



Two things that will take me away from the corral gate are music and grandkids. Last week, I strayed due to both! Let me take you along for the ride!



I had an opportunity to see the world renowned Blackwood Quartet. These gospel friends appeared at a theater on FM 515 in Emory, Texas in a performance with Josh Davis, Elvis Tribute Artist of Sulphur Springs, Texas. The show was called "The Gospel Side of Elvis".

Mark Blackwood was the only family member of the historic group who appeared in Emory, and with him were to be three professional singers who make up the quartet. İn an unfortunate turn due to a sudden illness, tenor Tim Williams was hospitalized in Oklahoma, but the group improvised to become a trio. David, the bass singer, had to take the tenor part and he did an admirable job! Mark and his men blend such tight harmonies that it's as if they've been singing together all their lives! The group loves to perform the familiar, beloved gospel songs of the Blackwood family's four-generation history. After singing to music tracks onstage, they came down and stood before the front row audience and took requests, performing them A capella with perfect precision. Audience members knew they were in the presence of greatness! Their treatment of traditional Southern Gospel music was a 'treatment" nobody will soon forget! The Blackwood Quartet's heritage is a rich one. Formed in 1934 in Mississippi by three brothers and a nephew (Roy, Doyle, James and R.W.), the Blackwood Brothers Quartet's popularity increased with the appearance of televisions in people's homes during the early 50's. In 1954, tragedy struck when two members were killed in a plane crash. The group survived the crippling blow and reformed, adding J.D. Sumner as bass singer. Mark, a greatgrandson of James Blackwood, heads up today's quartet. He also produced a Grammy Award-winning Blackwood Brothers album in the 1980's. This summer the group is touring the UK.

My friend David Stallings was at the concert too. David is a music promoter who has worked with the Blackwoods on numerous occasions. By way of surprise, Mark called him to the stage. David got a payoff in laughter as he fired off a few jokes about his previous Blackwood experiences, and invited everyone along as he takes the road again as comedian "Willie P. Richardson". For the last 20-plus years, Willie's "phone pranks" have delighted audiences in live performances and in the homes of fans of his CD collection. David is a delightful gentleman who loves country music and country people.





The desire to appear with the Blackwoods is something Josh Davis has held for a long time. His wish came true with "The Gospel Side of Elvis" concert. As an Elvis Tribute Artist, Josh loves gospel music himself, and knew that Elvis's favorite gospel group was the Blackwood Brothers. Here's a bit of Elvis/Blackwood history... grandson Cecil Stamps Blackwood and his teen friends had formed a quartet in 1951 and had begun singing at churches in the Memphis area. The group was called the "Songfellows". Elvis Presley came to hear them and a friendship was formed. Elvis wanted to join the group but there was no opening at the time. After their appearances, Elvis would often drive the group to eat at their favorite Memphis BBQ joints in his 1941 Lincoln. Later when a place opened in the group, Elvis sang with the Songfellows for only a short time, because he wouldn't shave his sideburns and he couldn't sing harmony well. They remained friends however, and Elvis kept Cecil informed as his career took off

Took the kids to the country again while they were visiting during June. You can't expose city kids to too much country! This time we looked for toad frogs and the maverick monster cucumbers hiding under the vines, and we picked a few peas. However, the





pea-picking started to feel too much like work, so they soon gave that up. The large watermelon we sliced (from Brookshires...the Black Diamonds out in the garden weren't quite ripe yet) was reduced to rinds which we fed to the horse. On the way home, we counted cows and horses in the pastures and felt the wind from the open car windows. My guess is we spent a good two or three hours without a

phone or games, and they didn't miss their electronics at all! I'm wishing you a safe and blessed Fourth of July! I'll be watching for you at the corral gate!

In 1969, when Thomas Padilla of Big Spring was in the Army stationed in Europe, he visited a tavern in Innsbruck, Austria One of the patrons went to Thomas's table and knocked three times, indicating he wanted to visit. Thomas returned the knock and the man sat down. Thomas was able to speak some German, so the two started a conversation. They exchanged cigarettes and found out a little about each other. Then the man got up and announced to the crowd that an American sergeant from

Texas was on the premises. That was enough to get the party started.

"I was being bombarded with questions," says Thomas, "like 'do you have a gun?' 'do you have a horse?' 'do you have a ranch?' 'how many oil wells do you have?' 'do you ride with a posse to chase bad people?' They started bringing me these one-liter beers. I don't know how many I had on my table. Then in unison they all said, 'prost, America' and repeated it three times. I raised my glass in appreciation."

The oompah band struck up a Texas tune.

"I was sitting there with all the commotion going on and wasn't listening very close, then it started sounding familiar. I finally recognized the melody. It was The Yellow Rose of Texas."

Thomas says everybody was having a good time and all of a sudden it got real quiet, like somebody turned off the switch. People who were sitting down stood up. A twelve-year-old girl entered, followed by an elderly gentleman. Thomas thought he must be somebody extremely important in the community. The girl walked up to Thomas and asked if he was an American. Before he answered, Thomas thought to himself, 'in Innsbruck I'm considered an American. In Texas I'm considered a Mexican.'

He proudly replied yes, he was an American. The young girl said the man with her was her grandfather and he wanted to tell Thomas something. The man didn't speak English, so the girl said she would translate.


"When the Nazis were here," said the gentlemen through his granddaughter, "we were being suppressed and being controlled and it was horrible. Then one morning, there was a lot of commotion outside, lots of screaming and hollering. I ran out and asked one of the citizens what was going on. The citizen replied that the Nazis were running. 'They're getting out of town. The Americans are coming. Right now they're on the outskirts of the city with tanks."

The grandfather continued, "The Americans came through, but they didn't bother to stop. They just kept on going. I wanted to stop them and give them thanks for getting the Nazis out. But I never had the opportunity to see another American military person. One of the citizens that was in this gasthaus ran over to my house and told me that an American soldier was here. So here I am. I want to thank you for getting the Nazis out of Innsbruck."





Annette O'Toole

Actress, Dancer and Singer-Songwriter

Annette O'Toole (born April 1, 1952) is an American actress, dancer, and singer-songwriter. She is best known for portraying Lana Lang in Superman 3 and most recently for portraying Martha Kent, the mother of Clark Kent, on the television series Smallville.

Early life and career

O'Toole was born Annette Toole in Houston, Texas, the daughter of Dorothy Geraldine (née Niland) and William West Toole, Jr. Her mother taught dance, something O'Toole learned at the age of 3. She started taking acting lessons after family moved to Los Angeles when she was 13. Her first television appearance was

in 1967 on The Danny Kaye Show, followed over the next few years with guest appearances in shows such as My Three Sons, The Virginian, Gunsmoke, Hawaii Five-O, and The Partridge Family.

1970s-1980s

O'Toole's first major film role was as a jaded beauty pageant contestant in the 1975 satire Smile; she got the role after doing an impression of a "dead cockroach" at the audition. She also appeared as Robby Benson's character's tutor/girlfriend in the college basketball story One on One in 1977. She costarred opposite Gary Busey in the 1980 film Foolin' Around. In 1981, she starred in the HBO onstage production of Vanities, as well as in the TV movie Stand By Your Man, which detailed the life of country music legend Tammy Wynette. Later on in 1982, she appeared briefly as Nick Nolte's girlfriend in 48 Hours. That same year, she played Alice Perrin in Cat People, and then in 1983 she played Lana Lang (love interest to Clark Kent/Superman), and single mother of Ricky in Superman III. In 1985, she co-starred with Barry Manilow in the CBS television movie Copacabana playing Lola La Mar to Manilow's Tony Starr. Also in 1985, she had a starring role as Ms. Edmunds in the original Bridge to Terabithia, and appeared in the TV adaptation of Strong Medicine the following year. In 1987's Cross My Heart, a romantic comedy, O'Toole had a leading role opposite Martin Short.

1990s-2000s

In 1990, O'Toole had roles in two ABC television miniseries. She played the adult Beverly Marsh in the miniseries adaptation of the Stephen King novel It, and also portrayed Rose Fitzgerald Kennedy in The Kennedys of Massachusetts, a role that earned her an Emmy nomination for Outstanding Lead Actress. She next starred in the 1992 NBC miniseries Jewels, based on the Danielle Steel novel of the same name.

In 1993, O'Toole starred in Desperate Justice as Ellen Wells. However, in 1995, she starred as Cheryl Keeton in the 1995 Lifetime television film based on Ann Rule's true crime novel Dead by Sunset. She had a recurring role on the television show Nash Bridges (1996) and starred in her own series The Huntress (2000) as a female bounty hunter. In 1997 O'Toole starred in the TV movie Keeping the Promise.

In October 2001, 18 years after portraying Lana Lang in Superman III, O'Toole returned to the Superman mythos in the role of Martha Kent, Superman's adoptive mother, in the television series Smallville. She remained part of the show's main cast, though at times in the background, until the end of its sixth season. On January 19, 2010, it was announced that O'Toole would be returning to Smallville for at least one episode.

On November 22, 2010, O'Toole played the role of Veronica, a middle aged woman suffering from a severe case of Alzheimer's, in season 3 episode 7 of the TV series Lie to Me. In March 2013 she appeared in Grey's Anatomy as a school teacher who finds out after surgery she will die from cancer. **2010s**

In 2015 O'Toole returned to the Stephen King realm as boarding house owner Edna Price in 'The Kill Floor' episode of the King mini-series 11.22.63. Musical career

In retrospect, O'Toole can date the beginning of her songwriting career to events during a car ride after the September 11 attacks; as her husband Michael McKean describes it, "On September 11, 2001, Annette found herself without an airline to carry her back down to Los Angeles from Vancouver, where she films Smallville. So she drove a rental car down. The two of us drove it back up together, and on the long drive up there, somewhere between Portland and Seattle, she told me she had a tune in her head." The "tune in her head" became "Potato's in the Paddy Wagon", one of three songs the couple wrote for A Mighty Wind, including the Oscar-nominated song "A Kiss at the End of the Rainbow."

O'Toole sang "What Could Be Better?" — a song she and her husband co-wrote — for the 2004 Disney children's album A World of Happiness.

In May-June 2005, the couple did a cabaret act for "Feinstein's at the Regency" in New York City.

On July 7, 2007, O'Toole appeared as a backing singer for her husband's fictional band Spinal Tap at the London leg of the Live Earth concerts. She has also performed on the band's 2009 Unwigged and Unplugged tour, and contributed lyrics to "Short and Sweet" on the 2009 Spinal Tap album Back from the Dead.

In 2011 she starred in CAP21's production of the new musical Southern Comfort, based on the Sundance award-winning documentary, by Dan Collins and Julianne Wick Davis.

Personal life

O'Toole married actor Bill Geisslinger on April 8, 1983; the couple had two daughters, Nell and Anna.

O'Toole first met Michael McKean, the man who would later become her second husband, when McKean was working on Laverne & Shirley. After both were divorced, O'Toole and McKean became friends in 1997 while starring together on Final Justice, a Lifetime movie. They were married in March 1999.

O'Toole and McKean guest-starred together in "Mega", a 10th season episode of Law & Order as a wealthy married couple accused of murder. The couple also guest starred on Boy Meets World as Topanga Lawrence's parents. McKean also played Perry White, the reporter,

and later boyfriend, of O'Toole's character Martha Kent on Smallville.




