





are presented with a catch-22: they cannot pay for the medical care they need until their case settles, but they cannot prove their case or get full value for it unless they get the treatment they need. One solution is a letter of protection to a medical care

provider. This is a letter from your attorney where your attorney agrees to pay for the necessary medical treatment directly out of any money you get by way of settlement or verdict.

other options.

Occasionally, we have had situations where we will obtain doctor's testimony at our expense that explains the future costs of surgery or other necessary medical treatment and relates that treatment to the accident and injury. We then take that testimony before a jury and ask for an award of future medical expenses. After the jury verdict is paid, the client can then go get the surgery they need. This can easily take a year or two.

One strategy that Joel and I are currently using is that under the Affordable Care Act (Obamacare) insurance companies are required to pay for coverage for preexisting conditions. In certain cases that coverage is so affordable that our clients can pay for it. In other cases, we pay for the coverage so that our clients can get the treatment they need. When an insurance company pays for treatment that results from an injury and there is a monetary recovery for that injury, the insurance company is then repaid.

One of the most common questions that I answer is how is money paid in a settlement or lawsuit. People often believe that medical treatment rights remain open after a settlement or that payments are made in separate amounts. Certainly in on the job injury cases medical treatment rights can stay open after settlement. In other cases, once the case is settled, the case is over and the settlement or jury verdict is for a set amount. Out of that set amount, the attorneys are paid, the expenses of litigation are paid, and medical expenses are repaid. The money for pain and suffering is tax free to the injured person. Buckle up and drive safely.

Burrell-Slater Shining Star

During its existence, Burrell-Slater High School produced some of the greatest athletes to ever come out of the Shoals area. One such shining star was John Humes, Sr. Humes was one of the school's most versatile athletes. He was a four-sport star, excelling in football, basketball, baseball and track.

He was captain of the football and basketball teams as a senior. He was also captain of the West Senior All-Star football team. Humes also won the conference shot put title his senior season. Humes' basketball talents intrigued the coaches at Alabama A&M University. He became a four-year starter for the Bulldogs under coach Frank E. Lewis.

He served as tri-captain his senior year and also was a member of the Bulldogs' track and field team for one year. At Alabama A&M, Humes averaged 16.8 points and 8 rebounds per game as a senior. After graduation, Humes served his country with two years active military service and three years active reserve duty.

Humes has always been involved in civic and community activities. He's a member of the American Legion and coached young boys in the Tuscumbia city basketball league for where his teams won four city championships. He also served as chairman of the

Board.



ontgomery, Alabama is a is complicated corner of the world that for three years I was blessed to call home.

small wondrous А museum abutting the fortress - like federal courthouse pays homage to the Freedom Riders: fierce men and women from a foregone era whose brave stand for equality and racial justice – in the face of a violent, sneering mob – was utterly fearless.

Montgomery is Martin Luther King, Jr., and it is Rosa Parks; it is Judges Frank Minis Johnson, Jr., and Myron Herbert Thompson, and so many, many more champions of liberty whose indelible imprints are forever enshrined on its soul.

And that is why the best thing about my three year sojourn working in Alabama as an assistant federal defender was, without a doubt, the people.

Alabama abounds in social justice activists; it has strong people and organizations of integrity determined to make the state better for all, not just some. A few include the federal defenders for the Middle District of Alabama, the Alabama Post-Conviction Relief Project, the Equal Justice Initiative, Alabama Arise, Project Hope, the Ordinary People Society, and Alabama Appleseed... The list goes on and on.

The second best thing about my time in Alabama was the art. Alabama has the most artistic, the most creative, most talented people amassed together in one state. Take just for example the fifteen-foot tall statute of a rooster by the side of Highway 231 in Brundidge, Alabama, made of old car parts. It is impossible to pass that bird without wanting to stop

Ali and Cosell: A Team for the Ages

ever having been a fan of Muhammad Ali during his boxing career didn't dampen the degree of respect I had for him as both of us matured. I did become a fan when it was clear that promoters simply prolonged his

boxing career for financial gain well after his skills had diminished.

Cassius Marcellus Clay, Jr. was born in Louisville, KY in 1942. He was high school educated and dealt with racism early in life as did most of his contemporaries.

Clay's name change, his moral and religiously-based refusal to participate in the Vietnam War, his banishment from professional boxing, and the ensuing three-year legal battle are all fairly common knowledge. Clay/Ali had a lot of on-

air time with sportscaster, Howard Cosell, who also called many of Ali's fights for ABC.

There were obvious differences in the two men aside from race and being a generation apart in age. Ali a Christian then a Muslim, Cosell a Jew; Ali modestly educated from the South, Cosell who earned a law degree from NYU; Ali made many of his points through simplistic rhyme, Cosell using the full breadth of his extensive vocabulary. Cosell served in the military during WWII in the US Army's Transportation Corp. He neither




Keller Fest Officials Expect Huge Crowds

per year to prevent their identity from being stolen. That's just silly. Especially when you can do it yourself for free.

The first step in protecting yourself is to keep an eye on your credit history. There are many scammy sites that actually charge you for your credit history but you can check it for free (but only once per year) by visiting AnnualCreditReport. com. If you see anything suspicious, you should report a "fraud alert" to one of the three main credit reporting agencies, TransUnion, Experian, or Equifax. The companies share this report so if you report to one, you report to all. This report makes it much harder for someone to acquire a loan in your name without you knowing about it. This alert must be renewed every 90 days.

You can also place a "Security Freeze" on your accounts.

That's actually far different from actual "identity theft" where someone uses your name and credit history to get loans on big ticket items such as TV's and boats.

Having your identity stolen certainly is a horrible thing. The average consumer who has their identity stolen is typically taken for about \$2500. Some egregious cases amount to over \$15,000. However, the consumer generally doesn't have to pay that loss. The banks who did the lending typically pay the vast majority of claims. The consumer usually end up paying a couple of hundred dollars -- and entirely too much time repairing their credit history.

Despite these numbers, people still pay upwards of \$150

Qualifying for Medicare

When I began working with Medicare health plans a few vears ago it became obvious to me that people aging into Medicare were joining a health insurance program that they really didn't understand. Although the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) do all they can to educate Americans about the benefits of Medicare it still isn't enough for them to fully understand what they have as far as medical coverage through the federal government. Over the next year, through this biweekly article, we're going to discuss the basics of and what is covered under Medicare. But first let's look at how Medicare started.

On July 30, 1965, President Lyndon B. Johnson signed into law the bill, Title XVIII of the Social Security Act, which led to the establishment of Medicare. The original bill included Part A (Hospital Insurance) and Part B (Medical Insurance). Today we know these 2 parts as "Original Medicare". In the beginning Medicare was created to provide health insurance to people 65 years of age and older, regardless of income or medical history.

Over the past five decades changes have been made as to who qualifies for Medicare. In addition to people over the age of 65 Medicare now covers people under the age of 65 who are permanently disabled and have been receiving Social Security Disability Insurance for 24 months. Also anyone at any age can receive Medicare if they have End Stage Renal Disease or ALS.

Although Medicare provides medical coverage for those who qualify it is not 100% coverage!! We often hear "once I go on Medicare my medical insurance worries are over." Medicare has deductibles and coinsurance that the Medicare beneficiary is responsible for unless the beneficiary has additional coverage to supplement Medicare.

your car and take a picture of it. I know I did.

Or visit the Montgomery Museum of Fine Arts in the state capital every day except Mondays, because usually, there is something fabulous there to see; my mom and I will never forget the art exhibition by Winfred Rembert – an African-American artist who handtools and paints on leather canvases – that we were so very lucky to see there one lazy, glorious, Sunday afternoon. And if you are anywhere near Alabama on the third weekend in October, I implore you, to the 45th Annual Kentuck Festival of the Arts located in the historic downtown of Northport, Alabama, immediately adjacent to Tuscaloosa. My maple wood walking stick, handmade leather belt and hat, and letterpress artwork by Amos Paul Kennedy, Jr., all of which I bought at the Kentuck festival, count among my most prized possessions.

Finally, the third best thing about my time living in Alabama is my dog. My wife and I adopted him on a Valentine's Day from the Montgomery Humane Society; we named him "Montgomery," but everybody calls him 'Monty.'

ON YOUR DEBT

Do you owe Debt that has been Charged off?

When I am meeting with clients, I get asked the following question "Do I still owe the debt on my credit report that is listed as charged off?"

Unfortunately, the answer is "Yes" you still owe old charged off debt.

Charging off a debt is an accounting practice meant to give a fair picture of the value of a business. The credit card company or medical provider or loan company, etc. is in essence taking their bad debt off their books. Charging off an account does not affect the legal obligation to pay the debt.

Most businesses will later decide to sell your debt to a debt buyer and they must then account for any money they obtained from that sale.

Now there is sometimes a long gap of time between the time your debt is charged off and when a debt buyer emerges to contact you for payment.

For all you "Walking Dead" fans, in some circles this is called "Zombie Debt". You think the debt is gone or dead, but then it resurrects and attacks you.

But, the (possible) good news is that gap is sometimes too long, and the debt too old, to make it collectible in a court of law. Just because a debt is sold to a debt buyer, it doesn't mean that the statute of limitations revives if it has already lapsed.

Generally the statute of limitations in Alabama for most debts is either three (3) years or six (6) years. That time runs from the date of the original default or last payment or last transaction date. If you make any partial payments later, this will usually re-start the clock, so don't make the mistake of sending the debt buyer a payment if you don't want the statute of limitations to start all over again.

If you are unsure of the statute of limitations on your debt or have any questions about your charged off debt or zombie debt as it is sometimes called, an experienced Bankruptcy Attorney at Bond & Botes can go over all your options with you.



publicly supported nor opposed Ali's position as a conscientious objector, only stating that he supported Ali's right to make his own decision.

After passing the bar, Cosell began a successful law practice. He worked with several clients from the entertainment and sports industries, including the great Willie Mays. When he got into broadcasting Cosell's smug arrogance was not popular with fellow sportscasters, but that didn't bother him. He was unimpressed by athletes of his day and considered many sportscasters to be hacks or cheerleaders.


The differences in Ali and Cosell belie their similarities. The seemingly combative relationship was one of tremendous mutual respect. Both men had superior intellect and both were trailblazers in their chosen profession each veering away from commonly-accepted tradition.

Both men were brilliant at their respective crafts. Both possessed a brash selfassuredness, and neither cared what critics or their

peers thought about them. In addition, bot both benefited from the relationship the two shared. Cosell, who died in 1995, likely respected Ali more than any other athlete he covered, and he gave no one else such a generous platform. Cosell knew who commanded the attention. He routinely asked questions in a provoking manner that would send Ali in productive, fanpleasing directions. He often set himself up for Ali's bold comments. Those interactions with Cosell are how most of the public became familiar with Ali and his personality. Both men understood that neither of them would have been nearly as popular without the other.

Ali won eight national Golden Glove titles, the AAU national title, an Olympic Gold medal in 1960, and heavyweight world championships in 1964, 1974 and 1978. He was the only man to ever win the title three times and was the youngest to unseat a reigning champion at age 22. Ali used his talents to further his influence and he used his opportunities to reach and encouraged others across the globe. When most fighters were content with boxing venues in the northeast U.S., Ali took his show to the far reaches of civilization. His out-dueling the oppressive white war machine and winning some big fights through his career earned him worldwide long-term respect and admiration. Of all the images Muhammad Ali gave us over the years, two of the most touching had to be his lighting of Atlanta's Olympic Flame in 1996 and his receiving the Presidential Medal of Freedom in 2005.





buried with Christ in baptism. Galatians 3:27 teaches we are clothed with Christ in baptism. 1 Peter 3:21 teaches baptism saves us. The Bible is very clear on this subject. It is also clear on the subject of believing, repenting and confession. The Bible is full of commands.







# NO-MAGIC DRAGON You don't need to work hard to care for a bearded dragon

f you want a friendly reptilian pet who's easy to care for, your choice is an easy Lone: You want a bearded dragon. Beardeds are not only tame when handled, but many also seem to enjoy the contact. Even better, they're suitable for almost any pet lover or family situation — and a great pet for a responsible child.

Bearded dragons enjoy exploring, whether crawling on their owners or around the house. They stick out their tongues to touch new surfaces to determine the temperature and makeup of the area — a behavior that adds to their appeal. Beardeds live to be about 10 years old and will measure 18 to 24 inches in length, including the tail. Hatchling beardeds are only about 3 1/2 inches in length and look more like a gecko than a giant lizard species. Common colorings of the bearded are yellow and tan, though they can be found in more vibrant yellow, orange and albino. The bearded dragon name comes from the display the pet puts on when trying to act tough. The puffed-beard display is used only defensively to scare away potential threats. Along with puffing out, beardeds also flatten out their bellies to look wider, as well as leave their rather large mouths gaping open to intimidate the potential threat. Beardeds are quite happy to live alone in the wild, except when in search of mates. If you want more than one, however, there's

no downside, since they seem to enjoy the companionship of another of their kind. Female beardeds can usually be housed with another female or male, but males should not be housed together, due to territorial aggression.

Beardeds need human help to maintain their temperature in captivity, using heat lamps or warming pads. They do well in tanks where some areas are cooler and some are warmer — a range of 85 to 105 degrees by day, dipping into the 70s at night.

You'll also need special lighting, since these reptiles need UVB rays to properly absorb dietary calcium. A full-spectrum light should be provided 12 to 14 hours a day most of the year, and 10 to 12 hours in the winter.

Omnivores by nature, beardeds enjoy both plants and meat in their diet. Juveniles enjoy a carnivorous diet, while adults become

primarily herbivores, enjoying a diet of dark, leafy vegetables and some fruit. All food given to the bearded should be shredded into easy-to-swallow, bite-size pieces. Insects should be given to adult beardeds two to three times per week. They eat mainly crickets, but also mealworms, wax moth larvae and pinkie mice in limited amounts. Beardeds hit sexual maturity between 1

and 2 years of age, when females will start laying eggs, regardless of whether they've been mated.

Veterinary care is minimal for pets who are being properly cared for. After purchase, your bearded should be examined for health and parasites, with treatment for the latter if necessary. After that, annual examinations are recommended, to help your veterinarian understand what's "normal" for your pet, so treatment can be more targeted if there's a problem.

* Every healthy dog has a reflex reaction to any passing skin irritation, whether it's an insect crawling between the hairs or a fingernail giving a scratch. If nerve endings detect something that's annoying the skin, the dog's leg will automatically come up to scratch off the pest - even if there's no pest there. The response is most pronounced if you scratch a dog on the rump near the base of the tail, along the upper part of the flanks or on the belly - not coincidentally, places where fleas like to congregate. The "scratch reflex" is so predictable that veterinarians will use it to help with their neurological exam when spinal damage is suspected.

The Mysteries of God

1 Corinthians 4:1 "Let a man so account of us, as of the ministers of Christ, and stewards of the mysteries of God." The words, (mysteries, mystery), appear 27 times in KJV. Three times used by the Lord Jesus Christ in the gospels. Four times used by the Lord and his messengers in Revelation. The other twenty times are given and revealed in the letters of the Gentile church Apostle Paul, which was certainly providentially controlled. 
