Blackhawk Technical College enrollment increases

JANESVILLE — Blackhawk Technical College's new student enrollment is trending upward. In its most recent submission to the Wisconsin Technical College System office, BTC reported an 11.6 percent increase in new students for the 2014-'15 school year.

The new student increase is BTC's largest since the closing of the Janesville General Motors plant in December 2008.

"This is an exciting time for the college as well as the communities we serve," Edward Robinson, vice pres-

ident of student services, said in a news release. "An increased number of people in Rock and Green counties are becoming more aware of BTC's top-notch academic training, which prepares them for fantastic career opportunities.

"Consequently, as more people are weighing academic training, career opportunities and cost to enroll in classes, BTC is becoming their college of choice."

According to the admissions department, 1,008 new students are attending BTC this fall, helping boost the college's full-time equivalent

or FTE growth by 4.8 percent, compared to fall of 2013.

In addition to the new student growth, the popularity of BTC programs was reflected in the number of applications received the fall semester.

BTC received 2,349 applications, the highest total since 2011-'12 when 2,678 applied. In fact, 60 percent of the college's programs saw an increase in applicants.

"Our plan came to fruition this year because our student services team, including the admissions and

administrative staff, faculty and other support areas worked as a team to promote the value of a Blackhawk Technical College education with prospective students," said Barrett Bell, director of admissions.

"We feel we have a lot of momentum heading into the fall," added Bell. "Our new Advanced Manufacturing Training Center is open and off to a great start, we've added a bus shuttle system this year to help with transportation and our new Student Success Center is among the best in the state."

Art Infusion features chalk masterpieces

JANESVILLE — The Fourth Annual Art Infusion-Sidewalk Chalk Art Competition will be held Saturday and Sunday, Sept. 20 and Sept. 21, in lower Courthouse Park in Janesville. The event will run from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. on Saturday and 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Sunday.

Art Infusion was developed to enhance art appreciation, art education and community spirit while showcasing downtown to residents and visitors alike.

The two-day event will feature a chalk art mural by master chalk artist/street painter Lee Jones of Orlando, Florida. The event also will include a competition for people of all ages.

Throughout the event, Jones will create a Janesville-themed work of art. During the 2011 event, she created a drawing of the iconic bridge and gazebo at Rotary Botanical Gardens, for 2012 her creation included the Lincoln-Tallman House and in 2013 it was the world champion Rock Aqua Jays Water Ski Show Team. Jones also will teach free chalk art classes at area schools while she is in Janesville.

Chalk artists of all ages and skill levels are invited to participate. There is no fee to draw a chalk mural. People who would like to participate in the competition will need to register and pay a \$10 fee, which includes chalk art pas-

tels, sponge and gloves. There will be a \$250 cash prize for the overall winner in the chalk art competition.

Sponsorship opportunities also are available for businesses wanting to support classroom visits by Jones.

Jones graduated with honors from Madison Area Technical College's commercial art program. She worked as a freelance artist in Madison for a few years, then moved to Orlando to work for an ad agency. During her career, Jones has worked for ad agencies, printing companies and graphics studios before eventually opening her own studio and traveling the country to draw and teach at sidewalk chalk art festivals.
