the enclosure to retreat inside. The two females did as instructed. The 17-year-old, 450-pound silverback did not. The boy's splashing alerted Harambe who climbed down to the water.

During the 8-10 minute interaction the obviously agitated and confused gorilla dragged the boy by the arm through the water and scraped him across concrete surfaces before climbing with him back up to the dry area of the habitat. Deciding that the boy's life was in danger, zoo officials made the decision to kill the gorilla with a single gunshot. The boy



My wife had a car wreck in March. The guy who caused the wreck's insurance company wants to record her over the phone telling them about what happened, should she do it?

Matt, Killen, AL

The short answer is NO. While you are obligated to cooperate with your own insurance company and give your own insurance company a statement, this does NOT require you to give a recorded statement to the other driver's insurance company. In fact, you should never give a recorded statement until you have consulted with an experienced personal injury lawyer. Insurance companies' claims adjusters are professional negotiators with extensive experience. They are well trained to ask questions in a manner designed to hurt your claim. Insurance adjusters are

trained to save money for the insurance companies. If they can do that by making fault questionable or by establishing that your medical claims are unfounded or unrelated, they may avoid having to pay for the full extent of your injuries.

Usually the insurance adjuster taking the statement is not the insurance adjuster who handles the property damage and the adjuster that handles the property damage claim is not the one that handles the personal injury claim. The one who wants you to talk can be charming. The one who wants to pay you as little as possible won't be

wants to pay you as little as possible won't be.

I also don't believe that these questions really can be answered <u>accurately</u> after an accident. Yet we all know that any inaccuracy will be used by the insurance company to make it appear as if you were lying. The problem is that the impressions left in memory after a sudden accident aren't accurate. There is no substitute for going to the scene with an attorney and foot looking at skid marks, scuff marks and debris left on the pavement as well as having a look at the distances involved. Only after you know the facts should you attempt to <u>state</u> the facts.

Buckle up and drive safely.

get it there.

And my two favorite toddler games to watch: "Oh, I'm gonna drop corn kernels one at a time from my chair to see. how. many. you. will. pick. up." Or there's, throw the toy down so you'll pick it up. ideologically-based. For my money, noted zookeeper, wildlife expert, and wild animal lover, Jack Hanna, is as much of an authority as anyone on the matter. He flatly agreed with the zoo's decision.

Hanna referenced gorilla unpredictability and a gorilla's pure strength that the general public simple cannot fathom.

"They made the correct decision," he told CBS. "A shot from a tranquilizer gun might take five-ten minutes to take effect." It was clear to Hanna that Harambe was already alarmed by the situation the tranquilizer shot would have further aggravated him.
"A human being is

alive today because of the decision the Cincinnati Zoo made," he added.

Later on Inside Edition, Hanna was even more convincing.

"You don't have seconds or minutes to make a decision like this. When the animal blows, it is like lightning. I will bet my life on this. That child would have been – I don't even want to tell you what would have happened... The boy had no chance whatsoever. The boy should thank God every single day of his life. This

gorilla was not happy."

There are several points





# PETS EAT THE DARNEDEST THINGS

### When pets down dangerous substances: Some nontoxic food for thought

our pet comes in licking his chops well before mealtime. Uh-oh. What has he gotten into?

Chances are, it's something that's not good for him. Last year, the Top 10 toxins ingested by pets were over-the-counter medications, medications prescribed for humans, insecticides, human foods that are toxic to pets, household items, veterinary medications, chocolate, plants, rodenticides and lawn and garden products.

If you find evidence or even suspect that your pet has swallowed something that could disagree with him in a serious or fatal way, the first thing to do is take a deep breath and remain calm. Then look for empty packaging or other clues as to what he might have eaten and how

Call the veterinarian to say that you're on your way with your pet, and why. Bring the empty or partially eaten containers, plant material or any type of label. It will help your veterinarian to know if that chocolate bar your dog ate is milk chocolate or 77 percent cocoa Belgian chocolate.

Maybe it's the middle of the night and you don't have a 24-hour veterinary hospital in your area. Call a pet poison hotline. Be prepared to describe packaging, labels or plant type and whether your dog or cat is conscious,

alert, breathing normally and able to stand and walk.

Don't induce vomiting. It's not the best way to remove toxic substances from a pet's stomach, so toss out that old bottle of ipecac. Nobody recommends it anymore, for pets or kids. Instead, keep activated charcoal on hand. It acts like a sponge, absorbing what's in the stomach. Stick with plain activated charcoal, available from your drugstore or grocery

Toxins aren't always ingested by swallowing; some are absorbed through skin or fur. If your pet has a reaction to an insecticide or other substance, your first thought might be to bathe him to remove it, but it's smart to check with your veterinarian or the poison control hotline first. Some products become more toxic when they get wet. If you get the go-ahead to give a bath, brush your pet first to help remove the substance from the surface of the fur.

Learn about your local plants and their toxicity. Toxic plant lists don't always include regional plants. And know the origin of ornamental plants in your home or yard. Many beautiful but toxic plants come from South Africa.

Among the foods that can give pets a bellyache or worse are grapes and raisins, moldy walnuts and dairy products. Although not every dog reacts to grapes or raisins, aggressive treatment is recommended because the reaction can be severe — renal failure — or even fatal. Give activated charcoal immediately, and

take your dog to the veterinarian right away. A good course of action is IV fluid therapy for at least 48 hours and careful monitoring of blood pressure, urine output and blood chemistry values for at least 72 hours to check for kidney failure.

Moldy foods cause a severe and potentially deadly neurologic syndrome. Signs — including restlessness, panting, excessive salivation, tremors and seizures - usually begin within 30 minutes of exposure. A dog doesn't even have to eat a moldy walnut; simply putting it in his mouth can cause problems. For the same reasons, toss the moldy cheese you found in the back of the refrigerator.

Lastly, in case you were wondering, wine and other alcoholic beverages are also toxic to dogs. So remember: It's a sin to let your dog dig zin.

### Some overweight Labs can blame their genes

- Your Lab's desire to eat everything he sees may be hardwired, say researchers at Cambridge University. They screened more than 300 Labradors kept as pets or assistance dogs, seeking known obesity genes. A change in a gene known as POMC was strongly linked to weight, obesity and appetite in Labs and flat-coated Retrievers. The gene in question may be involved in how the brain recognizes hunger and the feeling of being full after eating. The results of the study were published in the journal Cell Metabolism. "About a quarter of pet Labradors carry this gene," lead researcher Dr. Eleanor Raffan told the BBC.
- Pet dealers and retailers in New York state must now provide purchasers with written instructions on housing, feeding, handling, veterinary care, sanitation and other needs of small animals, reports the Journal of the American Veterinary Medical Association. The requirement applies to small mammals such as hamsters, chinchillas, guinea pigs, gerbils, rabbits, mice and ferrets, as well as small amphibians or reptiles — think frogs, snakes and lizards. It does not include dogs, cats, birds, fish or feeder animals. The law appears to be the first of its kind in the country, according to the AVMA State Relations Department.
- How do bacteria, viruses and parasites differ? Bacteria are microorganisms that exist everywhere - on skin, on surfaces in the environment and inside the body. Most are helpful or harmless, but a tiny percentage cause serious illnesses. Antibiotics are effective against them, but bacteria are fighting back and becoming resistant. Viruses are unique organisms that possess genes, evolve and reproduce, but require a host cell to replicate. They attack various areas of the body and aren't affected by antibiotics, although some vaccines can help to prevent them. Parasites are microorganisms that rely on hosts to survive. They may or may not cause illness.

### 3 Maintenance Musts

Reading home inspection reports is a daily part of being a Realtor. We learn a lot about houses from these reports, and we see many of the same items and issues over and over again. I was thinking recently about a few of these issues, and how they could so easily be averted. While the maintenance items I'm about to list may not cross your radar when you're thinking about areas to check, they are areas where an ounce of prevention is definitely worth a pound of cure. These are, in my opinion, the top three issues where a routine check or inexpensive fix could save hundreds or thousands down the road:

 Diversion of rain water far enough away from your foundation. This potential cause of foundation cracks, moisture issues, and wood decaying fungus can be easily eliminated. Whether it's a \$9 gutter downspout extension, a few wheelbarrows of soil and a shovel, or digging a French drain, it's much less expensive than the damage that could result from neglecting this problem. Basement foundations are also very susceptible to damage from soil erosion. If rainwater flow erodes the soil away from the basement foundation, it could cause cracks in the walls and resulting moisture issues.

• Keeping limbs and other foliage off of your roof and house. Routinely check that there is sufficient space for air to flow between trees and shrubs and your home. This eliminates the chance that moisture will cause paint flaking and eventual wood rot in siding, frim, fascia, and soffit. Ivy looks beautiful growing up a wall, but there is a huge potential for damage. Wooden walls and fences can be damaged, as well as older brick, dry-stacked, or weakened brick walls.

• At least once a year (early summer), check your heating and air unit's condensation drip pan and its drain line. You're checking the drip pan for rust and/or standing water. The condensation line should be free of blockages. Any of these issues could lead to a leak that could mean serious drywall damage. If the line gets blocked and the pan overflows, or the pan rusts through and stops catching the condensation, water will start running down the wall inside your house. Drywall only has to be exposed to water for a very short time before it is damaged beyond repair.

I hope this information is helpful for you. Just thinking about it has reminded me that I have a downspout to replace... - mr




