



Dear "Speak Out",

This year marks the 240th anniversary of the signing of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776. It is important that today we modern Americans understand the courage needed to sign that document! The 56 men who signed it were the first of a long line of patriots who have made great sacrifices for the cause of American freedom.

This is because myths often outlive the facts of history. Many people only remember George Washington and the cherry tree story. Benjamin Franklin's statesmanship is often forgotten but we remember that he flew a kite in a rainstorm. Joyce Kilmer was a military hero, but all we remember is that he wrote a poem about trees. Many people today remember the first lines of the Declaration of Independence but have forgotten that these men also pledged their lives and sacred honor to our country. Today we can better understand the significance of Independence Day if we know what happened to these men.

First of all they know that the chances of being executed were real. And many did pay that price. We named our village after Robert Morris and our county after Robert Livingston. Both served in Congress without pay giving every cent they had to the war effort and both died in poverty. Others such as Swinnett, Clymer, Middleton Hall and Elery had their homes burned and they died of hunger and starvation. Five were captured and tortured. Nine signers died of battle wounds.

These early patriots of July 4th, 1776 could have enjoyed luxury and ease or could have run off to safety in Canada. But they considered freedom so much more important than security that they pledged their lives, their fortunes and their sacred honor. So, as we watch the fireworks in the sky this weekend, this is why we should remember all who paid the price of our freedom. St. Peter said it in the Bible: "They suffered but they had God's approval".

Rest in peace.


