Homeless 'car camping' considered for Almaden Expressway parking lot

Santa Clara County supervisors will consider spending more than \$26 million on several controversial homeless shelter solutions.

The most controversial proposal is the conversion of a county-owned parking lot at the corner of Almaden Expressway and Camden Avenue into a safe zone for homeless for "car camping."

County Supervisor's president Dave Cortese thinks it's a great idea where the homeless will be able to stay in their cars and have access to showers and other facilities,



ties, but some Almaden families think the idea is "just plain dumb."

The county supervisors will also consider turning the defunct Plaza Hotel near the Greyhound bus station downtown into rooms where the homeless can live.

Cortese says the goal is to offer the homeless not only a roof over their heads but also allow them access services so they can eventually secure permanent homes.

The supervisors will vote on the solutions at their September 15 meeting.

Aquamaids compete among the best at 2015 Junior China Open in Beijing

Ten Santa Clara Aquamaids swimmers, including three athletes from Almaden Valley, competed in the 2015 China Synchronized Swimming Junior Open Championships and returned home with gold, silver and bronze medals.

Aquamaids represented the United States at the event and successfully competed with more than 300 swimming athletes. The event was held at the Olympic Sports Centre in Beijing, China August 13-16.

The Aquamaids earned a gold medal for the United States with a score of 81.7333 in the Free Combination routine, which includes ten swimmers. The routine dazzled the judges with its acrobatic moves and excellent choreography. The team members include: Emily Anger (Almaden Valley), Celine Joo, Rachel Lau, Karen Li, Jacklyn Luu, Alexandra Meridith-LeRoux, Nicola Schmidt, Stephanie Thielemann, Natalia Vega (Almaden Valley), and Rachel Ye (Almaden Valley).

In the Team routine (eight swimmers), Santa Clara had an amazing performance and again earned the gold medal with a total score of 149.5532. Team members included Emily Anger, Celine Joo, Rachel Lau, Karen Li, Jacklyn Luu, Alexandra Meridith-LeRoux, Stephanie Thielemann, and Natalia Vega. The team routine was coached by Patti Andresen and Ou Liu.

In Duet competition, the team of Jacklyn Luu, Celine Joo, and alternate Rachel Lau, coached by Jenny Ekhlévsky, earned a gold medal; and the team of Natalia Vega and Emily Anger, coached by Ou Liu,

got silver. In the solo event, Jacklyn Luu won the gold medal with an outstanding performance and Celine Joo took silver. In fig-

ures, Rachal Lau (Gold), Jacklyn Luu (Silver), and Celine Joo (bronze) swept the medals.

Aquamaids coaches agree that

the China Open signified the beginning of a great relationship Aquamaids and USA Synchro will build with the Chinese synchronized swimming team and association, currently one of the top three strongest synchronized swimming countries in the world.

This competition was also special because it was a homecoming for newly joined Aquamaids Coach, Ou Liu, a China native and Olympic bronze and silver medalist for China at the 2008 and 2012 Olympic Games. Coach Liu has been working with the Aquamaids since April of this year. "I'm very proud of the Aquamaids performance and my return to China," said Liu.

The event marked the conclusion of a very successful season for the Aquamaids Junior Team. The team will begin training soon for next season, and the future is bright as eight out of ten swimmers will return next season.

Santa Clara Aquamaids, founded in 1964, has had generations of exceptional athletes and coaches, and has become the most decorated synchronized swimming club in the world.

Head Coach Chris Carver has coached three U.S. Olympic teams, winning gold and bronze medals from Atlanta to Athens. She leads Santa Clara's accomplished coaching staff and has been named United States Synchronized Swimming Coach of the Year for an unprecedented 14 years.

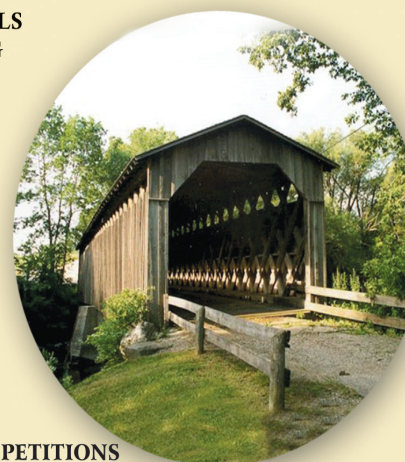

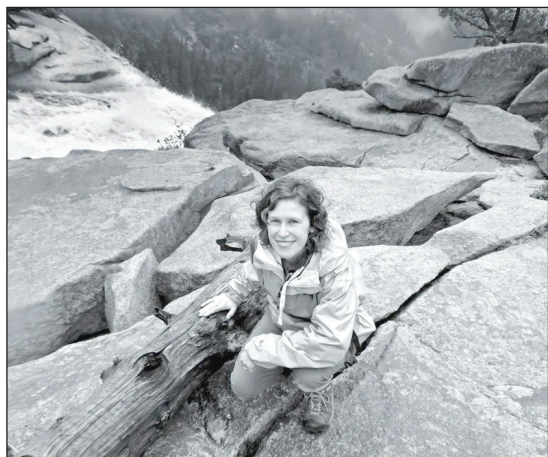

The High School Club Lacrosse State Championship game was held on May 31, 2015 and won by the “Chiefs.” This was the Chiefs’ second State Championship win.

The Chiefs’ Varsity team has been building with excellent skill sets and team sportsmanship. Their experience in big time games and superior coaching let them to an exciting 14 - 10 win.

“My players really wanted to win, they are a great group of kids who have played together for years,” said Coach Elliott Bender. “They put the time and effort in and deserved this win”, he said.

The game featured South Valley Chiefs and Santiago Sharks from Corona,

California. In their semi-finals game against the Vista Panthers, the Santiago Sharks had coasted by them with a 22-6 win.

Born and raised in Almaden Valley (Graystone, Bret Harte, Leland), Josh Kimball began shooting images of anything and everything back in his high school days while enrolled in Mr. Mays' darkroom photography class. Soon after graduating from college (UCSB 2001), a few of Josh's images ran in leading publications, and what began as a hobby soon became a career path as dozens of national and international magazines, books, calendars and websites collectively went on to publish hundreds of his images.

Eventually looking to broaden his approach to photography beyond the constraints of the editorial world, Kimball then began to devote himself towards printmaking. I thought the dancers might go into a state of shock when they say they'd be heavily laden. All their lives they wear as skimpy clothes as possible because they like to be free. Now they'd have gazelles on their arms; grass on their heads, all the while they're leaping and turning. The natural instinct would be to stiffen up and act robotic."

Working with his longtime company members, Norwood J. Pennewell and Natalie Rogers, he devised movements that wouldn't be hindering by the costumes. "The trick was to get the essence of the animals," he says, "but also to keep an awareness of the human body. I wasn't going to do the furry suit thing where someone portrays the shaggy whatever. I wanted you to think lioness but also think woman, who is hunting to eat. While you're seeing the lionesses hunting, you're still getting the feeling of softness and femaleness. They're strong women and if they don't hunt, the lazy men don't eat. All these human things I wanted to get in there. I'm very proud of all my dances but I'm particularly proud of the lioness dance."

Fagan came away from *The Lion King* not only with a Tony Award in 1997 for his choreography but with major new insights. "I learned how to create dances in hardly any space, like the hyena dance," he says, "and how to devise movement that would be vibrant and big enough not to be overpowered by all the beautiful scenery and costumes while also keeping in mind that the dancers have to do eight shows a week, and couldn't be totally exhausted." He paused, evaluating his life-changing experience. "But the most important thing I learned," he says, "was how to adapt when something didn't work. We were going for a masterpiece, and everyone involved knew the collaboration counted for more than any one particular view. That's why *The Lion King* is a masterpiece."
