

2016 Commencement Speaker Named

Mount Morris Central School District (MMCSD) has named Christina M. Gullo, a 1988 MMCSD graduate, as the 2016 commencement keynote speaker. Gullo is currently the President/CEO of Villa of Hope (formerly St. Joseph's Villa) in Rochester, a position she has held since November of 2010. The commencement ceremony will be held in the MMCSD Auditorium on Sunday, June 26 at 12:30 p.m.

"I feel honored to be given the opportunity to speak at commencement," said Gullo. "It is something that I feel strongly about participating in. I think my story can be impactful for students and it can change their perception of what possibilities are available to them in the future."

Villa of Hope is a nationally accredited, \$25 million non-profit agency that works with youth and young adults who have mental, emotional and behavioral health issues, often related to difficult and traumatic circumstances. The 400 employees provide a collaborative network of residential treatment programs, educational and community services, as well as addiction services treatment (both residential and outpatient clinic). In her role at Villa of Hope, Gullo has led a fiscal turnaround, created a new strategic plan, updated organizational structure, developed new programming models, and initiated a rebranding effort for the organization.



Gullo earned a Master's Degree in Social Work from Marywood University and a Master's in Business Administration from Rochester Institute of Technology. Her background includes clinical, professional, and business experience. In 1994, Gullo began her career as a social worker for Catholic Family Center. During her tenure, she led the strategic planning team that developed a comprehensive plan for the organization, steered the agency towards measurable outcomes, and spurred the restructuring of programs to provide efficiency and improve service.

While at Catholic Family Center, Gullo was promoted to several positions, including Preventive Supervisor, Human Resources Manager, Director of Human Resources, Vice President of Human Resources, Senior Vice President of Programs and Strategy, and Chief Program and Strategy Officer. In 2010, she was named Executive Vice President/Chief Operating Officer.

In 2014, Gullo was an ATHENA Award finalist, which is presented by The Women's Council, an affiliate of the Rochester Business Alliance. She was the 2008 recipient of the Up and Coming Businesswomen's Award, presented by the Rochester Women's Network. Gullo was a recipient of the Rochester Business Journal's Forty Under 40 Award in 2005, which recognizes leaders under the age of 40 who have achieved professional success and made significant contributions to the community. As the co-author of "Making Strategy Count in the Health and Human Services Sector," Gullo focused on strategy in human services and the importance of adjusting to change, creating a strong organizational culture, and innovating in effective ways.

Two of Gullo's former MMCSD teachers had a lasting impact on her: Marilu Fowler and Tom Graham. Gullo had Fowler in a grades 1-3 cluster and then again in fifth grade. Even as Gullo became a young adult and entered high school, Fowler always expressed a significant interest in her well being and success.

"She was extremely supportive," Gullo says of Fowler. "She took the time to invest in and know the true person that each student was. You felt like you were important to her."

Tom Graham, a MMCSD music and band instructor, also had a lasting impact on Gullo. She was the captain of Color Guard and Graham had high expectations for band and Color Guard members. For Gullo, extra-curricular activities like Color Guard made a difference in her life.

"This is where I found my leadership skills. He [Mr. Graham] had high standards and he believed in all of us. His expectations and work ethic, and his belief in me enhanced my ability to believe in myself as a leader and find my confidence."

Graham describes Gullo as a student who was reliable, hardworking, polite, and a great leader. "Christina was a wonderful person. I have great memories of her. She helped make everything [with Color Guard] work," says Graham.

Today, Gullo is married to John Mueller and is the mother of Alexandra and stepmother to Shannon and Patrick Mueller. Her parents still reside in Mount Morris.







What You Need To Know About Heat Safety

The summer months are upon us and the warm weather can take a toll on our bodies. Everyone is at risk for heat-related illnesses when temperatures rise above 90 degrees. The elderly and the very young are more likely to be affected by the heat. Heat-related illnesses can be very serious and even result in death. Muscle cramping is usually the first sign of heat-related illnesses. Other signs include nausea, dizziness, cold, pale, and clammy skin, heavy sweating and weakness or fainting. Victims of heat-related illness should be moved to a cool place, be cooled using any method available such as ice packs, cool wet cloths or by applying water to the body, and sip on water. If a victim is vomiting or loses consciousness, call 9-1-1 or your local emergency number immediately.

Tips to beat the heat and stay safe during the summer months include:

- * Dress for the heat. Wear lightweight, light-colored clothing. It is also a good idea to wear hats or to use an umbrella. It's also important to wear sunscreen to prevent sunburn and to protect against skin cancer.
- **Drink water.** Carry water with you and drink it continuously even if you do not feel thirsty. Avoid alcohol and caffeine, which dehydrate the body.
- *** Eat small meals** and eat more often.
- *** Slow down.** Avoid strenuous activity. If you must do strenuous activity, do it during the coolest part of the day, which is usually in the morning between 4 am and 7 am. If you must be outdoors, try to limit your outdoor activity to morning and evening hours. Try to rest often in shady areas so that your body's thermostat will have a chance to recover.
- *** Stay indoors** when possible. If air conditioning is not available, stay on the lowest floor out of the sunshine.
- * Stay informed. Check the local news for extreme heat alerts and safety tips. Learn the symptoms of heat illness and check on those who are most at risk.


