Mayor issues warning about trespassing at city pools

When the heat is on, the pool is a priority, especially for kids. "I go swimming every day," one young swimmer said. "Like if is a hot day, the pool is the best place to be," said another young swimmer. That's why city pools are open, but when they close, and kids want to swim, some break the rules. Laurel Police are aware that people are tempted to break into city pools, trespass when no lifeguard is on duty, jump the pool fence, and jump off of lifeguard ladders. Most of the time it's just kids trying to have fun, but police say trespassing in closed pools is dangerous and could lead to serious consequences including arrest. LPD recently arrested two people for jumping the fence at the L.T. Ellis pool. Mayor Johnny Magee is also giving a warning to those tempted to take a dip without permission. "People need to understand that breaking into the pools or jumping the pool fence is

indeed trespassing and will not be tolerated," Mayor Magee stated. Unfortunately, tragedy happened recently when Juwine Hughes, 13, of Laurel, died from drowning at a community pool in Hattiesburg. The pool was not open at the time of the incident. The city of Laurel is set to offer free swim lessons for rising 5th and 6th graders at absolutely no cost to the public. Lessons will be held at the Oak Park pool in two sessions. Each session meets for a 1-hour class Monday through Friday for one week. Kids

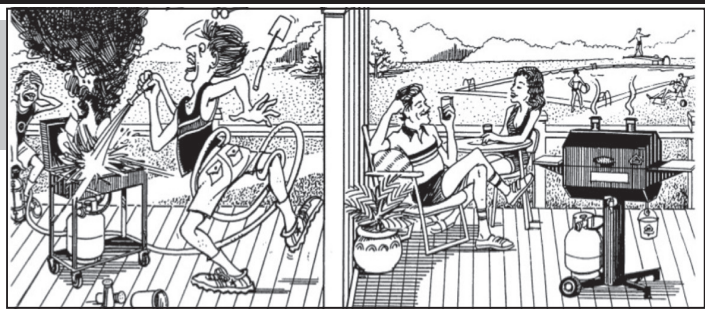

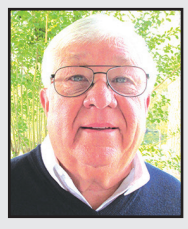

Sideline View: Cats one of three Miss. teams to ever win baseball national title

Congratulations to the JCJC baseball Bobcats for claiming the JUCO World Series title for the first time in school history last week-end. Jones has now won four national sports championships over the years. Football won two titles, in 1968 and 1998, while boys basketball claimed the trophy a couple of years ago. Not a bad Triple Crown for the Cats. Jones is only the third baseball team in Mississippi history to win a national championship. William Carey won the NAIA title in 1969, and Delta State won the Division II title in 2004.



Major League likes Mississippi diamond talent

Twenty-nine players from Mississippi schools had their names called over the three days of the Major League Baseball Amateur Draft. MSU led the way with 11 players followed by Ole Miss with six selections.

The Baltimore Orioles drafted former MSU slugger Rafael Palmeiro's son Preston in the seventh round last week. Young Preston played high school baseball in Colleyville, Texas, but just completed his junior season at N.C. State. Preston hit .337 with nine home runs this season. Rafael played seven seasons altogether with the Orioles (1994-1998 and again in 2004 and 2005).

Former DSU great dies

I want to send my deepest condolences to the family of Bill Marchant. Sadly, the former Delta State baseball coach died last week. He succeeded Boo Ferris as DSU head baseball coach in 1989 and led his final team (1996) to a 53-8 record. He coached the last three years in a wheelchair after a 1993 car accident. He also played at DSU for Ferris.

Fruit tree makes a great Father's Day gift

Happy Father's Day to all the special Fathers in our lives! The best gift only you can give your Dad is a nice, long visit.

Summer will soon officially begin, and I have become a dusk and dawn gardener. I work outside from 7 - 8 a.m. and 7 - 8 p.m.; any other time of day is just too hot.

I eliminated the planters on the deck railing - too much sun and they don't hold enough soil to keep anything alive. Keep what looks good and compost the rest.

Don't be afraid to move your plants around; one of my lantana was smothering a scarlet honeysuckle, so I transplanted it to a better location. Plants appreciate being moved in the evening, since they have all night to get used to their new space. I try to set out bedding plants and shrubs in the late afternoon or evening, because they don't wilt as much.

If you enjoy planting in containers, you may want to try something I read about recently. Get moss to grow on your clay pots by roughing up the outside of the pot with a wire brush and painting it with buttermilk or yogurt. Place the pot in a shady spot and keep moist until it turns green. I plan to try this . . . will let you know if it works. This would be pretty in the shade planted with impatiens or caladiums.

As you deadhead your zinnias, vinca and marigolds, scatter the seeds back into your beds; you should have a continuous crop of flowers. This works best where there is little or no mulch. For greatest impact, group several containers of different shapes and sizes, sticking with the same color palette. Try small pots for tight spots and larger containers for open spaces. If you're planting beds or containers that will be viewed from a distance, such as from the street, stick to light colors. Darker shades have more impact up close, along walks and near patios and decks. These are not hard and fast rules, just suggestions. It's your garden, do whatever makes you feel good; and don't let anyone tell you it is wrong!

To show your patriotism and help us all feel better about



this once-great nation, consider planting a flower bed with red, white and blue flowers. You might try red verbena in front, then white vinca and tall blue salvia in back. Since Independence Day is about three weeks away, I'm headed to the nursery for inspiration.

By the way, I recently visited Laurel Nursery and Garden Center on Highway 15 North in Laurel. This is a great place to find the perfect gift to take to Dad. If he enjoys cooking on the grill, he might like his own rosemary plant to season that chicken. What is Dad's favorite fruit? Buy him a fruit tree and he can grow his own. My husband is always looking for a new and better pump sprayer. Laurel Nursery sells one at a bargain price that can get the job done. Go look around; the friendly staff will help you find the perfect gift for your special Dad.

They also have the best selection of herbs I have seen to date. If you like to cook gumbo, stews or soup, buy a bay leaf plant. We have one and I just walk out on the deck and snip off a few leaves when I need them - fresh bay leaves! These are also good in bean dishes.

On the subject of food, I ran across this recipe in Southern Living Magazine. It is a quick, easy and healthy new take on summer squash. I use four small yellow squash and two zucchini; slice in thin rounds and set aside. In a large bowl, whisk together one tablespoon fresh dill weed, one tablespoon chopped fresh mint, two tablespoons apple cider vinegar, one tablespoon lime juice, 1/2 teaspoon kosher salt, 1/4 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper and 1/4 teaspoon crushed red pepper. Add squash to bowl and toss to coat. Cover and chill at least one hour.

This is even better after sitting a few days. Almost forgot: it was pretty tangy, so I added about one tablespoon sugar to the herb mix. The squash is still crisp after several days in the refrigerator. I also tried it with fresh green beans from the garden. Yummy! This would be a nice treat for the Dad in your life!

Have fun in the dirt this week, but don't overdo it in this heat!

along the way to play local teams and maybe some other big league teams. This barnstorming, as it was called, was done every year as teams tried to play their way into shape. Maybe the Cubs should return to Vicksburg if they want to win the World Series?

The Cubs entered the week at 43-18, 25 games over .500 before they lost their 25th game. This is their best 61-game start since the 1907 Cubs began 47-14. Entering the week, the Cubs are playing best in the major with a percentage of .705 while the Braves (18-44) are the lowest with a .290 percentage.

SEC leads way with \$\$\$\$

The rich keep getting richer in college football. The SEC hauled in \$527 million to lead all the conferences in revenue for this past school year. The Big Ten was second at \$448 million, the Pac-12 followed at \$439 million, the ACC cashed in \$403 million, and the Big 12 came in with a \$300 million jackpot. Tremendous TV deals and sponsorships were the source of all this income. Media reports put Conference USA next to the bottom with estimated revenue of only \$2 million. This is down almost 80% over last year's C-USA take per school. That means USM's cut of conference revenue will only be about \$200,000 this year. Last year C-USA split \$15.4 million per school. USM's paycheck last year from the conference was \$1.2 million. New TV deals were the reason for the shortfall. Compare that to Ole Miss and Mississippi State's take of over \$36 million from the SEC coffers.

What happens if I let my personal auto insurance lapse?

One way or another, letting your auto insurance lapse will cost you. Exactly what it costs you is completely dependent on your situation ... and often, your luck.



Acceptable Reasons for Not Having Car Insurance

Some people have no legitimate use for car insurance. It's probably safe to say you don't need auto insurance if:

- *You don't have a driver's license.
- *You have a license, but you just don't drive. Ever.
- *You don't own a car and don't plan to ... ever.
- *You're out of the country for an extended period of time. (Note: your host country may require you to carry local insurance if you plan to drive while you're in country.)
- *You have a chronic health condition that prevents you from driving.
- *Your license is suspended and you're not allowed behind the wheel.
- *You get the point. If you don't have a motor vehicle, or if you can't or don't drive, there's no reason for you to maintain a policy.
- *If you're a licensed driver and don't own a car—but you borrow or rent cars from time to time—you should still carry a non-owner auto policy. Talk to your independent insurance agent for more information about this type of coverage.
- *Even if you have a very good excuse for not having auto insurance, if you ever need a policy again you should expect to pay more after your hiatus. Even an explainable lapse could cause insurance companies to charge you more for coverage ... at least until you can establish a coverage/payment history again.

Unacceptable Reasons for Not Having Car Insurance

There are some less acceptable (but sometimes understandable) reasons why you might let your auto insurance lapse:

- *You forgot to pay the bill.
- *You couldn't afford the coverage.
- *Your coverage was cancelled due to non-payment of premium.

*Your coverage was cancelled due to too many violations or serious accidents.

*The good news is, if you let your auto insurance lapse (or had it cancelled) very recently, most companies have a grace period. Contact your insurance agent as soon as possible, because you can may be able to get reinstated without impacting your record of coverage.

*If your current insurance company refuses to reinstate your policy, you can probably get coverage from a different company. You may end up having to go with an insurer that specializes in people with a difficult driving record or a checkered payment/coverage history. It will cost you more, but you're still likely to get covered.

*If even the so-called "non-standard" insurance companies won't issue you a policy, get rid of your car and stop driving. Period.

Dangers of Uninsured Driving

Every single day, thousands of people across the nation drive around without insurance. This is against the law in every state but New Hampshire*, and a serious risk to everyone else on the road. It's also the reason all drivers should carry uninsured and under-insured motorist coverage as part of their auto policies.

Uninsured driving is also a serious risk to the uninsured drivers themselves. Here are a few of the exciting things that can happen if you're caught driving without the required insurance:

Tickets and Fines: Fines vary by state, but they range from a few hundred dollars to several thousand. (The penalty in West Virginia can be as high as \$5,000.)

License Suspended: Many states will suspend your driver's license if you're caught driving without insurance. The length of the suspension depends on the state, and also on whether you're a first-time or repeat offender.

Registration Suspended: In some states, your vehicle's registration could be suspended, and your license plates confiscated. Reinstatement of the registration often carries a healthy fee (at least a couple hundred dollars), and requires proof of guaranteed insurance coverage for a year.

Vehicle Impounded: Some states (like California and Minnesota) impound the vehicles of people caught driving without insurance. Naturally, they charge a fee to get your vehicle back.

Community Service: In some states (like Colorado and

Hawaii), uninsured drivers can be sentenced to serve anywhere from 20 to 100 hours of community service.

Jail Time: Yes—you can actually go to jail for driving without insurance. Statutory maximums vary from as few as ten days (in Montana) to three months (in Alabama and Kentucky) to up to a year (in Georgia). Sentencing generally depends on whether or not it's your first offense.

Repossession: If you financed your vehicle with a bank or finance company—or if your vehicle is leased—you probably signed a contract saying that you would maintain a certain level of insurance on the vehicle. If your creditors find that you've let your coverage lapse, they may decide to repossess the car.

Those penalties are for simply driving a vehicle without insurance. If you're involved in an accident, you'll be responsible for paying for all damages out of your own pocket. This includes property damage as well as medical treatment for anyone hurt. A court judgment could result in wage garnishment and the liquidation of any assets you might have.

Even if another driver is determined to be responsible for an accident, if you're driving without insurance you can lose the right to sue the at-fault driver for damages and medical costs.

Getting Covered Again

If you're driving without insurance and haven't been caught, consider yourself lucky. Talk to an independent agent today and get covered as soon as you can. Again, expect to pay more than you did before due to the gap in coverage.

If you haven't been so lucky, you'll have to find a company willing to take you. You may have an SR-22 requirement that you need to fill. Most licensed agents will know how to walk you through the process.

Driving is a big responsibility and for most people auto insurance is a necessity, not a luxury. If you feel you're paying too much for your car insurance, you're better off working with an independent agent to shop different companies at different levels of coverage. In the long run, letting your auto insurance lapse is much more expensive.

Southern Miss baseball to offer summer camps

The Southern Miss baseball program will hold five different camps this summer at Pete Taylor Park, including a pair of one-week sessions for kids, a summer showcase, and a pair of specialized sessions including one for pitching/catching and one for hitting/defense. The following is information on each of these camps of which all will take place at Pete Taylor Park/Hill Denson Field:

Pitching/Catching Camp

This one-day Pitching and Catching Camp is scheduled for June 18. This camp is designed to offer instruction and tips for improvement to attendees with focus specifically on pitching and catching. All campers will receive lunch and a camp T-shirt. Pitchers will be instructed on velocity training, arm care, front side direction, acceleration, tempo control, command philosophy, mental approach and other aspects of the USM pitching approach. Catchers will receive instruction on receiving, blocking, throwing mechanics, plays at the plate, bunts,

pop-ups, game management, arm care, and catching drills practiced by Southern Miss players. The cost is \$100. All campers will receive lunch and a camp T-shirt. The camp begins at 9 a.m., and ends at 3 p.m. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m. at Pete Taylor Park.

Hitting/Defense Camp

This one-day hitting and defense camp is scheduled for June 19. The camp is designed to instruct proper techniques used by Southern Miss hitters, infielders and

outfielders. The day will be divided up with defense in the morning and hitting in the afternoon. All campers will receive lunch and a camp T-shirt. Hitters will receive instruction and be provided with drills that emphasize pre-pitch mentality, proper load and timing mechanics, tee work, soft toss, front toss, extension with finish, body and physical training care, and other aspects used by USM players and coaches. The defense portion of the camp will include infield and outfield techniques and drills. Infielders and outfielders will learn all aspects from

pre-pitch routines to finishing throwing motions on all plays. This includes ground balls and fly balls, as well as throwing mechanics, and arm care. Campers are allowed to participate in both days. The cost is \$100. All Campers will receive lunch and a camp T-shirt. The camp will begin at 9 a.m., and end at 3 p.m. Registration will begin at 8:30 a.m., at Pete Taylor Park. The cost is \$100. If you register for both sessions, June 18 and June 19, the cost for both combined is \$175.

Summer Kid's Camps

The week-long session is for kids entering grades 1-7 and slated to take place on July 18-21. Campers will be divided into groups by age to ensure quality and safety. These camps will cover fundamentals such as hitting, base running, defensive techniques, primary and secondary positions. The camp will be limited to the first 100 applicants. Each camper will receive a USM Camp T-shirt and insurance. Cost for each four-day camp is \$165. Times for each day will begin with sign-in taking place from 8:15 - 9:00 a.m., with the conclusion of each day at noon.

Summer Showcase Camp

This camp is designed to allow current high school freshman through junior college sophomore (junior college freshman must be academic qualifier) baseball players the skills needed to compete at the next level. Participants will be given a chance to have their skills toned by college coaches and receive specific instruction to their defensive position, speed training to improve their 60 time, as well as hitting at Pete Taylor Park. Any pitcher who is a dual player will be able to participate at both positions. The camp is set to take place July 23; registration begins at 11 a.m. The camp starts at noon and ends when all camp participants have completed the session. Lunch will not be provided. The camp will be limited to the first 100 applicants. Cost is \$155 and includes insurance, instruction and a camp T-shirt.
