

Workforce group to provide training for FoodShare recipients

Effort aimed at improving job prospects

ROCK COUNTY — The Southwest Wisconsin Workforce Development Board has received notice from the Wisconsin Department of Health Services of its intent to contract with SWWDB to coordinate and administer FoodShare employment and training services in southwest

Wisconsin.

FSET services help FoodShare recipients gain the skills, training and experience necessary to improve employment prospects and reduce reliance on FoodShare benefits. Information provided by DHS during the proposal process indicates the estimated contract could exceed \$3.4 million for the 21-month period beginning Jan. 1.

FSET is a free employment and training program designed to provide

FoodShare recipients assistance in improving employment opportunities. As the administrator of Workforce Investment Act services, SWWDB sees a strong organizational alignment in operating an additional employment and training program.

According to Rhonda Suda, SWWDB CEO, "Drawing upon 14plus years of experience and positive outcomes, the Southwest Wisconsin Workforce Development Board

provides workforce solutions to employers by helping job seekers remove employment barriers through skillupgrading, retraining and other individualized solutions.

"Partnering with DHS and county economic support operations to provide FSET services opens a new chapter for SWWDB, and our experience as a workforce development leader predicts truly positive outcomes."

While the FSET program is available to all FoodShare recipients, on Jan. 1, new work requirements will apply to able-bodied adults without dependents, and participation in FSET will provide a primary way for them to meet the mandatory work requirements necessary to maintain eligibility for

FoodShare.

The state anticipates FSET participation will increase due to the new requirements. It is anticipated that about 2,900 FoodShare participants will be referred to the FSET program in 2015, with about half, 1,450, enrolling in FSET. A majority of those, about 75 percent, will be in Rock County. The remainder will enroll in Grant, Green, Iowa, Lafayette or Richland

SWWDB will assess participants, provide program orientations, career planning and offer other assistance in areas such as job search, training, work placement and education. Follow-up and support assistance will also be provided to ensure job retention and advancement.

United Way sets \$2.8 million goal

ROCK COUNTY — After making an unexpected arrival via helicopter, United Way Blackhawk Region President Mary Fanning-Penny, assisted by members of the United Way Campaign Cabinet, revealed the goal for the 2014 United Way campaign is \$2.8 million.

The goal is determined by various factors, including evaluation of trends from last year's campaign, evaluation of the nonprofit program partners seeking funding, program outcomes and how they relate to the United Way's community impact goals.

"This goal reflects a 4 percent increase over what was invested by the community in our 2013 campaign," Fanning-Penny said in a news release. "This goal, when reached, will support nearly 100 programs providing emergency services to those most in need as well as programs designed to create opportunities for a better life for

Co-chairs for the 2014 campaign are Tom Spilde and Donna Sykora. Spilde is chairing the campaign for a second straight year, while this is the first year in this volunteer role for Sykora, a key account manager with Alliant Energy.

"I have learned so much about the work being done in this region thanks to the United Way nonprofit partners supported by the annual

campaign," Sykora said. "I am inspired by how the people in the communities of the Blackhawk Region support their neighbors with a commitment to Live United.'

Spilde reported at the campaign kickoff event on Sept. 17 that \$223,525 have been reported to date by 22 of the 35 companies to host Pacesetter campaigns prior to the official kick-off.

"The success of the early Pacesetter campaigns helps to inject real enthusiasm into the campaign," Spilde said. "We are grateful for the enthusiasm of our Pacesetter campaigns. Many of these companies have been doing this for many years and we appreciate their dedication."

Following the campaign kick-off and reveal of the 2014 goal, a record number of volunteers spent the day participating in work projects for 30 nonprofit agencies within the Blackhawk Region during the United Way's annual Day of Caring.

"Giving back to the community is a great way to celebrate the kickoff of the campaign," said Beth Gliebe, United Way's volunteer Day of Caring project coordinator. "We had record-breaking involvement this year, with 725 volunteers from 27 companies sign up to work at 83 Day of Caring projects."






