Voters choose new Minnesota parks and trails license plate



Following a week of on-line voting, during which more than 30,000 votes were cast, Lt. Gov. Tina Smith announced Wednesday the winner of the contest to design a Minnesota state parks and trails license plate.

The winning plate features an image of a canoe on the water, surrounded by Minnesota's four seasons.

"Generations of Minnesotans have enjoyed our extraordinary state parks and trails system," Smith said. "This new license plate

allows Minnesotans to invest in the future of our parks and trails, and proudly demonstrate that commitment on their vehicles."

The plate was submitted by Michelle Vesaas of Coon Rapids. Vesaas's design received the most votes from among three finalists.

"My design was inspired by being in the outdoors in this beautiful state through all four seasons," she said. "Even in the coldest days of winter, if you're dressed for it, there is incredible beauty to

be found."

The new license plate will be available from the Department of Motor Vehicles this fall as part of the ongoing celebration of the 125th anniversary of Minnesota state parks and trails. The cost will start at \$60, plus tax. The total includes a one-time \$10 fee for the plate itself and a minimum \$50 contribution (renewable annually).

"Purchasing the new license plate will be a great way to show everyone on the road that you 'go the extra mile' to support Minnesota state parks and trails," said Erika Rivers, DNR parks and trails director.

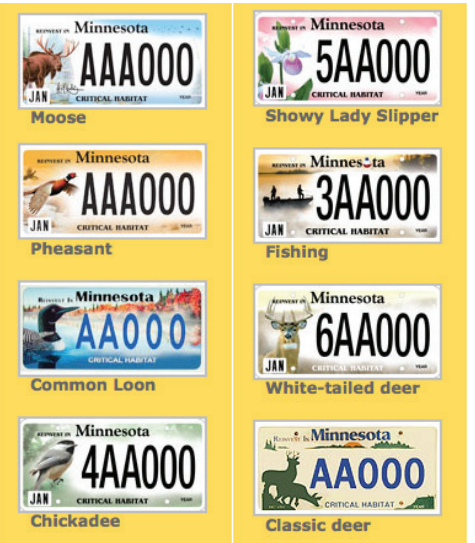
The plate provides their owners with unlimited access to all 75 Minnesota state parks and recreation areas for the year, replacing the need for an annual vehicle permit (a \$25 value).

Proceeds from license plate sales will help fund the operations and maintenance of Minnesota state parks and trails.

The DNR already has eight Critical Habitat license plates from which Minnesotans can choose. These specialty plates—first offered in 1995—provide an opportunity for citizens to support conservation and show their individuality by purchasing a license plate featuring a loon, a moose or another Minnesota-related image. The parks and trails plate will bring the total

number of specialty license plates available from the DNR to nine.

Widespread voter fraud documented in Minnesota Supreme Court case

 A new voter fraud case before the Minnesota Supreme Court claims 1,366 ineligible felons have cast at least 1,670 fraudulent votes in recent statewide elections, possibly tipping the outcome of close contests, including the 2008 U.S. Senate race.
 The case holds repercussions for the 2016 election with the plaintiffs seeking a court order to prevent state and local election officials

from distributing ballots to ineligible voters by implementing new safeguards.
 The lawsuit marks the culmination of a years-long effort to challenge suspected voter fraud tied to Minnesota's same day voting registration law. More than half a million Minnesotans register to vote on Election Day in general election years like 2016.
 "For the first time, the State of Minnesota will be

put 'on the stand' and forced to explain why it thinks it can violate the plain text of the Minnesota Constitution, election statutes, as well as specific court orders and permit individuals to vote who election officials know are ineligible," said Minnesota Voters Alliance Executive Director Andy Cilek in an email newsletter.
 The Minnesota Voters Alliance group behind the challenge alleges the actual number of illegal ballots submitted by ineligible voters far surpasses the 1,670 votes documented through a painstaking search of voting records hampered by a lack of cooperation by Minnesota Secretary of State Steve Simon.

MVA found 941 ineligible felons who were allowed to vote in 2008 alone, ex-

ceeding the 312 vote margin separating DFL candidate Al Franken and GOP Sen. Norm Coleman after a grueling recount.

Altogether, more than 100,000 Minnesota felons had their right to vote restricted and reported to the Minnesota Secretary of State between 2003 and 2015. But the Minnesota Secretary of State only notifies local election officials of the ineligible status of felons and others if they're already registered to vote in the Statewide Voter Registration System.

Court papers demonstrate how the incomplete list of ineligible voters provided to local election officials routinely allows felons, wards of the state, immigrants and other ineligible persons to register and vote.

"The 1,366 identified fel-

ons who have been permitted to vote is believed to be only a fraction of the true total," the 110 page court petition filed by MVA and former Rep. Kirk Stensrud states. "Cooperation from the Secretary of State would have allowed for a more complete accounting of the number of ineligible persons who have been permitted to vote."
 Simon has refused to release the data that would enable MVA to verify the actual number of ineligible people that have illegally cast a vote. In holding back the critical government data, Simon has ignored a Minnesota Department of Administration opinion stating that the voting records in question should be made public.

"The Secretary of State

plays a significant role with other election officials in permitting known ineligible felons to register or to vote," court documents state.

The lawsuit also alleges that election officials often allow felons flagged as ineligible in the Statewide Voter Registration System to vote anyway, providing the individual swears eligibility, according to court documents.

In their investigation, MVA determined more than 200 ineligible felons have voted in two of the last four general elections held in 2008, 2010, 2012 and 2014.

"There's a continuing problem in Minnesota with ineligible felons voting and the courts and Secretary of State and election judges haven't gotten on the same page and these close elections without a doubt are being determined by the votes of ineligible felons," said Erick Kaardal, MVA's attorney.

Other states offer provisional ballots to same day registrants that are not tallied until the voter's eligibility is confirmed.

The Minnesota Secretary of State has until July 15 to file a response on the election fraud case with the Minnesota Supreme Court. Simon did not respond to our inquiry.

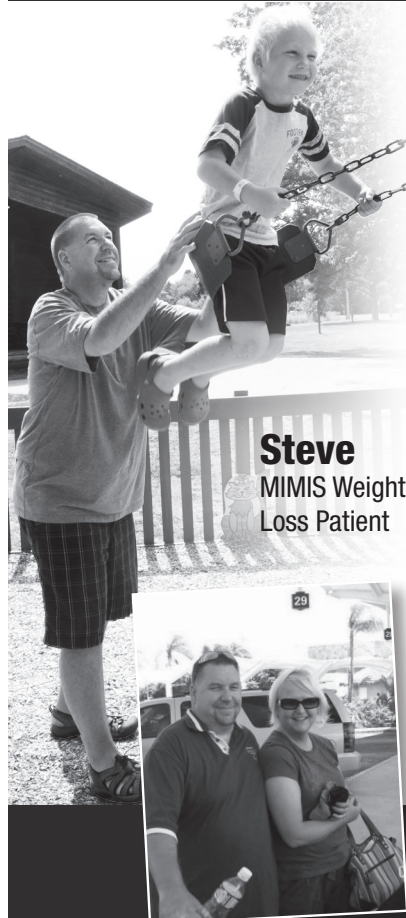

- 1/4 c butter, softened
- 1/2 c sugar
- 2 large eggs, beaten
- 1 c flour
- 1 tsp baking powder
- 1/4 c milk
- 1 1/2 c fresh or frozen blueberries

FOR THE SAUCE:

- 1/4 c butter, softened
- 1/2 c sugar
- 1 large egg yolk, well beaten
- 1/4 c boiling water
- 1 tsp vanilla

Directions

- Cream butter and sugar; stir in eggs.
- Sift flour and baking powder together.
- Add to creamed mixture alternately with milk, beating well.
- Coat blueberries with a small amount of additional flour (to assure even distribution of berries in cake); fold into batter.

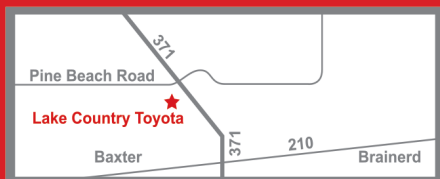
