

winter areas. They like bright light, and need a heavier mix of soil and a substantial pot or support system to keep it from falling over. If leaves yellow and fall off, you are watering too often.





Q.I saw an ad for a new HBO show called "Westworld," and it looks really awesome. Can you tell me anything about it? — Paul T., via



Mr. Hockey

There are a lot of things to celebrate and look forward to these days in the world of sports, but sometimes you are reminded of the past. A former mayor of New York once said that "weddings are optional but funerals are mandatory," and it's with that spirit we briefly look past the Pittsburgh Penguins and superstar Sydney Crosby's dominant Stanley Čup run and instead look to the past in honor of Gordie Howe.

Death, as they say, is a part of life. One week after the death of the great Ali, we are again reminded of this fact. It's a morose subject to be sure, but some people just make huge impacts and leave legacies that appear impossible to match. One such athlete was Gordie Howe.

It strains the limits of incredulity that Howe isn't in the world right now, having passed at 88 years of age. He wasn't the Ali of hockey he was the Gordie Howe of hockey.

He was "Mr. Hockey." Can you imagine? If you were a "war baby" born in 1946, the best player in hockey was playing until you were 34. He played from the Truman administration straight through to Reagan (and that's not counting his Minnie Minosa moment in the '90s when he played a shift for the Detroit Vipers).

Perhaps Howe's greatest ability was his talent for letting the game come to him. He was so efficient in his movement that he kept moving

longer than any other player in NHL history. Through sheer muscle mem-ory, Howe had an uncanny knack at being in position for the great play. Also, he was ambidextrous and could beat you silly from the left and the right. People like to say that he wasn't the

best at any one thing ... he was "just" great at everything. He could skate, but he wasn't the fastest. He didn't have the hardest slapshot, but he had the most goals. He wasn't the best fighter, but nobody dared to say that to his face. It didn't matter because he was the complete hockey player, a champion and an MVP many times over.

Also, he was a great guy. While he didn't earn the type of wage that today's hockey stars command, he was always there for the charity event. He may not have donated millions in cash, but he made others millions just by stroking his signature across a stick, and he was always willing to do it. Stories abound of him coming to the aid of people in tough situations when they didn't even ask. Like on the ice, he just had a uncanny way of being there. Maybe that's why they named an international bridge for the guy.

A famous novelist once said that no matter what a writer says, whatever they just wrote is the very best they can do at that moment. Howe never had a moment of doubt.

"You find that you have peace of mind and can enjoy yourself, get more sleep and rest when you know that it was a 100 percent effort that you gave - win or lose," Howe used

Howe never cheated himself, his teams, his family or the fans for even one minute, and that is why he will always be remembered.

. I don't appraise items for either A garage or estate sales. Even though I was in the antique business for more than 30 years, I am not an appraiser nor do I pretend to be.

When I publish a value in this column, I attribute it either to a price guide or expert. I also limit myself to answering one question per reader.

If you send me an inventory of your house even with a SASE it is a waste of both your time and money. With a computer you can check current values on eBay. I find that extremely helpful when determining current values.

Put another way, there are no free lunches or 5 cent cigars. If you feel you have something valuable, hire the services of a good professional appraiser. For general information, which I hope is helpful, I am your man.

I have a Coca-Cola tray from the 1920s featuring a couple playing golf. Do I have a valuable item? — Dorothy, Ladue, Missouri

A • Yes, if it is authentic. Coca-Co-la collectors must be aware that many of the old beverage trays have been reproduced, and some even aged to look much older than they actually are. If your tray is the real deal, it was issued in 1926 and is valued in the \$500-\$750 range, depending on condition.





Ten Ways To Get Prepared For Planting

(NAPS)—When the weather warms, many people's thoughts turn to how to make sure their yard is in tip-top shape for planting. These 10 tips can help get your garden off to a great start:

1. Make a plan. First, decide what to plant. One thing you may want to consider is pollinator-attractant plants. Yellow, blue or purple flowers make your garden more appealing to bees. The Pollinator Partnership's Bee Smart mobile app helps gardeners select the best plants in their area. You can visit FeedABee.com to view pollinator gardens from around the country for inspiration.

2. Observe the current state of your garden. See how well last year's planting choices worked out. Consider placement of compatible plants, sunlight, shade and irrigation.

3. Tidy up. Clean out old plants and weeds from last year's garden, including the roots. Remove winter mulch or pine straw, too.

4. Survey the soil. Make sure the soil contains the right nutrients with a soil sampling kit, found at home and garden centers. This analysis will inform your decisions on fertilizing methods. Aerate your soil by breaking it up so air, water and nutrients penetrate the plant roots.

5. Take care of pests. Check for slugs, snails or aphids, treating any infestations you find.

6. If it's broken, fix it. Fix broken structures and gardening tools. Also, treat wood with a preservative during dry periods to prevent

cracks and splitting.

7. Gather the tools you'll need and make sure they're clean. Sharpen and clean your tools, as proper maintenance saves you money and keeps disease from spreading between cuttings.

8. Planting vegetables? Consider raised beds. These warm quickly, encourage good irrigation and aeration, and are excellent for difficult soil. In addition, you'll be able to reach every corner to pull young weeds as they appear.

9. Prepare a compost pile. Buy or make a compost bin and throw in all your garden waste, grass clippings, paper, wood prunings, and fruit and veggie peelings. Turn and aerate it with a garden fork every month.

10. Label your plants. If you're growing food, learning to identify plants or sharing a community garden, plant markers are a must. Use the plastic markers that came with the plants or buy or make your own from pebbles, bamboo skewers or broken terracotta pots. Label your plants with the variety name and date you planted it.

1. Prepare grill for direct cooking over high heat (450 F to 550 F).

2. Grill the poblano chiles over direct high heat, with the lid closed, until blackened and blistered all over, 10 to 12 minutes, turning occasionally. Place the peppers in a bowl and cover with plastic wrap to trap the steam. Let stand for about 10 minutes. Remove and discard the charred skin, stems and seeds, and then coarsely chop the chiles.

3. In the bowl of a food processor, combine the poblanos, jalapeno, cliantro, almonds, lemon juice, garlic, pepper, sugar tablespoons of the oil and 1 teaspoon of the salt, and process until well-blended but some texture still remains. Transfer sauce to a serving bowl.

4. In a medium bowl whisk together the remaining 1 tablespoon oil and 1 teaspoon salt, the paprika and cayenne. Add the shrimp the mixture. Grill the shrimp over direct high heat, with the lid closed. until firm to the touch and just turning opaque in the center, 2 to 4 minutes, turning once.

5. Arrange shrimp on a platter and serve with the romesco sauce for dipping, and toasted bread and/or tortilla chips for dipping. Serves 4 to 6.


