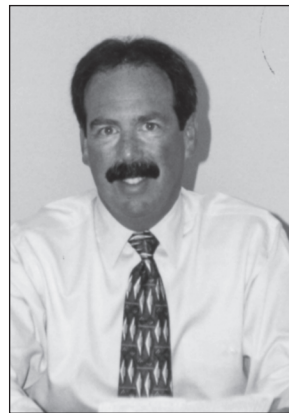

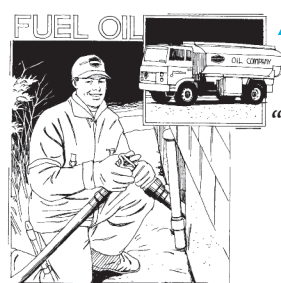

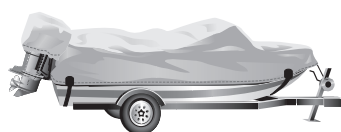

- It was noted American poet and feminist Adrienne Rich who made the following sage observation: "Language is as real, as tangible, in our lives as streets, pipelines, telephone switchboards, microwaves, radioactivity, cloning laboratories, nuclear power stations."
- When you were growing up, did kids call each other "chicken" to insult each other's bravery? In all likelihood, the answer is yes. That word has been used since the 14th century to insult those considered to be cowardly.
- It was once against the law in some places — England, for example — for a man to marry his brother's widow. It was considered to be an incestuous relationship.

Behind me in line was a young man with a red shirt on, along with a blonde woman with a black blouse.

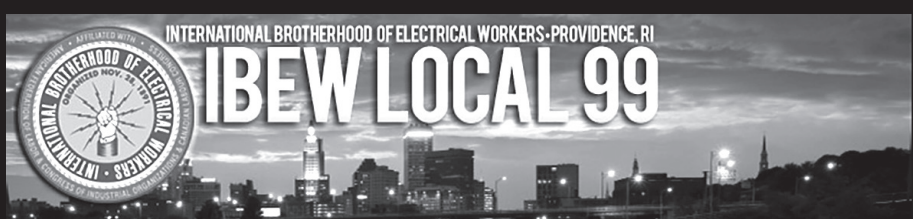
The clerk walked over to my carriage and placed two bags in my cart. I asked what is this? She replied, "these folks paid for your items for you..."

Eating Eight Strawberries A Day May Improve Heart, Mind And Body

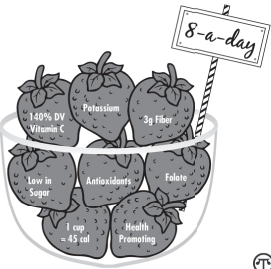
Clinical Research Suggests Strawberries Can Benefit Heart And Brain Health And Reduce The Risk Of Some Cancers

(NAPSA)—Just one cup a day of America's favorite fruit, strawberries, benefits the entire body. Subjects in the study were served a typical 'Western-style' meal high in carbohydrates and fat plus a beverage that contained freeze-dried whole strawberry powder (amount of powder ranged from 0 grams to 40 grams, equivalent to 3 cups of fresh strawberries). When subjects drank the most concentrated beverage, they didn't produce as much insulin as when they drank the least concentrated versions. In other words, they didn't need as much insulin to metabolize their meal after drinking the anthocyanin-rich strawberry shake. The study results add to the collective evidence that consuming strawberries may help improve insulin action.

"The health benefits of strawberries for the heart, body and mind are really incredible. In addition to the new insulin resistance study, another recent study indicated that an eating plan called the Mediterranean-DASH Intervention for Neurodegenerative Delay, or "MIND", diet can lower your risk of Alzheimer's disease by more than one-third—and the secret was a healthy daily dose of strawberries and blueberries," said Toby Amidor, registered dietitian. "Since strawberries can play a role in protecting our brains as we age, there's never been a better time to remember to eat more strawberries."

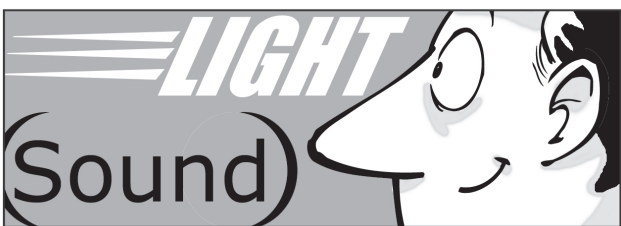
