### **Medicare Minute**

### "Medicare Part A Part 1"

On a Medicare card Part A will have the word "Hospital" beside it. Because of that Medicare Part A is most commonly known as the inpatient or hospitalization part of Medicare. This means when a Medicare beneficiary is admitted into the hospital most of the services that are received are filed under Medicare Part A. This sounds simple but sometimes it's not.

Medicare Part A has a deductible of \$1,288 per benefit period. Notice two things here. First is the deductible of \$1,288. If you are admitted into the hospital and had Original Medicare only, you would owe the first \$1,288 of your stay. This deductible covers hospital services, including semi-private rooms, meals, general nursing, drugs as part of your inpatient treatment, and other hospital services and supplies.

The second thing to notice is the term "benefit period". This tells you the deductible is not an annual deductible but could hit you more than once in a calendar year. A "benefit period" begins when you are admitted into a hospital or skilled nursing facility and ends when you haven't received any inpatient care for 60 consecutive days. If you are admitted as an inpatient after the 60 days of no inpatient care a new benefit period begins, meaning another \$1,288 deductible. Also if you are confined to the hospital for 60 consecutive days your deductible will cover you but on the 61st day you will begin

The good news is for most Medicare beneficiaries Part A is free. Free meaning you don't pay for it. The reason for this is while you are working you pay 1.45% of your pay check into Medicare. If you did that for 40 quarters you're entitled to Part A for free. Next week will discuss the other benefits of Medicare Part A.

# ASK THE **ATTORNEY**

My wife had a car wreck in March. The guy who caused the wreck's insurance company wants to record her over the phone telling them about what happened, should she do it?

Glenn, Russellville, AL

The short answer is NO. While you are obligated to cooperate with your own insurance company and give your own insurance company a statement, this does NOT require you to give a recorded statement to the other driver's insurance company. In fact, you should never give a recorded statement until you have consulted with an experienced personal injury lawyer. Insurance companies' claims adjusters are professional negotiators with extensive experience. They are well trained to ask questions in a manner designed to hurt your claim. Insurance adjusters are trained to save money for the insurance companies. If they can do that by making fault questionable or by establishing that your medical claims are

unfounded or unrelated, they may avoid having to pay for the full extent of your injuries.

Usually the insurance adjuster taking the statement is not the insurance adjuster who handles the property damage and the adjuster that handles the property damage claim is not the one who handles the personal injury claim. The one who wants you to talk can be charming. The one who wants to pay you as little as possible won't be.

Î also don't believe that these questions really can be answered accurately after an accident. Yet we all know that any inaccuracy will be used by the insurance company to make it appear as if you were lying. The problem is that the impressions left in memory after a sudden accident aren't accurate. There is no substitute for going to the scene with an attorney and foot-looking at skid marks, scuff marks and debris left on the pavement as well as having a look at the distances involved. Only after you know the facts should you attempt to state the facts.

Buckle up and drive safely.



Dear John,





10. After July 29, the price will reportedly be \$120 for the Home version and \$200 for the Pro version. Microsoft isn't being clear on the prices so don't hold me to





One positive thing will probably happen, though. Microsoft says they will remove the "nag screen" July 29 that so many of

you are sick of seeing.
So, should you upgrade?
Probably. We've upgraded hundreds of computers to Windows 10. Out of those only a very small percentage had problems afterward. So, from a reliability and compatibility standpoint, I give it two thumbs

Windows 10 starts up faster which makes your old computer run like a newer one. It has some security features under the hood that supposedly make it more secure than previous operating systems. Microsoft always claims that with new releases. I'm not sure I buy it.

From our experience, Windows 10 computers are just as susceptible to virusy stuff as previous operating systems. I'm not enough of a software nerd to know what additional mechanisms are in place to protect you, but I don't see a difference here in the real world.

Microsoft claims that Windows 10 will be the last

numbered operating system (OS) upgrade it ever releases. From now on, instead of major numbered OS upgrades, there will generally be 3 incremental upgrades every year similar to the strategy Apple has used for

Some benefits of the upgrade include "unification" of all your devices. The stuff you store on one computer will be available on your other computers as well. It doesn't have the annoying 'tiles" introduced in Windows 8. Actually, they are there but presented in a much less obnoxious manner. Battery life on laptops is longer for Windows 10 users.

So, if you are a home user and have been waiting for my permission to upgrade; go for it. The fact is that all of us who use home computers will eventually have to get used to Windows 10 anyway. You may as well take

If you are a business user, you'll want to make sure any specialized software is compatible with Windows 10 before upgrading. Windows 10 has been out long enough that the initial bugs have been worked out. Alas, if you upgrade and decide you don't like it, it's really easy to go back to your previous operating system--as long as you do that within 30 days of the upgrade. After 30 days, you're stuck with





spending time in the fawn's location in order to decrease her scent in the area or otherwise attract predators to the fawn. While the mother is feeding nearby, the fawn avoids detection by hiding motionless in a grassy area.

"Fawns raised by their mothers in the wild fare much better than those reared in captivity," said Keith Gauldin, Wildlife Section Chief for the Alabama Division of Wildlife and Freshwater Fisheries (WFF). "Wellmeaning individuals can actually cause more harm by removing it from its hiding place. The best option is to take a photo and leave the fawn where it was found."

Most wild birds and mammals, including fawns, are protected by law and may not be legally taken from the wild or kept as pets. In the vast majority of instances, fawns will survive if left alone. Deer and other wildlife are difficult to rear in captivity and have the greatest chance for survival if left in their native habitat.

If a fawn is found with serious injuries or confirmed to be orphaned, contact the nearest wildlife rehabilitator permitted to handle deer. For a list of rehabilitators permitted by WFF, visit www.outdooralabama. com/current-wildliferehabbers.

- If fed cow milk, fawns can dehydrate quickly from diarrhea.
- Deer raised by humans can become dangerous as they mature.
- Fawns are born completely odorless for the first few days of life. The doe relocates away from the fawn only returning for nursing. This prevents predators from detecting the fawn's scent and the location of the fawn.





felony Manslaughter. Criminally Negligent Homicide without being under the influence of a controlled substance is only punishable by twelve months in the local detention center. Because of his bail-related antics, the defendant has already served six months of the sentence.

In hindsight the most curious aspect of the trial may be that the victim was a middle-aged black lady and the jury was all males and all white. Combined with what seems to be such overwhelming evidence of culpability by the defendant, can certainly understand how family members and friends of the victim have serious concerns. From all that has been made public, they are demonstrating a tremendous amount of class and restraint. It's doubtful I could be equally subdued. How could the striking

result in such a potentially incendiary make-up? Would they have ever assembled an all black jury for this case? If the defendant were black and the traffic fatality white, would an all-white jury ever be assembled?

Both are doubtful.

We have a crime victim who CAN'T take the stand, getting short-changed by the legal system. Logic doesn't mirror the verdict. Therefore we are left with racial undertones that are very difficult to ignore.

# DRAFT DOGS

### Pulling a cart or wagon is bred in the bone for some breeds, but almost any dog can learn

ou've probably seen vintage photos of dogs pulling carts or wagons loaded with milk cans, large cheeses and other goods to market for farmers. Certain breeds specialized in this work, among them Bernese mountain dogs, bouviers des Flandres, great Pyrenees, greater Swiss mountain dogs, Leonbergers, Newfoundlands, Rottweilers and Saint Bernards. Dogs were less expensive to purchase and care for than horses and were sometimes referred to as "the poor farmer's

Some modern dog owners, inspired by their breeds' heritage, are eager to teach their dogs to perform their traditional work. They've taken up drafting, also known as carting.

Laura Bullock of Charlotte, North Carolina, has had greater Swiss mountain dogs for nine years. "I really wanted to do all of the things that my breed is meant to do," she says. "It's something that is interesting and different and definitely challenging. It may look easy, but it's not."

Dogs who can pull a cart or wagon are popular for lots of reasons. They are crowd pleasers in parades, give rides to neighborhood kids, haul recycling bins out to the street, help bring home groceries and work as gardening assistants, pulling wagons loaded with potting soil, bark and trays of plants around the yard.

A framework of training and trust between dog and owner is necessary to

be successful. Before a dog starts training for carting, he should know and respond readily to basic obedience commands, especially "stay" and "come."

Before a dog is ever put into a harness or

attached to a cart, he becomes accustomed to having a cart brought behind him and learns how it feels to have the shafts of the cart touching his shoulders. Experiencing that sensation is important because as the cart turns, the shafts will touch the dog's body, so it's something he needs to be

More advanced lessons involve learning to go in circles, back up, pull uphill, control the speed of a cart going downhill and walk across different surfaces. In a draft test, to earn a title, a dog may have to pull his cart over dirt, grass or gravel, as well as over a bridge or through a gate. He needs to learn how it feels and sounds to cross those surfaces and how to make his way through narrow spaces. As he learns, he is rewarded with toys, treats and praise.

Dogs can become accustomed to wearing a harness and being hitched to a cart at any age — the earlier, the better — but depending on the breed, they must be 18 months to 2 years old before they can enter a draft test to earn a title. That's to ensure that the dog's bones and joints are fully developed.

Drafting isn't limited to large breeds. Any dog of any size can learn to pull for fun, exercise or utility, although a smaller dog's loads are limited. Breeds and mixes that have learned to pull include papillons, cockapoos, Shetland sheepdogs and collies.

Before getting started, take your dog to the veterinarian. He shouldn't have any physical problems that could be made worse by the activity.

To learn more, contact a local Bernese mountain dog breed club. They often have drafting demonstrations and clinics at fun days or specialty shows so people can learn about the sport.

The benefits of carting go beyond earning titles or even doing work with it, says Kathe Vasquez, co-chair of the draft committee for the Bernese Mountain Dog Club of Southern

"It forms a really special bond between you and your dog. When you have that partnership, that teamwork, it's really a beautiful thing."

### **Excess thirst, urine** signal health problems

My cat seems to be drinking a lot more water than usual. She's even started having accidents outside the litter box. I think she can't get there in time. What could be causing this? via Facebook

In vet speak, what's going on is called polydipsia and polyuria — excessive thirst and urination. The problem is that these signs can be symptomatic of any number of diseases. It can be really frustrating for veterinarians and owners to try to figure out the cause. Diseases that cause these signs include diabetes, kidney failure and hyperthyroidism, to name just a few.

The differential diagnosis — a term you may know from medical detective shows such as "House M.D." — involves a good nistory first. The veterinarian will want to know how long your cat has been drinking lots of water and whether you've noticed if she's urinating more frequently (pollakiuria) or going a normal number of times but producing greater amounts of urine (polyuria). Other questions may include what you feed your cat, whether you've noticed any changes in eating habits or unusual weight loss and whether you're giving her any medications or supplements.

A physical exam and lab tests are also part of the search for answers. A complete blood count, urinalysis and thyroid test are among the lab work your veterinarian may order. They can help to check such things as kidney and liver values, thyroid hormone levels, abnormal electrolyte levels and excess sugar in the urine. Again, there are many potential causes of these signs, so a veterinary visit is a must. -Dr. Marty Becker


