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





Apple-Oat Cookies

Ingredients

2 1/4 cups all-purpose flour

1 cup old-fashioned oats

1 teaspoon ground cinnamon 3/4 teaspoon baking powder

1/2 teaspoon baking soda

1/2 teaspoon salt



1/4 teaspoon ground allspice

1 1/2 sticks unsalted butter, melted and cooled slightly

- 1/2 cup packed light brown sugar
- 1/2 cup granulated sugar
- 2 large eggs
- 1 Fuji or Gala apple, coarsely grated
- 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 1 cup confectioners' sugar
- 2 tablespoons milk

Directions

Preheat to 350 degrees F. Line 2 baking sheets with parchment paper. Whisk the flour, oats, cinnamon, baking powder, baking soda, salt and allspice in a medium bowl. Combine the butter, brown sugar, granulated sugar and eggs in a separate bowl; whisk until smooth. Stir in the grated apple and vanilla, then stir in the flour mixture until just combined. Scoop heaping tablespoonfuls of the dough onto the prepared baking sheets, about 1 inch apart. Bake until just set around the edges, 10 to 12 minutes, switching the baking sheets halfway through. Let cool 5 minutes on the baking sheets, then transfer to a rack to cool completely.

Make the glaze: Whisk the confectioners' sugar and milk in a bowl; drizzle on the cookies.

Oatmeal Cookies

Raisin Pecan Oatmeal Cookies

Ingredients

1 1/2 cups pecans, toasted and chopped (2 sticks) unsalted butter, at room temperature 1 cup dark brown sugar, lightly packed 1 cup granulated sugar 2 extra-large eggs, at room



- temperature 2 teaspoons pure vanilla extract
- 1 1/2 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 3 cups old-fashioned oats
- 1 1/2 cups raisins

Directions

Preheat the oven to 350 degrees F. In the bowl of an electric mixer fitted with the paddle attachment, beat the butter, brown sugar, and granulated sugar together on medium-high speed until light and fluffy. With the mixer on low, add the eggs, one at a time, and the vanilla. Sift the flour, baking powder, cinnamon, and salt together into a medium bowl. With the mixer on low, slowly add the dry ingredients to the butter mixture. Add the oats, raisins, and pecans and mix just until combined.

Using a small ice-cream scoop or a tablespoon, drop 2-inch mounds of dough onto sheet pans lined with parchment paper. Flatten slightly with a damp hand. Bake for 12 to 15 minutes, until lightly browned. Transfer the cookies to a baking rack and cool completely.





Oatmeal Cookies

Coconut & Oatmeal Drop Cookies

Ingredients

- 1 cup (2 sticks) butter
- 1 cup granulated sugar
- 1 cup packed light brown sugar
- 2 eggs
- 1 tsp. vanilla extract
- 1 tsp. baking powder
- 1 tsp. baking soda
- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 2 -1/2 cups shredded coconut
- 1 cup chopped walnuts or pecans
- 2 cups old-fashioned oats

Directions

Heat oven to 350 degrees. Grease 2 large cookie sheets. Cream butter and sugars in mixer until light and fluffy. Add eggs, beat together. Add vanilla, baking powder and baking soda. Then add the flour. Mix until well combined. Stir in coconut and nuts. Mix in oats.

Drop on greased cookie sheets by the tsp., spacing about 1/2 inch apart. Bake 12 to 15 minutes, just until the edges begin to brown. Transfer to a wire rack to cool.

Giant Monster Cookies

Ingredients

2 cups creamy peanut butter 2/3 cup butter, softened 1-1/3 cups sugar 1-1/3 cups packed brown sugar

- 4 eggs
- 2-1/2 teaspoons baking soda
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon light corn syrup



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- 6 cups old-fashioned oats
- 1 cup semisweet chocolate chips
- 1 cup milk chocolate M&Ms

Directions

1. In a large bowl, cream peanut butter, butter, sugar and brown sugar until light and fluffy, about 4 minutes. Beat in eggs, baking soda, vanilla and corn syrup. Add oats and mix well. Stir in chocolate chips and M&Ms. Cover and refrigerate 1 hour.

2. Preheat oven to 350°. Drop by 1/4 cupfuls 3 in. apart onto ungreased baking sheets. Bake 14-18 minutes or until edges are lightly browned. Cool 5 minutes before removing from pans to wire racks to cool completely. Store in an airtight container. Yield: about 2-1/2 dozen.

No Bake Oatmeal Cookies

Ingredients

1¾ cups granulated sugar
½ cup milk
8 tablespoons butter, cut into large pieces

. 3 tablespoons unsweetened cocoa powder

1/2 cup creamy peanut butter

1 teaspoon vanilla extract

1/4 teaspoon salt

3 cups quick cooking oats

Directions

Add sugar, milk, butter, and cocoa powder to a medium heavy-bottomed saucepan over mediumhigh heat. Bring to a boil for about three minutes. Remove from heat and stir in peanut butter, vanilla, salt and oats. Drop large scoops of no bake cookies onto parchment paper. Allow to dry for about 10-15 minutes until the no bake cookies have become firm.




