



BLUE GREEN ALGAE BLOOM HEALTH ADVISORY UPDATE Friday July 1, 2016

Based on surveillance performed Friday, July 1, 2016, no blooms have been identified on Conesus Lake. Blooms were first identified on June 21, 2016 primarily along the easterly shore. Blooms occur when algae multiply very rapidly over a short period of time, usually in calm, warm, water. There are thousands of different algae species, however, a few of these may produce toxins. The toxins are a concern when there is a high level present in the water. The Livingston County Department of Health is monitoring for algae blooms and may collect samples of the water if the bloom is concentrated and persistent. Blue-green algae blooms may persist in varying degrees and a various locations throughout the summer and fall seasons. The public water supply is safe for drinking.



At this time, visual monitoring has detected the presence of blue-green algae in the noted area. Contact with the algae may result in some health effects such as itching, rashes, fever, headache, upper respiratory symptoms, vomiting and diarrhea. These symptoms are not just caused by blue-green algae contact. If you experience any of these symptoms and they persist, you should seek medical advice. You are advised not to drink or use the lake water for cooking and do not swim, wade, play, or come into direct contact with water that is discolored or has scum on the surface. Pets should not be allowed to drink or to come into contact with discolored water. If contact occurs, wash with soap and clean water to remove algal material. Always rinse after coming into contact with any surface water whether or not a blue-green algae bloom is present. Avoid contact with surface water when open cuts or wounds are present on the body.







I FOUND A BAT IN MY HOUSE!

You could be subject to getting rabies vaccinations if the bat is not tested.




Bats are important in the environment but can cause a serious health risk in the home. Based on NYS Department of Health guidelines, if you encounter a

bat while sleeping you may need to undergo rabies treatment. Bites can be very small and unknown. Once rabies is contracted it is nearly always fatal.

If you find a bat in your home:

- 1. Keep it isolated to one room if possible.
- 2. Capture the bat if you are comfortable doing so. Wait until it lands and then place a can, plastic container or box over it. Slide a paper under it and then place a cover on top to contain it. You may also contact a wildlife removal specialist to capture it.



WISDOM TEETH

Wisdom teeth, also known as "third molars," are the last teeth to develop and erupt into the mouth. Unfortunately, they are the most common teeth to be 'impacted' or unable to fully erupt between the ages of 15-20, but can be seen earlier or appear much later in life. Impacted teeth are not able to erupt through the gum tissue fully or at all. This can be due to many reasons, including lack of room for the teeth (jaw growth), malposition of teeth or pathology. Nearly everyone has at least 1 impacted wisdom tooth.

Why are wisdom teeth removed?

There are many reasons wisdom teeth require removal; These include pain, swelling, infection, orthodontic treatment, periodontal disease, cavities, shifting of teeth, age and pathology (such as cyst development). If not removed, impacted wisdom teeth could lead to damage of adjacent teeth or cause infection, which is a very common reason that they are removed. If they do erupt fully, they often are difficult to clean and maintain, have bacteria associated with them which can lead to systemic infection and illness that can affect the heart and make management of other illnesses such as diabetes more difficult. If the teeth remain impacted as people age, other pathology can develop, such as cysts and tumors. Management of these situations is often compromised by anatomy and other medical concerns. Pain-free does not mean problem-free or pathology-free. If the wisdom teeth erupt fully, are hygienic and without pathology, proper follow up is in order with periodic exam and x-rays.

What is the best age to remove wisdom teeth?

Studies have consistently shown that removing wisdom teeth in the teen years is by far easier for patients. This is due to bone being softer, roots not being fully developed, better healing process, and an essentially uncomplicated or benign medical history.


